### **LAST GAME**

The Bowie Baysox walked-off the Altoona Curve 4-3 last night on a wild pitch for their first walk-off victory of the season. The game began as a pitcher's duel between Baysox right-hander Justin Armbruester and the Curve's Jared Jones. Bowie would eventually break through in the fourth inning with a Heston Kjerstad RBI double. Altoona would charge back to take the lead in the sixth, with three-straight two-out baserunners capped off by a Henry Davis three-run home run. That soured the start for Armbruester, but all three runs were unearned in his six frames of work, due to an error earlier in the inning. The Baysox would quickly tie the game in the bottom half of the sixth with a two-out homer of their own. Mark Kolozsvary lifted a two-run shot to left field that leveled the score at three until the bottom of the ninth, where Cesar Prieto led off the frame with a double, eventually advancing to third on a fielder's choice and coming home on a wild pitch with John Rhodes at the plate, securing the victory for Bowie.

### **TODAY'S OPPONENT**

The Altoona Curve enter the week with a record of 15-17. Altoona currently sits fifth in the Southwest division standings, but are only two games out of first place. The Curve are coming off a series in which they lost four of six games to the Akron RubberDucks at home. Altoona took four of five games played against the Baysox last month at Peoples Natural Gas Field. The Curve are led by C Henry Davis, as the No. 3 Pirates prospect and No. 48 overall prospect (per MLB Pipeline) ranks top five in the Eastern League in OPS (1.124 - 1st), on-base percentage (.454 - 1st), slugging (.670 - 1st), batting average (.309 - 4th), home runs (9 - 3rd), and extra-base hits (15 - 4th). Davis' on-base percentage also leads all of Double-A, while his OPS is second. Davis is one of six prospects in the MLB Pipeline Top 30 for the Pirates, alongside INF Liover Peguero (No. 6 PIT), RHP Jared Jones (No. 11 PIT), OF Matt Gorski (No. 16 PIT), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 19 PIT), and OF Matt Frazier (No. 22 PIT).

### **TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER**

Altoona sends right-hander Sean Sullivan to the mound tonight. The right-hander fired 4.1 shutout innings against Bowie back on April 21 allowing a pair of hits and walks, while striking out three on 67 pitches. That was part of a 14.1 inning shutout streak to begin the season for Sullivan. Since then, he has allowed five earned runs on eight hits in his last six-plus innings of work. An 8th round draft pick of the Pirates in 2021 from the University of California, Berkeley, the right-hander features a low-90s tailing fastball, alongside a mid-80s changeup and slider.

### **HAIL CESAR**

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern Leauge with 48 htis and a .387 average - 58 points above the next highest qualified average. Prieto has hit a scorching .438 in the month of May with a .481 on-base percentage. He has collected multiple hits in 8 of his 12 starts this month, and has 15 multi-hit games in his first 31 contests of 2023. The No. 17 O's prospect also ranks third in the league in on-base percentage (.433), along with third in OPS (.981).

### **GETTING BACK TO WINNING WAYS**

The Baysox are hoping to string together consecutive victories for the first time since the opening two games of the season. Bowie is the only team in the Eastern League yet to have a winning streak of at least three games yet this season. The Baysox are also the only team in the league to not win consecutive games at least three times in 2023 (Bowie has only done so once). Overall, the Baysox are 1-8, averaging just 2.9 runs per game, following a victory this season.

### TANDEM TROUBLES

Bowie's abundance of starting pitching experience is leading to a statistical split based on when each pitcher enters the game. Bowie has had eight different pitchers start multiple games this season, and those pitchers sport a 2.91 ERA with 151 strikeouts in 136 innings when they start their respective games. When those same pitchers enter games as relievers, they sport a collective 6.71 ERA, with only 46 strikeouts in 51 innings.

### **HESTON IS BESTON**

OF/1B Heston Kjerstad has shown out as one of the top bats in the Eastern League so far this season. Kjerstad currently sits third in the Eastern League with nine home runs. Beyond the long ball, the Orioles' No. 5 prospect has also demonstrated plenty offensive consistency - sitting second in the Eastern League in slugging percentage (.640) and second in OPS (1.025) among qualifiers, while also ranking second in extra-base hits (18) and total bases (73), and sitting tied for the league lead with three triples. Kjerstad is in the midst of a 19-game on-base streak - the longest streak in the Eastern League this season. He has reached base safely in 28 of his first 29 Double-A contests.
