TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Albuquerque Isotopes (Colorado Rockies affiliate) get set for Game 2 of their six-game set on Wednesday night. The Express trailed 6-5 entering the eighth inning when 2B John Taylor cleared the bases with a grand slam, giving the Express their first lead of the game. In the ninth, RF Sterlin Thompson trimmed the deficit to one for the Isotopes but the Express held on to secure a 9-8 victory in Tuesday night's series opener.

WHERE WE STAND

The E-Train have now won their last three series openers... looking for their first three-game winning streak since April 19-23 at Sugar Land... finished June with a 13-12 record... first winning month of the campaign and first time they have finished June above .500 since they went 17-7 in June of 2023... now 11-18 in one-run games but are 7-3 in their last 10 one-run games after starting the season 4-15 in one-run contests... are 5-2 in the second half... just their fourth win in 42 games when trailing after seven innings this year and three of the four wins have come in the last 30 games.

SEEING THE SLUG

The E-Train have homered in a season-best 11 consecutive games (6/18-current)... is the longest active streak among PCL clubs...previous high was 4 games (6/10-13)...are 6-5 in that span, slashing .289/.365/.520/.885...finished June, 2nd in the PCL in home runs (34) after entering the month last in the league in homers for the season (42).

ON THE FLIP SIDE

With a home run in the 2nd inning last night, the Express have now allowed the most home runs in the PCL through the first 3 innings (43)...23 of the round-trippers have been allowed away from Dell Diamond... have allowed the 2nd most homers in innings 4-6 with 39... given up the 3rd fewest home runs (19) through the 7th inning or later...both clubs combined for 6 homers, the most in any game at Dell Diamond this season.

NO K'S IN CASTILLO

INF Diego Castillo has now gone 10 consecutive games without striking out, the longest active streak in Triple-A...is slashing .324/.395/.459/.854 during the streak...among Pacific Coast League batters (min. 200 PA), ranks 3rd in strikeout rate (9.9%) and 5th in whiff rate (14.2%)... the PCL average strikeout rate is 21.0% while league average whiff rate is 24.7%.

CAM GETS THE CALL

Round Rock INF/OF Cam Cauley made his Major League debut on Monday night, batting 7th and playing 2nd base for the Rangers...recorded his 1st career base hit with a triple in the top of the 7th and later scored on a single from SS Nicky Lopez...in 74 games with Round Rock this season, he has led the club in hits (76), triples (3), walks (45) and stolen bases (29) and is 2nd in home runs (8) and RBI (33).

THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - MONDAY, JULY 1, 1985

38-year-old Nolan Ryan delivered 9.2 innings for the Houston Astros but took the loss. On the 124th pitch of the night, Bruce Bochy hit a walk-off home run in the bottom of the 10th inning to give the San Diego Padres a victory over the Astros at Jack Murphy Stadium.

"Anyone who looks for a breaking ball against Nolan Ryan has got to be nuts," Bochy said. "I was looking for the fastball." Bochy had entered the game in the top of the ninth inning after Bobby Brown pinch-ran for regular catcher Terry Kennedy. The homer was Bochy's third of the season. His first had come against another Hall of Famer, Steve Carlton. According to North County Times writer John Maffei, teammates mobbed the big catcher at home plate, lined up bats in the clubhouse pointing toward his locker and filled his size 8½ helmet with a six-pack of Lite Beer. Ryan pitched beyond 9.0 innings 17 times in his career.

After this outing, he stood just 10 strikeouts shy of 4,000 for his career. He finished the night allowing six earned runs on nine hits with three walks, seven strikeouts and two home runs over 9.2 innings. Goose Gossage earned the victory after tossing a scoreless inning in relief.

MANAGER KYLE MOORE

The 2026 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kyle Moore's first season with the E-Train. In 2025, Moore served as the bench coach for Triple-A Iowa of the Chicago Cubs organization. He previously served as the skipper in the Baltimore chain with Short-Season Aberdeen (2018), Low-A Delmarva (2019), High-A Aberdeen (2021) and Double-A Bowie (2022-23) - combining for a 321-286 (.529) record over five seasons. The 2019 Delmarva Shorebirds were named the 2019 MiLB Team of the Year, finishing with a 90-48 record, the most wins across all of MiLB that season.

A catcher in his playing days, Moore signed with the Orioles as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He played collegiately at University of Alabama after winning three high school state titles with Edgewood (Ala.) Academy. Moore transitioned to coaching in 2012 as a strength and conditioning coach with Delmarva.

PITCHING COACH DAVE BORKOWSKI

Former MLB pitcher Dave Borkowski (Boar-COW-ski) enters his fourth season on Round Rock's staff and 17th year in coaching. He will serve as the Express' pitching coach in 2026, reprising the role he held from 2023-24 after spending the 2025 campaign as the club's bullpen coach. Borkowski spent five seasons as a minor league instructor in the Los Angeles Dodgers' farm system.

His tenure also includes an 11-year stint as a minor league coach for the Houston Astros. Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Borkowski enjoyed a 15-year professional playing career that saw him post a 13-20 record and 5.87 ERA across seven MLB seasons with the Detroit Tigers (1999-2001), Baltimore Orioles (2004), and Houston (2006-08). He was originally selected by Detroit in the 11th round of the 1995 MLB Draft out of Sterling Heights (Mich.) High School.

BENCH COACH CHASE LAMBIN

Lambin enters his sixth year on the Express staff and will reprise his role as bench coach for the fifth straight year (beg. 2022). The 2026 campaign will mark Lambin's 12th in the Texas organization. He has previous stops as a hitting coach for High-A Down East (2019), Low-A Hickory (2018), Short-A Spokane (2017), and the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers (2016). He first joined the Rangers as a member of the Spokane coaching staff in 2015.

Lambin was selected by the New York Mets in the 34th round of the 2002 June draft out of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette and played in the Mets, Marlins, Nationals, Twins, and Royals organizations. He also has international experience, spending the 2009 season with Chiba Lotte in Japan. The versatile defender appeared at every position except catcher over the course of his career.

BULLPEN COACH JULIO VALDEZ

Valdez enters his seventh year in the organization and first as the Rangers' Triple-A pitching coach after serving in the same role with Double-A Frisco (2025), High-A Hickory (2024), Low-A Down East (2023), Rookie-level ACL Rangers (2022), and DSL Rangers (2020-21). During the canceled 2020 campaign, Valdez worked with pitchers at the Dominican Republic complex and Fall Developmental League in Arizona.

The Florida native played baseball at Alabama State University from 2012-16. He attended Lake Howell (Fla.) High School, where he posted a career 15-4 record and 2.20 ERA, and earned all-conference honors as a junior and senior. Valdez transitioned to an assistant coach role at Alabama State in 2017 before becoming Director of Pitching at the Texas Pitching Institute in El Paso, Texas. He spent two years at TPI before taking the same role at Baseball Rebellion in Durham, N.C., before joining the Rangers.

HITTING COACH MATT LAWSON

Former Rangers farmhand Matt Lawson returns for a fifth straight season as Round Rock's hitting coach. Lawson previously served as an assistant coach, hitting instructor, and recruiting coordinator at his alma mater, Missouri State University, from 2014-21. The Missouri native was selected by the Rangers in the 14th round of the 2007 MLB Draft and played seven professional seasons as an infielder in the Texas (2007-10), Seattle (2010), and Cleveland (2011-13) organizations. With Texas, he was named Short-A Spokane's team MVP as a rookie in 2007 and a league All-Star for High-A Bakersfield (2009) and Double-A Frisco (2010) before he was involved in the 2010 trade that brought Cliff Lee to the Rangers.

He holds a degree in psychology and a graduate degree in sports management.

DEVELOPMENT COACH KAWIKA EMSLEY-PAI

Emsley-Pai enters his sixth year in the Texas organization and returns to the Express as a development coach, this after beginning his Rangers tenure in the same role during the 2021 season. He has also served as Double-A Frisco's bench coach (2025) and was a development coach with Frisco (2023-24) and High-A Hickory (2022). He served as the Centralia (Wash.) College head coach and education advocate from 2019-21. Prior to his stint at Centralia, Emsley-Pai had a three-year stint as an education advocate at a maximum-security juvenile rehabilitation facility.

A former catcher in the minor leagues, Emsley-Pai spent six seasons with the Diamondbacks (2010) and Pirates (2011-15) organizations, topping out at Double-A Altoona in 2014. He was originally selected by Arizona in the 10th round of the 2010 June draft out of Lewis-Clark State College in Lewiston, Idaho after spending his freshman year at the University of Texas in 2008.
