#### The Final Countdown (of the first half)

The Fightin Phils continue the final week of the first half with game four of a five-game series at the New Hampshire Fisher Cats on Friday night. It is the fourth-of-17 matchups between the teams this season, and fourth-of-11 at New Hampshire. Reading goes back to New Hampshire from July 23-28, and the Fisher Cats come to Reading from Aug. 13-18. New Hampshire won the 2023 season series over Reading 17-7, and leads 2-1 in this season's series.

#### All Around Friday Night Victor

It was an all-around effort on Friday night as the Fightin Phils won 6-2 to take their first victory in this week's series at New Hampshire. Robinson Pina improved to a team-best 8-2 with five innings of two-run ball. The bullpen combined to allowe just one hit and no runs over the game's final-four innings. Offensively, Marcus Lee Sang had three hits, a run, three RBI and a home run in the second. Carson Taylor had four hits, a run, double and two RBI. Trevor Schwecke added two doubled and Carlos De La Cruz turned in a two-hit game.

#### **Taylor Torments New Hampshire**

Carson Taylor turned in another impressive game in what has been a career-year for him. He set a new season-high with four hits, and also tied a career-high with that mark. The only other time Taylor had four hits in a game was June 22, 2021, when he was with Great Lake in the Dodgers' organization. It was also the second four-hit game for a Fightin Phil this season, as Marcus Lee Sang had four hits on June 8, against Harrisburg. Taylor currently ranks fifth in the Eastern League with his .299 average and leads all active Eastern League players with 48 RBI. This week, Taylor is slashing .417/.462/.500, with a .962 OPS.

#### Marcus Mashing

Marcus Lee Sang continued his red-hot stretch with three hits, one run, three RBI and a home run on Friday night. Lee Sang's ninth home run tied him with Carson Taylor for the team lead. So far in June, Lee Sang is slashing .328/.400/.574, with a .974 OPS. He's added 15 runs, four doubled, one triple, three home runs and 12 RBI. Lee Sang;s season started slowly, as he hit just .197 in April. Since May 1, Lee Sang is hitting .33, with an .862 OPS.

#### Bombs Away

After hitting another home run last night, Reading has matched a season-high with home run in seven games in a row. This comes after also hitting home runs in seven-straight games from June 4-11. The only game since June 4 Reading has not hit a home run in was June 12, so they have homered in 14-of-15 games. The Fightin Phils now sit second in the Eastern League at 67 home runs on the season, trailing first-place Somerset by five long balls. Since starting this run on June 4, Reading has hit the second-most home runs in the Eastern League at 23, trailing only Binghamton, who has 24.

#### Old Cats

Trevor Schwecke has had a strong week at the plate for the Fightin Phils. This week, Schwecke is 4-12 (.333), with three doubles, one home run and three RBI. He's appeared in four games since being transferred back to Reading from Triple-A Lehigh Valley on June 15, and has hits in all four games. Two of those have been multi-hit games. Schwecke is quite familiat with Delta Dental Stadium as he played parts of 2022 (39 games) and '23 (71 games) with the Fisher Cats. The Phillies selected Schwecke in the Minor League Phase of the Rule Five Draft from Toronto this past offseason. Additionally, first year coach, and acting manager, Karl Ellison is a former Fisher Cat. Ellison played part of 2022 (nine games) and '23 (11 games) with New Hampshire. After signing with the Phillies prior to the 2022 season, Ellison was traded to Toronto on Aug. 31, 2022. Following 2023, he retired from playing and is now the R-Phils Development Coach.

#### This Day in Baseballtown History

June 22, 2023: At Portland, Reading wins it third-straight game 10-5 over the Sea Dogs. Oliver Dunn homers for the third-straight game, Johan Rojas has his sixth-straight multi-hit game and Carlos De La Cruz reaches base for the 36th-straight game in the win.

#### Scouting the Fisher Cats

New Hampshire enters tonight in fifth place place in the Eastern League's Northeast Divison with a 30-36 record. New Hampshire most recently dropped four-of-six at home against the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Following this week, New Hampshire heads to Hartford to take on the Yard Goats. New Hampshire's roster features five players ranked amongst the Toronto Blue Jays' top-30 prospects: Adam Macko (9), Josh Kasevich (11), CJ Van Eyk (17), Alex De Jesus (23) and TJ Brock (29).

#### On the Mound for New Hampshire

Lefty Trenton Wallace makes the start tonight for New Hampshire. This season, Wallace is 3-2, with a 2.95 ERA over 12 starts. He's tossed 58 innings, allowed 38 hits, walked 26 and struck out 70. Wallace last pitched June 15 against Richmond, going six innings, and allowing four hits and two runs, with three walks and one strikeout, in a no-decision. Wallace made stops in 2023 with the FCL-Blue Jays, Single-A Dunedin, High-A Vancouver (majority of starts) and New Hampshire. Overall in 2023, Wallace went 5-3, with a 2.65 ERA over 12 starts. The Blue Jays took Wallace in the 11th round of the 2021 draft out of Iowa. Wallace pitched for the Hawkeyes from 2017-21 and combined to go 10-2, with a 3.33 ERA over 107 games and 24 starts. He was a 2nd Team All-American in 2021.
