CAREER NOTES

2024: Spent the majority of his season with Altoona, going 1-7 with a 5.98 ERA in 20 games, 17 starts... Was a non-roster invite to Pittsburgh Pirates Spring Training... Was named to the Pirates Spring Breakout roster but did not play due to illness... Changed Number from #45 to #35 on 4/25... Placed on the Development List on 6/20 and transferred to Florida to get back on track... Transferred back to ALT on 8/8... Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings on 8/31 vs. New Hampshire, first scoreless start of 5.0+ with Altoona since 7/1/23 (30 apps) vs Harrisburg (5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K)... Allowed a career-high 9 hits on 9/13 vs Richmond...

2023: Finished the season 7th among PIT MiLB with 118 strikeouts... Also finished 8th in IP (110.1), 3rd in WHIP (min. 50.0 IP) with a 1.19 mark, 5th in ERA (3.26) and 11th in BB% (8.6%)... Made his Double-A debut on 6/17 @ Somerset, struck out 7 and took the loss... Was the Eastern League's youngest pitcher at 20 years, 6 months, and 15 days when he made his debut... Became the 13th player in franchise history to suit up for the Curve under the age of 21 and slotted in as the 5th-youngest player in the team's history when he joined the club on June 17... Tossed 14.0 consecutive scoreless innings from the final inning of his team debut through 3 innings on 7/6 vs. Erie... Threw the third-most innings by a pitcher age-20 or younger at the Double-A level this season (50.1) and walked just 6.5% of batters he's faced. He was one of 14 pitchers to reach Double-A at age 20 or younger this season...

CURVE CUTS: Anthony Epifanio Solometo... Last name pronounced "saul-o-MEET-o"... Does everything in life right-handed except for sports... Because of his unorthodox delivery has earned comparisons to LHP Madison Bumgarner and LHP Mackenzie Gore... Attended Glaucester Catholic HS as a freshman and sophomore before transferring to powerhouse Bishop Eustace Prep for his final two seasons... Recent Bishop Eustace alums include RHP Zac Gallen, RHP Tyler Phillips and RHP Devin Smeltzer... Committed to the University of North Carolina after his freshman year of high school... Was rated as the 17th-best player in the 2021 MLB Draft by MLB Pipeline (28th by Baseball America)... Was rated by Baseball America as having the fourth-best "Breaking Ball" and having the fifth-best "Control" among high school players in the 2021 draft... First identified as a fan of the Pittsburgh Steelers after the team beat the Seattle Seahawks in Super Bowl XL (wore No. 32 in high school as a fan of Steelers Hall-of-Famer Franco Harris), now roots for the Philadelphia Eagles... Started working out at Tread Athletics, a pitching development complex in Charlotte, NC that has worked with Pirates RHP Mitch Keller in the '22-23 off-season where he dropped his playing weight from 220 to 195... Lists his favorite player growing up as LHP Cole Hamels... Has a dog named Bugsy... Told Young Bucs in August of 2023 that Dick Vitale is the most famous contact in his phone... 

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching career has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rangers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.


