YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Baysox fought back from a 4-2 deficit to win their home opener 5-4 over Erie. **Tavian Josenberger** tied the score at four with a two-run triple in the sixth before **Enrique Bradfield** raced home on a wild pitch for the winning run in the seventh. **Dylan Coleman, Dylan Heid** and **Keagan Gillies** combined for 3.1 innings of scoreless relief late. Starter **Pat Reilly** struck out three in 4.1 innings in his season debut.

BULLPEN BEASTS

Chesapeake's bullpen owns the second-lowest ERA (1.42) in Double-A through the first four games of the season. Baysox relievers threw 15 consecutive scoreless innings to start the season before Jake Holton's two-run homer in the sixth last night. Last season, the Baysox bullpen led all of Double-A in strikeouts (724) and innings pitched (653.2).

MEET THE SQUAD

Chesapeake's 2025 Opening Day roster features 19 returners from last year and nine newcomers. Of the returners, five are top 30 Orioles prospects with three in the top 15, according to MLB Pipeline. OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. (No. 3), RHP Patrick Reilly (No. 10), C Creed Willems (No. 12), RHP Trace Bright (No. 25) and RHP Alex Pham (No. 29) all return to Bowie while notable newcomers include top-20 O's prospect RHP Juan Nunez (No. 20), RHP Zach Fruit, former Royal RHP Dylan Coleman and non-roster Spring Training invitee IF Jeremiah Jackson.

ELECTRIC ENRIQUE

OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** begins his first full season in Double-A after swiping the second-most bases in the Minors last year with 74 stolen bags. The Orioles' 17th overall selection in 2023 led all O's minor leaguers in runs, tied for second in triples, was fourth in hits and received a Minor League Gold Glove Award after recording only two errors all season. Bradfield posted excellent numbers against Erie last season, slashing .378/.462/.578 with two doubles, two triples, a homer, five RBI and eight stolen bases in 12 games played.

CREED CRUSHES

C **Creed Willems** is set to begin his first full season in Chesapeake. The Orioles No. 12 prospect matched his career-high with 17 homers and set a new career-high with 65 RBI last season. Willems raked in the final series of the regular season last year, going 10-for-21 (.476) with three doubles, a homer and eight RBI against Erie. He also played in the Arizona Fall League and was named a Fall League All Star after batting .338 with an .891 OPS.

GOING LONG

RHP **Ryan Long** is set to make his season debut for the Chesapeake Baysox. The 25-year-old completed his second stint and his first full season with the Baysox last year primarily as a starter and tandem reliever. Long pitched the third most innings on the team (93.0) last year and made his Triple-A Norfolk debut against Worcester. In three career starts against Erie, Long holds a 9.26 ERA.

THE CHAMPS HAVE ARRIVED

The Erie SeaWolves are on a quest for a third consecutive Eastern League title after defending their crown last year against Somerset. The Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers finished 77-58 last year and clinched the first half of the season. Erie's active roster features nine Tigers' Top 30 prospects (MLB.com), C/1B Thayron Liranzo (No. 5), RHP Jaden Hamm (No. 9), RHP Troy Melton (No. 12), LHP Jake Miller (No. 17), RHP Joseph Montalvo (No. 19), OF Roberto Campos (No. 22), IF Max Anderson (No. 23), OF Justice Bigbie (No. 27) and RHP RJ Petit (No. 30).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Joseph Montalvo makes his second appearance and his first Double-A start for the SeaWolves. Montalvo was acquired by the Tigers from the Rangers during last year's trade deadline in a deal that sent LHP Andrew Chafin to Texas. The 22-year-old split the season between High-A Hickory and West Michigan. The Bayamon, Puerto Rican struck out 88 batters in 78 innings. Montalvo was drafted by the Rangers in the 20th round of the 2021 Draft out of Central Pointe Christian HS in Kissimmee, Fla.

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. Before the Baysox, Mercado spent two seasons as manager of the Aberdeen IronBirds - the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Mercado received the Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award in 2022 by the Orioles.

Prior to joining the O's, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut and served as Dean of Students for over 18 years.

JORDIE HENRY

Pitching Coach

Jordie Henry enters his first season as Baysox Pitching Coach in 2025 and his third season as a member of the Orioles' system. Previously, Henry served as the pitching coach at High-A Aberdeen wher his staff recorded 1,357 strikeouts last season - 2nd-most in the South Atlantic League and 2nd-most in IronBirds franchise history. Before joining the Orioles, Henry was the Director of Pitching at Prime Sports Performance in Baltimore - a private athletic development training facility. He also worked as a pitching coach and instructor at the high school and summer collegiate levels. Henry pitched collegiately for four seasons at Wayland Baptist University.

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la DiversiónTM" or "Fun CupTM"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League BaseballTM teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
