"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

SAINTS SALVAGE FINAL GAME IN DES MOINES: The St. Paul Saints snapped a five-game losing streak with a 3-1 win on Sunday afternoon over the I-Cubs at Principal Park. The Saints offense backed a strong outing from starter Andrew Morris, who fanned eight over five shutout frames when Will Holland uncorked his third home run of the season to break a 1-1 tie in the ninth, a two-run blast with one down. Kyle Bischoff threw up a scoreless inning of relief in the eighth before Richard Lovelady slammed the door with a 1-2-3 ninth inning for his second save of the season. The only run the Saints pitching staff allowed was unearned because of an error in the sixth. Randy Dobnak fanned three across two innings to bridge the gap between Morris and the rest of the pen, the veteran's first game with St. Paul since April 18 after going on the IL with a right ankle sprain.

BLAME IT ON THE RAIN: Following back-to-back postponements, the Saints now [lead the minor leagues](#) with 13 rainouts on the season (incl. two cancellations & 11 PPD). Only AA-Portland (12), AAA-Rochester (10) and AA-New Hampshire (10) also have at least 10. St. Paul's 13 rainouts this year is more than their past two seasons combined with the Saints seeing five postponements/cancellations in 2024, five in 2023, four in 2022, and five in 2021 in each of their first four seasons of Triple-A affiliation.

FRESH FACES, NEW ENEMIES: The Saints welcome in the Norfolk Tides and are set to face the Orioles affiliate for the first time in franchise history. The Tides are one of three International League teams the Saints will play for the first time in 2025; they'll also see Worcester (BOS) at home in late-July and Memphis (STL) in a September road series. Also new to Triple-A this year, the Saints will take part in an International League vs Pacific Coast League crossover series as Round Rock (TEX) visits CHS Field for the first-time in August. In addition to the four new teams they'll face, the Saints will also visit Coolray Field for their first road games ever vs Gwinnett (ATL). After this year, Lehigh Valley (PHI), Jacksonville (MIA), and Charlotte (CHW) will be the only IL teams they haven't faced.

PITCHING PARTICULARS: Despite righting the ship with just an unearned run allowed in a 3-1 win on Sunday, the Saints have struggled on the mound recently as they've yielded 38 runs across the last 40.1 innings of baseball last week in Des Moines. Since the start of May, St. Paul pitching has produced a 6.42 ERA (93 ER, 130.1 IP), [the 4th-worst mark in Minor League Baseball and 2nd-worst in the International League, only ahead of the Rochester Red Wings \(6.70\) since the turn of the calendar page](#). Despite the pitching struggles, the Saints' team OPS of .870 as an offense is the [third-highest in MiLB in May](#).

CHICKS DIG THE LONGBALL: After hitting just 7 homers in their first 12 games of the season, which ranked tied for the second-fewest in the International League at the time, the Saints have touched off for 43 round-trippers in their last 30 games since April 14, which [ranks tied for the 3rd-most in the minors in that stretch, trailing only the Greensboro Grasshoppers \(46\) & Charlotte Knights \(44\)](#). St. Paul had left the yard at least once in eight straight games, a season-long streak for the club, until going homerless on Tuesday and Wednesday last week in Iowa. They have left the yard in [12 of their past 15 games](#).

HEY MICKEY, YOU'RE SO FINE: Since being optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on May 5, Saints utility man Mickey Gasper has hit .429 (18-54) with four doubles, 5 HR, and 12 RBI in 13 games. His OPS of 1.114 in that stretch ranks [7th in the International League \(min 40 AB\)](#) while his nine extra-base hits ranks 3rd, trailing only Lehigh Valley's Buddy Kennedy & Iowa's Carlos Perez (10 each). The New Hampshire native now has seven homers in 17 games in a Saints uniform this year, more than halfway to his career-high 12 set last season in the Boston organization. Gasper has quite simply been one of the best hitters in the minors the last two years. Since the start of 2024 with the Boston org, he ranks as the 2nd best hitter in the minors by wRC+ (weight runs created plus, where 100 is league average, a ballpark and league adjusted measure) & 3rd in OPS in MiLB:

FORGET ABOUT THE CURVEBALL, RICKY...GIVE 'EM THE HEATER! The Saints have crushed fastballs this season and [lead the International League in batting average \(.306\) and are 1st in slugging% \(.499\) against fastballs](#) so far this year. 30 of the Saints' 50 home runs as a team have come against the hard stuff. TWINS REPORT: The Minnesota Twins (27-22) saw their 10-game home winning streak snapped when they fell in yesterday's regularly scheduled game to Cleveland, 5-1 (The Twins finished off a 6-5 win that had been suspended on Monday night earlier in the day). The 10-game win streak at home was the longest in Target Field's history. Kody Clemens hit a walk-off double to win the resumed game, and now has an extra-base hit in four straight contests. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (23-18) evened the series at one apiece in San Antonio (SDP) behind 4.2 IP of one-run ball by Minnesotan southpaw Aaron Rozek. INF Tanner Schobel extended his hit streak to 10 straight games after going 1-4 yesterday. High-A Cedar Rapids (23-16) were rained out in Fort Wayne (SDP) yesterday. Twins No. 4 prospect Kaelen Culppepper has hit safely in 11 straight & ranks top-6 in the MWL in hitting (.312) & OPS (.923) for the Kernels. Cedar Rapids will send the Twins No. 28 prospect, RHP Jose Olivares (0-1, 5.79), to the hill tonight. Low-A Fort Myers (19-22) have lost back-to-back games this week in Lakeland (DET).

LAST APPEARANCE: Started Wednesday afternoon at Principal Park and threw up zeros in his first two innings of work before he was burned for his second straight leadoff walk in the third inning. Walked the first two hitters he faced in the fourth and ran out of rope after giving up back-to-back RBI singles with one out. Simplified his arsenal, throwing only four-of-his-six pitches: 31 knuckle balls (40%), 22 sliders (28%), 20 four-seamers (26%), and 5 curveballs (6%). Generated three whiffs, all of them on the knuckle ball, and recorded all three of his strikeouts on the knuckler (two swinging, one looking). His five walks issued was a career-high.

THE KNUCKLEBALL FRATERNITY: When he debuted on September 19 with the Saints last season, Lewis became just the third pitcher in Triple-A to throw an offering recorded as a knuckleball (not counting position players) by pitch tracking last year, joining El Paso's Matt Waldron and Lehigh Valley's Nick Nelson. Only Waldron threw the knuckleball more than 7% of the time like Lewis (it was Waldron's primary offering at 43%) & neither Waldron nor Nelson's knuckleball averaged more than 80 mph. Lewis' hard-knuckler came in at an average of 83.2 mph, with his hardest of the day clocking in at 85.8 mph. MLB's Statcast system has never in its 17 seasons of existence recorded a knuckle ball in the Major Leagues faster than 84.2 mph (thrown by Padres' Matt Waldron in June 2024). In a poll of seven Twins catchers at this year's Spring Training, the group identified Lewis' knuckleball as [the filthiest pitch in camp](#). Saints catcher Patrick Winkel told the Minnesota Star Tribune's Bobby Nightengale that one of the knuckleballs Lewis threw in pregame warm-ups hit him squarely in the mask.

R.A. DICKEY ON LINE 1: One of Lewis' secondary offerings is a knuckleball that he picked up when he was 10 years old. He started throwing it at a Pony League All-Star practice and blew away coaches with it. His high school coaches allowed him to stick with it and realized in college that it was for real. Along the way, he has gotten tips from R.A. Dickey on how to throw the pitch, which will average in the mid-80s.

THE BEST WAY TO CATCH A KNUCKLEBALL? WAIT TIL IT STOPS ROLLING AND PICK IT UP : When the Twins took Lewis in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Amateur Draft, Lewis bought an oversized catching mitt, which he passes along to anyone who catches for him. Catchers joke that it looks like a softball first base mitt, but it's absolutely necessary.

LEWIS KNOWS NO-NO's: In Lewis' final Double-A outing last season on September 12, he did not allow a hit until there were two outs in the fifth inning. However, he has been part of a no-hitter in his career. On May 14, 2023 with Fort Myers, Lewis spun 5.2 innings of perfect baseball, retiring all 17 hitters he faced, striking out seven. The Mighty Mussels went on to finish the game without allowing a hit or a walk, but lost the perfect game on a wild pitch and a dropped third strike in the eighth inning.

IT'S NO LONGER HIGH NOON: Last season's breakout for Sim came in his first season after making some significant mechanical adjustments. During the offseason leading into 2024, he changed his arm angle to no longer come straight over the top. Instead of a 12 o'clock arm angle, he dropped down about six inches in hopes of getting his velocity back up to 93-94 mph. In addition, SWR added about 10-15 pounds to his frame.
