LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox dropped their home opener to the Akron RubberDucks, 7-4, last night. Bowie struck early on a two-run single by Gilbert Lara in the second inning – Lara's first hit of the season and one of two hits he would have on the night. However, Akron quickly equalized on a two-run home run by Michael Amditis in the top of the third off Bowie starter Garrett Stallings. The see-saw swung back in Bowie's favor the next half inning, when Cesar Prieto launched a solo home run to right-center field for his first long ball of the season, restoring the Baysox lead at 3-2. The homer was part of a third consecutive multi-hit game for Prieto. In the top of the fifth, Akron tied the game, after a two-out walk by left-hander Antonio Velez came around to score on an error by Baysox third baseman Coby Mayo - one of two errors on the night for Bowie. The RubberDucks found separation in the seventh, when they hit their second two-run homer of the night, this time coming of the bat of Angel Martinez, in the third inning of relief for Velez. Bowie would try to fight its way back in each of the last two innings. Heston Kjerstad hit a solo home run for his second of 2023, cutting the Akron lead to 5-4. Ultimatley, Bowie would load the bases before Donta' Williams struck out to end the frame. The RubberDucks tacked on two in the top half of the ninth of right-hander Xavier Moore, before Bowie threatened again. However, Kjerstad would ground out to second, ending the game, representing the tying run. In total, Akron pitching recorded 13 strikeouts of Baysox hitters on Tuesday night, while also collecting 12 hits of their own, after entering the series opener struggling at the plate through three games

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Akron Rubberducks return fifteen players from a squad that missed the Eastern League playoffs via a tiebreaker in the first half, and finished just two games off the pace in the second half. In its inaugural series of 2023, Akron dropped two of three games at home against the Erie Seawolves, falling in the rubber match 3-2 in 11 innings on Saturday night. Seven of the Guardians' top 30 prospects begin the 2023 campaign with Akron, including a debut Double-A stints for OF Petey Halpin (No. 17 CLE). Halpin hit .262 with six home runs, four triples, and 16 stolen bases for High-A Lake County last season and is off to a 3-for-12 start with a stolen base in 2023 as a tone-setter atop the Akron lineup. INF Angel Martinez (No. 10 CLE) hit .244 in 24 games for Akron last season and has continued to develop in the offseason, putting successful shifts together in both the Arizona Fall League and Guardians Spring Training. INF Jose Tena (No. 24 CLE) hit .264 in 127 games with 13 home runs for Akron in 2022 but did not feature in either of the two last games against Erie. The RubberDucks have four arms inside of the Guardians' top 30, including righthander Gavin Williams (No. 2 CLE) and southpaw Joey Cantillo (No. 19 CLE), the latter of whom was a 2022 Eastern League All-Star with a 1.93

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Akron looks to start Jack Leftwich on the mound for tonight's contest. The right-hander only has one season in the minor leagues under his belt. However, Leftwich was one of the most effective arms in a deep Cleveland system last season. He finished with an 8-2 record through 24 appearances, transitioning to a starter by June and making 15 starts, and a 2.72 ERA – third lowest among qualified arms in the Guardians system. His .194 opposing average was the best amongst the system. Leftwich had five starts across Single-A Lynchburg and High-A Lake County of six innings or more, not allowing more than a run in any of them. With his 10 starts in High-A Lake County, opponents only hit .188 off him through 49 innings, with a 3.12 ERA. Originally a seventh-round selection for the Guardians out of Florida University, tonight will be a Double-A debut for

THE CHAYCE IS ON

Right-hander Chayce McDermott looks to make his first start, and second appearance, of the season tonight. McDermott had a phenomenal relief outing on last Thursday's season opener against Hartford, pitching four shutout innings, and accumulating six strikeouts along the way to close out a Baysox victory. McDermott struggled to initially adjust in Double-A, joining the Baysox from High-A Aberdeen last August, not very long after being acquired by the Orioles as part of the Trey Mancini trade, but began to turn a corner towards the end of last season. Entering tonight, McDermott now has five consecutive outings of at least four innings with only allowing one earned run or fewer. McDermott has also shown prevalence as a major strikeout arm, now with at least six strikeouts in four-straight appearances dating back to last season, and in five of his seven outings with the Baysox overall.

DEBUT DARLING

Heston Kjerstad's solo home run in the eighth inning of last night's contest was his second in a Baysox uniform. Kjerstad has now homered in his Double-A home debut, Double-A road debut, and Spring Training debut - all in the span of 45 days. Kjerstad's four long balls and 34 total bases led the Orioles in Spring Training. Currently rated as the Orioles' No. 6 prospect via MLB Pipeline, Kjerstad is also expanding his defensive versatility this season, with two starts at first base for Bowie so far this season, after not playing there since a brief stint during his 2020 collegiate season for Arkansas

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto has been on a tear at the plate so far in 2023. After going 0-for-5 on Opening Day, Prieto has bounced back with three consecutive multi-nit games, including consecutive three-hit games for the first time in his minor league career on Friday and Saturday in Hartford. Prieto has only notched multiple hits in three-straight games one other time in his minor league career - June 14-16 of last season against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies. Prieto leads the Eastern League with eight hits through four contests.
