BATTLE OF THE HIGH SEAS

Today marks the 1st of 12 games between the Shuckers and Blue Wahoos over the final 5 weeks of the regular season... Last series, the Shuckers won 2-1, including an 11-1 win in the series finale.

Leaders in the season series include **OF DAMON KEITH** (12-for-27, 4 2B, 3 HR, 12 RBI) and **C MATTHEW WOOD** (10-for-33, 4 2B, HR, 10 RBI).

CHASING DOWN ANOTHER RECORD

SS JESÚS MADE (77) enters today in the top-4 for single-season RBI in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015)... The current single-season record is 89, set by **OF JACKSON CHOURIO** in 2023... Made is 1 of the 4 Southern League players with at least 70+ RBI this season.

Leaders in the season series include **OF RECE HINDS** (98, CHA, 2023) is the only Southern League player with 90+ RBI in a season since 2017... **OF TYLER O'NEILL** (102, JAX, 2016) is the last Southern League hitter with a 100 RBI season.

HOMER HAPPY SHUCKERS

Across 39 games in the second half, the Shuckers have hit 73 home runs, the most in MiLB and tied for the 13th-most by a Southern League team in the 2nd Half since 2005... The Shuckers have hit a home run in 13 of the last 14 games.

The Shuckers need 15 home runs over the final 31 games of the season to break the franchise record of 154, set in 2022.

NASHVILLE IS CALLING

1B BLAKE BURKE was promoted to Triple-A Nashville on Tuesday... Burke ends his time in Double-A as the Southern League leader in average (.285), home runs (30), RBI (88), slugging percentage (.603), OPS (.970) and extra-base hits (57).

Burke holds the Shuckers single-season (30) and career (41) home run records... Burke is among the Shuckers single-season leaders in OPS (1st, .970), RBI (2nd, 88) and average (4th, .285).

Entering today, Burke leads the Southern League in all three Triple Crown categories, including a .285 average, 30 home runs and 88 RBI... No Southern League hitter has won the Triple Crown since **1B/OF MIKE REINBACH** (.346, 30 HR, 109 RBI) in 1972 with the Asheville Orioles.

Burke became the 1st Southern League player to record a 30 home run season since **OF ADAM BRETT WALKER** (CHA) in 2015... Burke was the fastest Double-A player since at least 2005 to reach 30 home runs, needing 88 games to reach the mark.

GONE FISCH-ING

3B ANDREW FISCHER recorded his 35th home run of the season on Sunday, moving into 4th place for the most home runs by a Brewers Minor League player in franchise history (since 1970)... His 35 home runs mark the most by a Brewers Minor League hitter since 1985.

Fischer needs 5 more home runs to become the 2nd Brewers Minor League player with a 40 home run season... He would become the first since **CF GORMAN THOMAS** (51) in 1974.

The Shuckers enter today with 213 stolen bases, the 2nd-most in a season in franchise history (since 2015) and the 4th-most in Double-A this season... The current franchise record is 214, set in 2023.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP JARON DEBERRY (7-5, 4.26) makes his 21st start of the season and his 5th against the Blue Wahoos... Across his last 2 starts, DeBerry has allowed 1 run over 10.2 innings with 10 strikeouts... Entering today, DeBerry is among the Southern League leaders in opponents average (1st, .218), strikeouts (2nd, 106), ERA (3rd, 4.26), wins (T-3rd, 7) and innings pitched (4th, 99.1).
