#### LAST TIME OUT

After another rain delay of 42 minutes, the Pelicans crushed the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers 14-2 on Friday night. LF Andy Garriola and 1B Drew Bowser each hit home runs in the win, while RF Jacob Wetzel fell a homer shy of the cycle and reached base five times. RHP Nico Zeglin pitched 3.2 shutout frames in relief with five strikeouts to take the win. The victory was number 2,390 for Birds' manager Buddy Bailey, as he is now tied for third on the all-time MiLB managers

#### THE SILVER SEASON

The Pelicans will be celebrating their 25th season in 2024. After the departure of the Myrtle Beach Hurricanes in 1992, the Pelicans were established in 1999 following the relocation of the Durham Bulls to Myrtle Beach. During their 25 seasons, the Pelicans have won four Carolina League titles in 1999, 2000, 2015, and 2016. Myrtle Beach has been affiliated with three teams in their 25 seasons, including the Atlanta Braves (1999-2010), Texas Rangers (2011-2014), and the Chicago Cubs (2015-pres-

#### **PELICANS POWER**

After pacing the league last year with 104 home runs, the Pelicans are once again leading the league this year with 64 on the season. After hitting 12 home runs last year to place second on the team, **OF Andy Garriola** currently leads the league with 16, and is fourth in Pelicans' franchise history with 28 career home runs. In his first year in Myrtle Beach, OF Alfonsin Rosario ranks second with 11 homers, six of those being hit on the road. Just 29 of the 64 home runs hit by the Pelicans have been hit in Myrtle Beach, with 35 being hit in road ballparks. The 64 home runs have been hit by 16 different players.

#### **TOP BIRDS**

Currently, the Pelicans roster features three of the Cubs' top 30 prospects by MLB Pipeline. Interestingly, the top two prospects are brothers as INF Cristian Hernandez and his younger brother INF Alexis Hernandez stand as the No. 17 and No. 18 Cubs prospects, respectively.

20-year-old Cristian led the Pelicans in games played last year with 106, hitting .223 with four home runs while splitting time between shortstop and second base. 19-year-old Alexis hit .315 across 37 games in the Arizona Complex League last season while playing second, third, and shortstop. No. 28 Cubs prospect RHP Nazier Mulé was added to the Pelicans' roster in late May after missing all of 2023 with Tommy John surgery. He was the

#### **BUDDY IS BACK**

A familar face will be leading the Pelicans in 2024 as **Buddy Bailey** returns to manage the club for his seventh year in Myrtle Beach. Bailey previously led the Pelicans from 2016-18 and 2021-23, and will be coaching his 18th season in the Cubs organization. During his Pelicans tenure, Bailey has recorded 463 wins, the most in franchise history. He has also guided the Birds to four half-season Southern Division Championship titles, one Southern Division Championship title, and the Carolina League Championship in 2016. In 2017, Bailey became just the 11th minor league manager to reach the 2,000-win plateau- he currently sits with 2,390. Bailey currently tied with Mike Kelley (managed from 1901-1931) for third-place all time on the MiLB managers wins list. 2024 will be his 36th season as a minor league manager.

#### PELICAN POINTS

The Pelicans continue their home-packed month of July with a six-game homestand against the Carolina League South Division first-half champion Kannapolis Cannon Ballers. The two teams have already played two series, with the Birds dropping three of five in Myrtle Beach and losing four of seven in Kannapolis.

Through the first 85 games, the Pelicans lead all of Minor League Baseball with 133 wild pitches

Pelicans' INF Cristian Hernandez is currently fifth in the Carolina League with 76 hits.

Pelicans' **OF Andy Garriola** is currently the Carolina League leader with 16 HR and 59 RBI. He is also currently the leader with 33 extra-base hits.

OF Jacob Wetzel set the franchise RBI record on June 1st with a two-run triple, he currently stands at 125. He set the franchise record with his 128th career walk on 6/6 at Augusta. The third-year Pelican also holds the franchise record in runs scored at 159.

The Pelicans have won four Carolina League championships in team history, with the last one coming in 2016. The Birds have also won in 1999, 2000, and 2015.
