Today is a special Cinco de Mayo celebration on a Capital City Market Kids Day, with the Lansing Locos taking the field against the Dragons, the rubber match in a seven-game, six-day series between the Lansing Lugnuts and the Dayton Dragons, and part of a larger 15-game season series. The Nuts are 4-4 against Dayton in 2026 and 241-196 vs. the Dragons dating back to 2000.

Yesterday: Dragons 5, Lugnuts 3. Dayton's Nestor Lorant and Cody Adcock blanked the Lansing lineup through eight innings, and the Dragons scored three key insurance runs (aided by a pair of errors) in the top of the ninth to stave off a last-ditch Lugnuts rally in the bottom of the ninth.

On Deck: After a day off tomorrow, the Lugnuts take a trip to Four Winds Field for a six-game series at the South Bend Cubs, next returning home from Tuesday, May 12, through Sunday, May 17, to welcome in the Kansas City Royals-affiliated Quad Cities River Bandits,

LUG-NOTES

Milestone Watch: Lansing is six wins away from the 2,000th victory in Nuts history, plus three players away from 1,000 players all-time.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster boasts five players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects: No. 8 (**Devin Taylor**), No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**), No. 26 (**Nate Nankil**) and No. 30 (**Bobby Boser**).

Firemen: A pair of 2022 Lansing Lugnuts rank atop the Major Leagues' relievers. The San Diego Padres' **Mason Miller** leads MLB with 10 saves, while the Athletics' **Hogan Harris** ranks 1st in the Majors with 19 relief appearances.

Game 7: Today marks the conclusion to the Lugnuts' first seven-game series since May 16-21, 2023, which also went to a rubber match. The finale was a thriller, tied 2-2 to the bottom of the ninth. **Clark Elliott** walked with one out, stole second base with two outs, and came sprinting home on a game-winning single from **Alex Campos** to give the Nuts a 3-2 walk-off win and series victory. Today also marks Game 7 for the Detroit Pistons/Orlando Magic at 3:30 p.m. and Toronto Raptors/Cleveland Cavaliers at 7:30 p.m. in the NBA playoffs, and for the Montreal Canadiens/Tampa Bay Lightning at 6 p.m. in the NHL playoffs.

Streak Snapped: **Bobby Boser** went 0-for-4 yesterday, the first game he has not reached base in this season, ending a 23-game streak.

Starting Spotlight: Lansing right-hander **Tzu-Chen Sha** makes his first appearance this year and his fourth appearance overall against the Dragons. Last year, Sha made his Midwest League debut vs. Dayton, suffering the loss (3 IP, 7 H, 6 R, 1 BB, 1 K) on June 25 with a home run served up to Carlos Sanchez. He rematched on August 14 in Game 1 of a doubleheader, twirling four scoreless innings in piggyback relief. But Dayton had the last laugh in Sha's final appearance of the year, handing him another loss (4 2/3 IP, 6 H, 3 R, 3 BB, 2 K) as Carlos Sanchez homered again in a 7-1 win on September 6 at Day Air Ballpark.

Midwest League Leaders, Batsmen: **Devin Taylor** is 3rd in the Midwest League in batting average (.330) and tied for 2nd in base hits (31). **Davis Diaz** is 3rd in doubles (9).

Midwest League Leaders, Moundsmen: **Zane Taylor** ranks 2nd in the MWL in ERA (1.50) and is tied for 3rd in innings pitched (24) with teammate **Kyle Robinson**. **Steven Echavarria** is tied for 5th in batting average against (.195).

The Week That Is: In their three wins against Dayton this series, Lansing has scored a combined 30 runs. In the three losses, the Nuts have plated only five runs.

Late Magic: The Nuts lead the Midwest League in ninth-inning offense: highest batting average (.272), most runs (19), most hits (22), most walks (18), and the second fewest strikeouts (14). On the other hand, Lansing has the second lowest batting average (.195) in the first inning.

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

MAY 3 IN LUGNUGS HISTORY

2016: The Lugnuts bullpen's scoreless streak ended at 38 1/3 consecutive scoreless innings on an A.J. Murray two-out home run in the top of the seventh, lifting the Cedar Rapids Kernels to a 3-0 win over the host Lugnuts.

2017: The Peoria Chiefs set a Midwest League single game record by hitting six Lugnuts with pitches, matching the most single-game HBPs for one team in MLB history to boot (1913, NY Yankees vs. Washington Senators). The Lugnuts scored seven second-inning runs and beat the Chiefs 9-7 at Cooley Law School Stadium. Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. hit his fourth home run of the year, a two-run shot below the LF video board that capped the second-inning rally.

Last Outing: Started on April 26 at Quad Cities: 4 2/3 IP, 7 H, 4 R, 1 HR, 1 BB, 3 K, 76 pitches, 52 strikes... allowed one run in 2nd, one in 3rd, two in 5th en route to 9-5 loss.

Hometown Heroes: The first Taiwanese Lugnuts, **Po-Hsuan Keng**, who pitched primarily out of the bullpen for the Nuts from 2005-2007, and **Chi-Hung Cheng**, a starting pitcher in 2005-06 and 2008, put themselves in the franchise record book.
