FRES-NOTES

HIGHWAY 99 HEAT: The Fresno Grizzlies and Visalia Rawhide open another chapter of the Highway 99 Rivalry with both clubs arriving on opposite recent trajectories. Fresno enters the series tied for first place in the California League North at 19-15, while Visalia sits fourth despite taking the opener Tuesday afternoon. The Grizzlies continue swinging one of the hottest offenses in the California League, ranking third in runs scored and third in OPS entering the night. Visalia, meanwhile, has started generating more offensive momentum recently behind some come from behind victories over the last two weeks.

BRITO LEADING THE CHARGE: Roldy Brito enters tonight carrying the longest active hitting streak in the California League at 12 games. During the streak, Brito has collected 20 hits while continuing to impact games with extra-base damage, speed and run production near the top of Fresno's lineup. The switch-hitting infielder/outfielder now ranks among CAL leaders in runs scored, RBI, total bases and triples. Brito has also hit Visalia pitching well this season, helping anchor Fresno's offensive success in the rivalry matchup.

POWER VS. PRESSURE: Fresno and Visalia arrive with very different offensive identities entering the series. The Grizzlies lead the California League with 39 home runs and continue relying on middle-of-the-order power from Ethan Holliday, Tanner Thach and Derek Bernard. Visalia has generated more offense recently through speed and contact pressure, with a number of players creating problems on the bases. The Rawhide rank near the top of the league in stolen-base activity, while Fresno continues producing some of the league's loudest extra-base contact.

EXTRA-BASE DAMAGE: Fresno continues producing some of the loudest contact in the California League entering this week's rivalry matchup. The Grizzlies rank 2nd in the league with 38 home runs while also ranking near the top of the league in doubles, total bases and slugging percentage. Derek Bernard, Ethan Holliday and Tanner Thach have combined for 18 home runs and 82 RBI already this season, giving Fresno one of the deepest middle-of-the-order groups in the league.
