## LHP MASON ALBRIGHT (0-0, 5.40) vs. RHP CRISTIAN MENA (2-3, 4.89)

TODAY'S GAME: Reno holds a 1-0 series lead after the Aces claimed a 7-6 walk-off victory last night ... Reno has won five-straight games over the Isotopes ... Mason Albright is slated to take the hill for the Isotopes while Cristian Mena is expected to start for the Aces

LAST FIVE: Four of Albuquerque's last five games have ended in a walk-off (May 15-17 vs. Tacoma and last night).

WALK-OFF: The walk-off loss yesterday is Albuquerque's second on the year (May 8 at Oklahoma City, Michael Chavis two-run double).

WALK-OFF @ RENO: It's Reno's seventh all-time walk-off against the Isotopes and first since September 21, 2024, when Sergio Alcantara swatted a two-run dinger as the Aces claimed a 6-5 win in 11 innings.

**ONE-RUN GAMES**: With the loss last night, the lsotopes fell to 8-9 in one-run games and 2-7 on the road. The loss snaps a three-game winning streak in games decided by one run.

ON THE ROAD: In Albuquerque's last six road games, the club has played five one-run contests, tallying a 1-4 record in such dames.

THREE BAGGERS: Albuquerque has connected on a triple in four-straight games for the first time since a seven-game stretch from August 2-9, 2021.

TOPES STARTERS: Jack O'Loughlin completed just 0.2 frames yesterday, allowing three runs on two hits and one homer ... It's the shortest start for an Isotopes hurler since September 13, 2024, vs. Las Vegas (Peyton Battenfield 0.2 innings).

HITS: The Isotopes have recorded double-digit hits in fourstraight games, one shy of the season-high (April 22-26).

HOMERS ALLOWED: Albuquerque has allowed a homer in seven-straight contests, the longest stretch since September 11-18, 2024, also a seven-game streak.

SERIES OPENERS: The Isotopes are 4-5 in series openers and 2-3 on the road. The club has lost two-straight since winning four in-a-row.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Ryan Ritter is T-5th in walks (29) and runs scored (32), 9th in OPS (.900) and 10th in OBP (.397) ... Sam Hilliard is T-1st in triples (4), T-6th in XBH (19) and 10th in slugging (.537) ... Warming Bernabel is 9th in doubles (12). **RIT**: Ryan Ritter went 3-for-5 yesterday with a double and RBI. Has recorded multiple hits in five-straight games, matching a career-long (June 16-21, 2023, with Fresno) ... Has an extra-base hit in five-straight games. During stretch, slashing .522/577/1.043 with five doubles, two triples, one homer and nine RBI.

-Has an RBI in six-straight games (10 total), one shy of his longest streak of career: June 24-July 2, 2023, with Fresno ... Has 12-game on base streak.

POTW: Ryan Ritter was named PCL Player of the Week Monday ... Went 10-for-22 with four doubles, two triples, a homer and nine RBI ... During week, led PCL in OPS (1.475) and slugging (.955) and tied for first in doubles (four) and second in RBI (nine).

KESTDADDY: Keston Hiura swatted his fourth dinger of the season last night and third in his last 10 games. Has a sevengame hitting streak. During stretch is slashing .385/.500/.615 with three doubles, one homer and six RBI ... Has six RBI in his last four games.

-Hiura has a hit in 13 of 14 games played in May ... During the month, is slashing .358/.443/.623 with a triple, three doubles, three homers and 10 RBI after hitting .141 over his first 24 games ... Has a 14-game on-base streak, fourth-longest active streak in PCL

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard has reached base in 33 of 34 games started on the year ... Belted his sixth homer of the year last night and second in his last four contests. Has an RBI in five-straight games for the first time since June 18-22, 2021, with Albuquerque.

-Hilliard's 24-game on-base streak from April 3-May 6 is tied for the longest in the PCL (Drew Avans, Las Vegas)

**WARMING UP:** Warming Bernabel tallied two hits last night for his fourth-straight multi-hit contest and team-leading 14th on the season. Over his last four games, is 9-for-18 with two doubles, one homer and four RBI. Has a hit in five-straight. Has an extrabase hit in three-straight.

YF: Yanquiel Fernandez tallied his third-straight multi-hit game yesterday and 10th of the year ... Has three-straight multi-hit games for second time this year (also: April 20-23).

VEEN: Since being sent back down to Albuquerque April 24 (17 games), Zac Veen is 17-for-68 with four doubles, one triple, one homer and eight RBI ... Has a hit in three-straight and four of last five.

### NUCLEI NOTES

**SKIPPER**: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

**CHRIS MICHALAK**: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

**MICHAEL RYAN**: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

**AARON MUNOZ**: Takes over as Isotopes hitting coach after Jordan Pacheco was named one of two new hitting coaches for the Colorado Rockies on May 12 ... Began the 2025 season as the hitting coach for the ACL Rockies ... Spent nine seasons (2016-2024) as the Rockies bullpen catcher ... Was Isotopes bullpen catcher in 2015 ... Originally drafted by the Blue Jays in the 34th round of the MLB Draft ... Played parts of four seasons in the Minor Leagues (2011-14), making it to Double-A.

**SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT**: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

**BALLS AND STRIKES**: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
