## BROOKLYN CYCLONES (15-21) vs. WINSTON-SALEM DASH (23-14)

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn split Sunday's doubleheader at Hudson Valley...The Cyclones captured the opening game, 6-0...RHP Tyler Stuart posted a career-high 6.1-shutout innings, striking out 8, to earn the first victory of his professional career...LF Kevin Kendall reached base 3 times, doubling twice and earning a walk...3B Mateo Gil added a 2-run home run in the 4th...RHP Jace Beck completed the 4-hit shutout by collecting the final 2 outs...The Renegades won the finale in 9 innings, 3-2...CF Grant Richardson provided the walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the 9th...LF Joe Suozzi tallied 2 hits and an RBI for Brooklyn...RHP Christian Scott retired the first 12 batters he faced and finished his day with 4.0-plus, 1-hit innings.

**START ME UP:** After not registering a win in the team's first 31 games, Brooklyn starters collected 4-straight victories during the team's season-high win streak between May 17 and Game 1 of Sunday's double-header at Hudson Valley...In the last 5 games, Cyclones starting pitchers has amassed a 4-0 record with a 0.34 ERA (1 ER in 26.1 IP)...Brooklyn's starters have walked only 11 and struck out 29...The last earned run yielded by a 'Clone starter came on RF **Grant Richardson**'s solo home run to start the 5th inning in Friday's 6-1 win.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS: The Cyclones pitching staff has been marvelous over the course of the team's last 5 games...Since Wednesday afternoon, Brooklyn has permitted just 2 earned runs (7 total) on 27 hits through the last 42.2 innings...That is good for a microscopic 0.42 ERA... Cyclones pitching has walked 20 and struck out 51 in that span...Brooklyn's strikeout rate is 29.8% during the streak...The 'Clones outscored the Renegades, 27-7, over the 5-games stretch...Brooklyn is 4-1 during that span.

GUIGUE GUNSLINGER: Guigue, Venezuela's LHP Daniel Juárez has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023...In his first 12 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 2-0 record with 1 save...He has not permitted an earned run (1 total) on 5 hits and 6 walks, striking out 24 (13.79 K/9)...In 17 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 2 unearned runs in 20.0 innings...The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 25 straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Since then, he is 4-0 with 10 hits allowed, 15 walks, and 39 strikeouts in 30.1 innings...Since the streak began, no pitcher in Minor League Baseball has thrown more innings without allowing an earned run.

STU'S CRUISE: RHP Tyler Stuart has been as consistent as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old extended his scoreless inning streak to 14.2 innings with 6.1 spotless frames in game one at Hudson Valley on Sunday...Stuart punched out 8 batters for his first pro win...Entering Tuesday's series opener, the Southern Miss alum leads the circuit in ERA (1.13) by a full run over Hickory's RHP Josh Stephan (2.17)...Stuart is also 2nd in the league in batting average against (197) and 5th in WHIP (1.13)...Analytically, the right-hander is also among the SAL's best...Stuart is 2nd in FIP (2.86), 3rd in xFIP (3.49), 4th in strikeout rate (32.3%), and 5th in strikeouts per nine innings (11.81).

WIZARD OF SUOZZ: OF/1B Joe Suozzi matched a season-high with 3 hits on Friday and enters Tuesday riding a 10-game on-base streak during the course of Brooklyn's road trip...The Glen Cove, N.Y. native is 12-for-his-last-31 (.387) with 5 runs scored, 3 doubles, 5 RBI, 4 walks, and a stolen base...Suozzi has registered a .943 OPS and 158 wRC+ in those 10 contests.

**THRILL OF THE 'CHASE':** After a bumpy month of April, INF **Chase Estep** has picked up the pace at the plate in season's second month... In his last 11 games played dating back to May 5, the 23-year-old is slashing .316/.381/.553 with a .934 OPS...Estep has accumulated 6 runs scored, 4 doubles, a triple, a home run, and 9 RBI in 42 plate appearances...The Corbin, Ky. native has also registered a 146 wRC+...Estep has garnered at least one knock in 9 of those 11 games...In his first 12 outings, he was just 2-for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21.

HIT PARADA: C Kevin Parada cracked a home run last Tuesday night and has been on a tear since the calendar flipped to May...In 17 games during the season's second month, the 21-year-old is slashing .286/.384/.524 with a .907 OPS...Parada is 18-for-63 at the dish (.286) with 10 runs scored, 7 doubles, a triple, 2 home runs, and 8 RBI...In that time frame, the Los Angeles native holds a .408 wOBA and a 143 wRC+...In the month of May, Parada is 2nd in the league in doubles (7) and tied for 5th in extra-base hits (10)...For the entire campaign, the Georgia Tech alum is tied for 2nd in the SAL in two-base hits (11)...Parada has also reached base safely in 8-straight games dating back to May 13 at Wilmington.

vs. WINSTON-SALEM: Brooklyn returns to Coney Island for a 6-game set against the White Sox High-A affiliate... The Dash posses 9 of Chicago's top 30 prospects per Baseball America...RHP Norge Vera (8), RHP Jonathan Cannon (11), RHP Kohl Simas (13), RHP Jared Kelley (14), OF Wilfred Veras (17), INF Wes Kath (18), OF Terrell Tatum (24), INF Loidel Chapellí (26), and RHP Andrew Dalquist (28) are featured...The Cyclones went dropped 5-of-6 to Winston-Salem in their first meeting at Truist Stadium from April 11-16...In last year's meeting at Maimonides Park, Brooklyn split the 6-game set from August 2-7.

BROOKLYN BRUISING COMPANY: In Friday's victory, the Cyclones were drilled with pitches on 6 different occassions...That is the most times a single team has been plunked in a South Atlantic League game this season...It also set a new franchise record for hit-by-pitches in a single game...The previous high-water mark was 5 on July 24, 2022, at Jersey Shore...In addition, with LF Jaylen Palmer and 1B Joe Suozzi drilled twice and once, respectively, they have tied OF Matt Rudick's Cyclones record for career hit-by-pitches with 16...Rudick still holds the single-season mark as all 16 of his came in the 2022 season.

BREAK OUT THE RYE BREAD: 3B Mateo Gil's grand slam in the top of the 6th inning on Thursday marked the first 4-RBI home run by a Cyclone in 2023...lt marked Brooklyn's first grand slam since 1B JT Schwartz smashed one off RHP Ryan Miller at Hudson Valley on July 27, 2022... Last season, the Cyclones smashed a pair of grand salamis...CF Jaylen Palmer hammered the first off RHP Alex Pham vs. Aberdeen on June 12.

RAMÍ ROCKETS: OF Alex Ramírez reached base 4 times and tied a season-high with 3 hits on Thursday night at Hudson Valley...The 20-year-old doubled twice, worked a walk, scored a run and drove in another...It was Ramírez's first multi-extra base hit game since he doubled twice on August 25, 2022, at Jersey Shore...Since joining Brooklyn's roster on July 4 of last year, Ramírez leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (54), hits (97), doubles (24), and total bases (144)...He only trails teammate OF Stanley Consuegra in extra-base hits (32) and Winston-Salem INF Alsander Womack in batting average (.272).

ROAD WARRIOR: OF Stanley Consuegra has thrived away from Maimonides Park in 2023...Coming into Tuesday, the 22-year-old has posted a batting average 125 points higher on the road (.313) than at home (.188)...Away from home, Consuegra is slashing .296/.342/.577 with a .919 OPS adding 10 of his 15 extra-base hits and all 5 of his home runs...17 of his 19 RBI have been on the road, as well...As a team, the Cyclones are hitting 28 points better in visiting parks (.223) than on Coney Island (.195).

'DASH' LOS SANTOS: In addition to his 14 stolen bases in 16 attempts in 2023, OF Omar De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 84 stolen bases in that span, which is 6th most in Mil.B... Only Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (93), Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (90), Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (89), Athletics OF Esteury Ruíz (85), and Diamondbacks prospect OF Wilderd Patiño (85) have swiped more...De Los Santos has also snagged 48 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 36...Omar and Palmer are already 18 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

**MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS:** Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18).

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts 3 of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 5 of the Top 30...They include C Kevin Parada (No. 1 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF Alex Ramírez (2/5), and RHP Blade Tidwell (5/9)...INF William Lugo (24/26) and RHP Christian Scott (28/26) also appears on both lists...OF Stanley Consuegra ranks as the organization's No. 19 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*

SIT DOWN: Tidwell whiffed a career-high 10 batters on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...The 21-year-old became the first Brooklyn pitcher to strike out 10+ batters in a single game since RHP Carson Seymour punched out 10 hitters on July 22, 2022, at Jersey Shore...Tidwell was the first Cyclone to do it at home since RHP Dominic Hamel accomplished the feat with 10 K's on July 16, 2022, vs. Greensboro.

**TOP PROSPECT:** Tidwell enters the 2023 season ranked as the Mets' top pitching prospect per MLB Pipeline...Comes at No. 5 overall on the Top 30 list...The 21-year-old is considered the organization's No. 9 overall farmhand by *Baseball America*...Only RHP **Kodai Senga** is a higher-ranked pitcher on their list...Selected as having the "Best Fastball" and "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2022 draft class.

**2022:** Selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft...Signed for \$1.85 million on July 27...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 9...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning vs. FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Made 4 starts, registering an 0-1 record with a 2.16 ERA (2 ER in 8.1 IP) and 9 strikeouts... Hurled 9.2-scoreless innings for St. Lucie in the Florida State League playoffs, helping the Mets to their first league title since 2006...Earned his first professional win in the decisive Game 2 of the Championship Series on September 20 vs. Dunedin (5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 BB, 7 SO).

**VOLUNTEER SERVICE:** Tidwell joined the New York system after an incredible career at Tennessee...As a draft-eligible sophomore in 2022, The Volunteer State native accrued a 3-2 record with a 3.00 ERA (13 ER in 39.0 IP) and 51 punch outs in 13 appearances (9 starts)...Missed the first two months of the season with shoulder soreness...Named to the 2022 Knoxville Regional All-Tournament team...As a freshman in 2021, Tidwell was recognized on the SEC All-Freshman Team and named a Freshman All-American by D1Baseball. com and Perfect Game.

LORETTO LIGHTNING: Tidwell is no stranger to being around talent...At Loretto (Tenn.) High School, the former second-round selection was teammates with 2018 firstround pick (No. 7 overall) and current San Diego Padres LHP Ryan Weathers...Ryan's father, David, who pitched for the Mets (2002-04) is also a Loretto High School alum.
