YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox won the series opener over New Hampshire on Tuesday night by a final of 6-1. Orioles Major League rehabber **Kyle Bradish** threw 3.2 scoreless innings and allowed just one hit with two strikeouts. **Jalen Vasquez** recorded his first three-hit and three RBI game at Double-A and fell a triple shy of the cycle. **Blake Money** pitched in bulk relief and threw five innings of one-run ball with five strikeouts to pick up the win.

ROAD TO RECOVERY

Orioles Major League rehabber **Tyler Wells** is scheduled to make a rehab start this afternoon for Double-A Chesapeake. The 30-year-old is recovering from an internal brace procedure on June 17, 2024 to have his right UCL repaired. The average recovery time for this procedure is about two to four months shorter than traditional Tommy John surgery. Wells' last full healthy season was in 2023 where he recorded a 3.64 ERA in 118.2 innings for the Orioles. He last pitched for the Baysox in August 2023.

CREED CRUSHES

C **Creed Willems** has been red hot in the month of July. **The Orioles No. 14 prospect is second in the league in batting average (.357) and is sixth in the league in OPS (.973).** The 22-year-old is on a 17-game on-base streak and has collected a hit in 14 of 16 games this month.

ESTRADA IS ELECTRIC

IF **Aron Estrada** was promoted to Double-A Chesapeake yesterday and **homered for his first Double-A hit yesterday.** The 20-year-old led High-A Aberdeen in AVG, H, 2B, 3B, RBI and OBP at the time of his promotion. The Orioles No. 18 prospect was named a Carolina League Post-Season All-Star last year with Single-A Delmarva.

HOME WOES

Chesapeake has won just 15 games at home this season, **which is the third fewest in all of Minor League Baseball.** The Baysox have dropped 20 of their last 28 home games since May 27. The last time the Baysox finished a season at least 10 games below .500 at home was in 2016 (30-41). **17 of the next 23 games for Chesapeake are at home.**

CLOSE GAMES AND FREE BASEBALL

Chesapeake has won 21 games in one-run fashion - **which is the most in the Eastern League and is the second most in all of Double-A.** Chesapeake has 11 extra inning wins, which is the most in full-season MiLB. The Baysox have played 36 one-run games this season, **which is tied for the most in all of Double-A.**

BULLPEN BEASTS

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 3.13 ERA, **which is fourth-best in Double-A and fifth-best in full-season MiLB.** Baysox relievers have punched out 464 hitters, which is fifth-most in Double-A and the most in the Eastern League.

HERE COME THE CATS

The New Hampshire Fisher Cats - Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays - make their first trip back to Bowie since September 2023. New Hampshire finished the first half in fifth place at 29-40 and are off to a 10-16 start in the second half. New Hampshire's active roster includes four of the Blue Jays' top 30 prospects, per MLB.com - RHP Trey Yesavage (No. 2), OF Victor Arias (No. 13), IF Charles McAdoo (No. 15), and OF Dasan Brown (No. 29).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Grant Rogers makes his 12th start of the season for the Fisher Cats. Rogers has pitched six or more innings in six consecutive starts and holds a 2.43 ERA during this stretch. The 24-year-old began the season in High-A Vancouver and was promoted to Double-A New Hampshire on May 20. The Groves, Tx. native was drafted by Toronto in 2023 out of McNeese State.

- Appeared on his fourth career Opening Day roster, all with the Orioles; placed on the 15-day Injured List with right elbow inflammation on April 16, retroactive to April 13; transferred to the 60-day Injured List on June 19 after undergoing right elbow UCL surgery
- Made three starts in 2024, going 0-2 with a 5.87 ERA (10 ER/15.1 IP) on 18 hits (3 HR), 11 total runs, and three walks with 13 strikeouts
- Took the loss in his season debut against the Angels on March 31, logging 6.0 innings and allowing four runs (3 ER) on five hits (1 HR) with seven strikeouts; retired the final 14 batters he faced in order, capped off by striking out the side in the sixth inning; induced 16 whiffs, the fourth most in a game in his career; his career high is 18, done three times (last: 5/29/23 vs. CLE)
- All three home runs on the season were surrendered to right-handed batters (LAA's Taylor Ward, PIT's Joey Bart, and MIL's Gary Sánchez)

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

2023: Made his third career Opening Day roster; optioned to Double-A Bowie on July 30; had option transferred to Triple-A Norfolk on August 22; recalled by Baltimore on September 22 for the remainder of the season...Went 7-6 with one save and a 3.64 ERA (48 ER/118.2 IP) with 83 hits (25 HR), 50 total runs, 34 walks, four hit batters, and 117 strikeouts in 25 MLB games (20 starts)...Had been scheduled to start the fifth game of the season but pitched in relief on April 3 at TEX after Kyle Bradish was hit by a comebacker in the second inning; entered in the fourth inning and threw 5.0 hitless innings with two strikeouts...Worked a career-high-tying 7.0 scoreless innings on one hit with two walks and a career-high eight strikeouts on May 13 vs. PIT; retired 17 batters in a row from the second inning to the seventh; became the first Oriole to retire 17 in a row since Kyle Bradish set down the first 17 hitters of the game on September 22, 2022 vs. HOU...Led MLB with a 0.88 WHIP and a .185 opponent average and ranked second with a .232 opponent on-base percentage through June; posted a 3.21 ERA (33 ER/92.2 IP) during that time...Held opponents to a .193 average (73-for-379) through July 9, the third-best mark by an O's pitcher (min. 100 IP) before the All-Star break in team history (since 1954); his 0.927 WHIP during that time was also the fourth-best in Orioles history, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...Retired the side in order to secure his only save of the season as the O's clinched the division on September 28 vs. BOS...Appeared in all three ALDS games vs. TEX, completing 3.1 scoreless innings on one hit and three strikeouts...Had one save and a 5.52 ERA (9 ER/14.2 IP) with 13 hits (3 HR), seven walks, and 14 strikeouts in 10 games (three starts) between the Baysox and Tides.

2022: Made the Opening Day roster for the second year in a row; spent time on the Injured List from July 28 to September 6 (lower left side discomfort) and September 23 to the end of the season (right shoulder inflammation)...Set career highs in starts (23), wins (7), innings pitched (103.2), and strikeouts (76); the 23 starts were the most in his professional career...Tied for second on the O's in starts with Kyle Bradish, trailing only Jordan Lyles (32)...Threw less than 5.0 innings in 11 of 23 starts; had not thrown as a starter since 2018 in the minor leagues in the Twins system; completed at least 5.0 innings in seven of eight starts from May 25 to July 3...Started the Orioles' third game of the season on April 10 at TB, marking his first career start...Allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 17 straight starts from April 16 to July 17, tied for the third-longest such stretch in MLB during the season; since 1994, the only O's starter with a longer stretch is Chris Tillman (20, 6/10-9/20/14)...Did not walk a batter in five consecutive starts from April 21 to May 15, becoming the only O's starter in team history (since 1954) to do so...Won five straight games from June 11 to July 3, tied for the fifth-longest streak and one of 15 MLB pitchers to do so in 2022; marked the 56th occurrence (29th player) in O's history to win five-or-more outings in a row in one season and first since Chris Tillman (5, 4/27-5/18/16)...Struck out a career-high seven batters on July 3 at MIN (6.0 IP, 3 H, R, ER, BB, 7 K); the win was the start of Baltimore's 10-game winning streak through July 13...Went 4-0 with a 2.42 ERA (7 ER/26.0 IP) in five June starts, ranked 12th in the AL during the month (min. 25.0 IP); limited opponents to a .174 batting average (16-for-92)...Held left-handed batters to a .193/.224/.341 (34-for-176) slash line; the OBP was the third-lowest and the AVG was the 12th-lowest in MLB (min. 150 PA).

2021: Made his major league debut on April 4 at BOS (1.0 IP, H); struck out Gleyber Torres on April 6 at NYY for his first career strikeout...Earned his first career win on June 2 vs. MIN (3.0 IP, H, 2 K)...Earned his first career save on September 5 at NYY; retired Aaron Judge, Giancarlo Stanton, and Anthony Rizzo in order...His four saves were the third-most on the team; and his 18 games finished were tied for second-most (Cole Sulser)...His 44 games were fifth most on the O's, while his 57.0 innings ranked third...Opponents did not hit above .200 against him after July 19 (14 G); his .192 opponents' average is now the third-lowest by a rookie (min. 40 G) in club history (since 1954), trailing only Gregg Olson (.188 OBA - 1989); it ranked fourth among all rookie relievers in the majors in 2021...His .176



opponents' average on his fastball ranked as the 12th lowest among all major league pitchers, and fourth among AL pitchers (min. 100 PA)...Appeared in the ninth inning in 15 outings (from 7/6 on) after throwing in the ninth inning four times in 25 prior appearances...His 65 strikeouts ranked tied for 10th among rookie relievers...Had at least one strikeout in 34 of his 44 games, and multiple in 17 outings...His 0.91 WHIP led O's hurlers and was the lowest among qualified rookie relievers; is the seventh-lowest WHIP by an O's rookie in club history (since 1954, min. 10 G)...Did not issue a walk in 32 of his 44 outings...His 1.89 BB/9 was the 16th lowest among qualified big league relievers...Struck out at least one batter in a career-high 18-straight outings from May 15 to July 11...21 of his 44 outings were more than 1.0 inning...Did not give up a hit in 20 of his 44 outings, including a career-high five-straight appearances (4.1 IP) from July 19 to August 25...Had two stints on the 10-day IL with right wrist tendinitis (7/23-8/12) and right shoulder inflammation (9/25-end of season)...Made an Opening Day roster for the first time in his career.

2020: Selected by the Orioles in the Rule 5 Draft from the Minnesota Twins on December 10...Did not pitch during the regular season because of the cancellation of the minor league season due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

2019: Missed the entire season with a right elbow ECL sprain grade 1...Underwent Tommy John surgery in May.

2018: Split the season between Class A-Advanced Fort Myers and Double-A Chattanooga, going 10-6 with a 2.49 ERA (33 ER/119.1 IP), 31 walks and 121 strikeouts...Named the Fort Myers recipient of the Harmon Killebrew award for minor league community service.

2017: Spent the entire season with Class-A Cedar Rapids...Placed on the IL twice, May 12 to 31 and June 29 to August 10, both times with a right shoulder strain...Had a rehab assignment with the GCL Twins from July 29 to August 10.

2016: Spent his first professional season with Rookie-Level Elizabethton...Made 10 starts, including his first career complete-game shutout on 8/22 (7.0 IP, 1 H, 2 BB, 14 K).

AMATEUR: Played three seasons at Cal State San Bernardino...Went 4-6 with a 2.84 ERA in 15 starts during his senior season... Finished his senior season leading CCAA in strikeouts (89), ranked third in the conference in innings pitched (92.0 innings), and ninth in ERA...His 89 strikeouts rank fourth in California State, Santa Barbara history and his 92.0 innings rank eighth in school history...Totaled 191 career strikeouts during his career, ranking third in school history...His accolades include striking out a career-high 12 in the season opener at Sonoma State, a one-hit shutout in a 4-0 win over Stanislaus State and two CCAA Pitcher of the Week honors...Became Coyotes' first All-CCAA first-team starting pitcher honoree in 10 seasons.

PERSONAL: Married; wife's name is Melissa; the couple is expecting their first child, a daughter, in the spring...Has a mini bernedoodle named Buckley...Has two tattoos on his left forearm: one is the anniversary of his birth mom's death, the other is an outdoor scene that he feels represents his life and what he's been through...Grew eight inches the summer between his sophomore and junior year of high school...If he could pick anyone to play him in a movie about his life he would pick Ashton Kutcher or Channing Tatum...His go-to food to make for a pot luck is a dip with Hormel chilli and cream cheese in a crock pot.

Manager

For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™" - a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
