ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Wilmington scored early and put the game away late, beating Brooklyn 4-1 in front of 3,453 fans at Frawley Stadium. RHP Oscar Rojas allowed two early runs before departing with apparent injury in the third. RHP Nathan Jones made his High-A debut in emergency relief, tossing 3.1 scoreless innings. OF Matt Rudick tripled and collected two hits with 1B JT Schwartz. Wilmington's LHP Tim Cate yielded one unearned run over six innings en route to the victory.

BYE-BYE BMAC: OF **Brandon McIlwain** earned a promotion to Double-A Binghamton today. Prior to his call-up, he had been on base in 21 of his past 23 games and 14 straight. Since April 30th, McIlwain was hitting .330 with a .430 OBP in 35 games.

THANKS, FOG!: This week, the Cyclones and Blue Rocks are playing eight games in six days, playing a doubleheader on Wednesday and Saturday thanks to two fogged out games at Maimonides Park during the week of May 10-15. Since 2001, the Cyclones have dealt with fog outs but never in a three-day span that was experienced Thursday, Friday, and Saturday in Coney Island. In that series, Wilmington won three of the four games played, winning Tuesday, twice on Sunday, and losing Wednesday.

FIRST HALF CLOSING: The first half of the season ends next Thursday, June 23 during the six-game series with the Jersey Shore BlueClaws. The second half begins on Friday, June 24th. Aberdeen clinched the first half division title on Wednesday night, beating Jersey Shore. The first half division winners in the North and the South clinch a playoff berth against the winners of the second half. In case of a repeat winner at the top of the division, the team in that division with the best full season record is awarded the playoff spot.

GRRR-ERRERA: Watertown, CT native OF **Justin Guerrera**, who attended Fairfield University, earned

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn returns to Frawley Stadium for the first time since the opening weekend of the season. In the season series, Wilmington has won eight of the 12 games. Only the Jersey Shore BlueClaws, who have scored 224, rank lower than the Mets High-A affiliate. The Cyclones rank last in the league with runners in scoring position, hitting .226.

ROUGH N' ROWDEY: OF **Rowdey Jordan**, the Mets' 11th-round selection out of Mississippi State leads the team with 70 total bases and 16 doubles to lead the entire Mets organization.

PEROZA PEAKING: With hits in eight of his past 11 games, INF **Jose Peroza** has increased his batting average up 27 points (.195 to .222) and his on-base percentage (.288 to .306) 18 points. In his past six games, the Venezuelan is 8-for-23 with three walks, a triple, and five RBIs.

PALMER'S POP: Brooklyn native OF Jaylen Palmer, the team's top prospect according to *MLB Pipeline* (No. 14), leads the club with six home runs, including a grand slam to win the game last Sunday against Aberdeen. His career high is seven home runs which game during his second professional season in 2019, playing with Rookie-level Kingsport.
