### YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox used small ball to defeat the Richmond Flying Squirrels last night 4-3. The Baysox have now won three in a row and four of their last five. **Jeremiah Jackson** collected a game-high three hits and **Adam Retzbach** delivered the go-ahead run in the eighth on an RBI groundout to second base. **Preston Johnson** earned his first Double-A win with 1.2 innings of shutout relief and **Yaqui Rivera** slammed the door in the ninth for his second Double-A save.

### ARMS RACE

Chesapeake pitching has allowed four earned runs or fewer in 10 of the 12 games played this season (2.07 ERA in 87 innings pitched), which leads the Eastern League. Baysox relievers threw 15 consecutive scoreless innings to start the year. Last season, the Chesapeake bullpen led all of Double-A in strikeouts (724) and innings pitched (653.2).

### CREED CRUSHES

C **Creed Willems** blasted his first homer of the season on Wednesday with a solo shot in the ninth. The Orioles No. 12 prospect matched his career-high with 17 homers last season after hitting 17 the year before. Willems also played in the Arizona Fall League during the offseason and was named a Fall League All Star after batting .338 with an .891 OPS. The 21-year-old was drafted in the 8th round of the 2021 Draft out of Aledo HS (TX) and is the youngest position player on the team.

### TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGIE

OF **Doug Hodo** has been an on-base machine for the Baysox to start his first full season at Double-A. The 24-year-old is on a nine-game on-base streak, which is the longest active streak on the team and the fourth-longest active streak in the league. The Orioles 6th rounder in 2022 is currently third in the Eastern League in OBP (.500) and is tied for the league lead in walks (13).

### FRIDAY BRIGHT LIGHTS

RHP **Trace Bright** makes his third start of the season for the Baysox. In his most recent start on Saturday against Erie, Bright earned his first Double-A win in 32 career starts with 5.1 hitless innings, allowing one unearned run on four walks with three strikeouts. It's the first hitless start thrown by Bright in his Double-A career. The Orioles No. 25 prospect struck out the eighth-most batters in the Eastern League last year (120) but also walked the most batters in the league (60). In three career starts against Richmond, Bright holds a 3.95 ERA.

### MEET THE SQUAD

Chesapeake's 2025 Opening Day roster features 19 returners from last year and nine newcomers. Of the returners, five are top 30 Orioles prospects with three in the top 15, according to MLB Pipeline. OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** (No. 3), RHP **Patrick Reilly** (No. 10), C **Creed Willems** (No. 12), RHP **Trace Bright** (No. 25) and RHP **Alex Pham** (No. 29) all return to Bowie while notable newcomers include top-20 O's prospect RHP **Juan Nunez** (No. 20), RHP **Zach Fruit**, former Royal RHP **Dylan Coleman** and non-roster Spring Training invitee IF **Jeremiah Jackson**.

### THE SQUIRRELS ARE FLYING

The Richmond Flying Squirrels face the Baysox for the first of 18 total meetings this season. The Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants finished 64-74 last year but defeated the Baysox in 12 out of 18 games. Richmond's active roster features six Giants' Top 30 prospects (MLB.com): LHP Joe Whitman (No. 7), RHP Trent Harris (No. 11), IF Diego Velasquez (No. 15), IF Aeverson Arteaga (No. 16), IF Sabin Ceballos (No. 23) and LHP Jack Choate (No. 27).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Manuel Mercedes makes his third start of the season for Richmond. The 22-year-old is coming off a four inning start on Saturday in Harrisburg where he allowed two runs (one earned) on six hits with no walks and three strikeouts in the loss. The right-hander spent all of last year in High-A Eugene and threw the fifth-most innings in the Northwest League (116.0) and led the Emeralds in strikeouts (89). Mercedes signed with the Giants in 2019 as an international free agent at the age of 17.

### QUICK HITS

**Arsenal:** Fastball, Cutter, Curveball, Changeup, Splitter  
**Ranked** the Orioles No. 25 prospect, via MLB Pipeline  
**Delivered 1,305th Baysox** **strikeout** last year, **setting new franchise single-season record**

**2025:** **Earned first Double-A win in 32 career starts after delivering first hitless start of AA career on 4/12 vs ERI (Gm 2) with 5.2 IP. Enters third stint (second full season) with Chesapeake.**

**2024:** Completed third season in Orioles organization and first full season in Double-A with Bowie as a full-time starter. Eclipsed 100.0 IP for first time in career with 112.0 IP but allowed a career-high 60 BB. 2nd on team in IP and K (120). Led Eastern League in walks but finished 8th in K. Delivered 1,305th strikeout of the season in final start of year, which set a new Baysox single-season franchise record. Threw 4th-most IP, struck out 8th-most batters, and allowed 2nd-most BB in O's system. One of two winless starters in all of Double-A (minimum 20 starts). Went 5.0+ IP in only four starts. Baysox went 9-18 when Bright started. Started season strong with a 2.41 ERA in month of April (9th-lowest in EL) over 18.2 IP with 23 K. Ended season strong with a 1.93 ERA in 14.0 IP in September.

**Career Notes:** Began '23 in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 IP. Led IronBirds in K. Finished 4th in South Atlantic League in K. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Went at least 4.0 innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.... Debuted professionally in '22 with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27.

**College:** Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were 4th-most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

**Personal:** Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with 3rd round pick Nolan McLean...Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

The Chesapeake Baysox logos were created by Baltimore-based Younts Design, whose clients over the years have included a variety of professional baseball teams (including the Baltimore Orioles).



## ALTERNATE IDENTITIES

### CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

### CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasma De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™" - a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasma de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

### BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
