OFFENSIVE TURNAROUND: After dropping the first two games of the series, Salem's offense came alive Thursday. Last night, Salem outhit the Warbirds 10-4 but still fell short in 10 innings

OPATA ON THE PATHS: Outfielder **Andrews Opata** leads the team with 27 stolen bases on the season. The first year player has been thrown out just five times, good for an 84.4% stolen base percentage. Opata enters play third in the Carolina League in stolen bases and fourth in all of Single-A in stolen bases. Opata became just the third Salem player since 2004 to steal 20 bases before June 1. Joining an exclusive list of Ahbram Liendo (2023) and Yoan Moncada (2016)

OPATA REACHING: **Andrews Opata** snapped a 14-game on base streak Tuesday by going 0-for-4 at the dish. Tuesday was the first game since May 12 @ Fredericksburg that Opata failed to reach. In 43 games played this season Opata has reached safely in 37 games

NEED TO LIMIT THE FREE PASSES: Through 56 games this season, Salem pitchers have issued 336 walks, the third-most in Single-A, the only teams with more are Delmarva (366), and Jupiter (337). The Yaks are averaging 6.00 walks per game this season

SKYLAR SOARING: Since May 9, outfielder **Skylar King** has been swinging a hot bat. Over his last 19 games, King is hitting .269 (18-for-67) with an .797 OPS. He has recorded a hit in 17 of his last 24 games and has reached base safely in 20 of his last 25 contests dating back to May 3

LIGHTS OUT WUILLIAMS: **Williams Rodriguez** has been dominant out of the bullpen as of late. Over his last six relief outings since May 15, the right-hander has allowed no earned runs and just two hits across 9.1 innings pitched with six strikeouts and two walks. Rodriguez has dealt to a 0.43 WHIP and .063 BAA over his last six

BATTLE OF THE THIRDS: In the first six innings this season, Salem has outscored opponents by 29 runs, holding a 216-187 advantage. However, in the final three innings (7-9), the Yaks have been outscored by 38 runs, with opponents holding a 112-74 edge

SIT THEM DOWN: Through the first five games of this series, Salem pitchers have struck out 61 Wilson hitters, averaging 1.4 strikeouts per inning. Since Monday, that total ranks fifth in Single-A and seventh across all of Minor League Baseball. However, Salem (1-4), Jersey Shore (1-4), and Hill City (2-3), are the only teams among the top 10 in strikeouts with losing records this week

EXTRAS.....: After last night's 4-3 loss in 10 innings, Salem falls to 0-5 in extra-inning games this season. The Yaks have now dropped six consecutive extra-inning contests dating back to last season. Salem's last extra-inning victory came on July 20, 2025, against Fayetteville

BACK-TO-BACK NIGHTS: The last two nights marked the first time since August 20-21, 2021, that Salem played extra-inning games on consecutive nights. It was also the first time Salem suffered walk-off losses in extra innings on back-to-back nights since July 23-24, 2017, at Winston-Salem and Wilmington

ORTIZ ON BASE: Infielder **D'Angelo Ortiz** has successfully reached in 39 of his last 46 games dating back to last season. Since August 29, 2025, over his last 45 games, Ortiz is hitting 44-for-155 (.287) with an .373 on-base percentage

✦ **GRAND SALAMI:** After Salem went 401 days without a grand slam, the Yaks have blasted two grand slams in the last 24 games alone!

✦ **GILMAN'S GREATNESS:** Left-hander **Jason Gilman** turned in a career night on the mound Wednesday, setting career highs with 6.0 innings pitched and 10 strikeouts. Both marks are also season highs for any Salem pitcher in 2026. Gilman became the first Salem hurler to record double-digit strikeouts since September 5, 2024, when Matt Duffy fanned 10 Kannapolis batters. Through 24.1 innings, Gilman has struck out 36 batters, averaging 1.48 strikeouts per inning

✦ **RIDGEYAK SPEEDSTERS:** Through 56 games, Salem has swiped 106 bases and been thrown out 36 times (74.5 SB%). For context, after 56 games last season, Salem had 62 stolen bases

✦ **BATTLE WITH RIGHTIES:** Salem pitchers this season have excelled against right-handed hitters. Through 56 games, the Salem staff has limited righties to a .196 batting average against, the lowest mark in all of Single-A and the second-lowest in all of full season Minor League Baseball. However, against left-handed hitters, Salem has allowed 23 home runs (23 of the 39 total home runs surrendered this season), while lefties are hitting .232

WHAT IS A RIDGEYAK

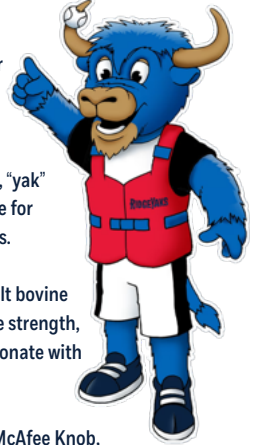
The name "**RidgeYaks**" is a creative and symbolic reflection of the Southwest Virginia community and carries a double meaning:

Ridge: A tribute to the scenic Blue Ridge Mountains that tower beyond the outfield wall at Salem Memorial Ballpark, a nod to the beautiful, rugged landscape that defines the region.

Yak: The name carries two layers of local-flavor meaning. First, "yak" plays off the slang for kayak, a subtle salute to the region's love for kayaking and other outdoor recreation on the area's waterways.

A Yak is also a real animal. The Yak is a long-haired, heavily built bovine native to high-altitude mountains. The Yak comes to symbolize strength, resilience, stability, and a hardworking spirit, qualities that resonate with both the team and the broader Salem community.

The new mascot, named **Mac the Yak**, takes inspiration from McAfee Knob, one of the region's most iconic natural landmarks, linking the team's identity not only to athletic grit, but to local heritage, outdoor adventure, and mountain pride.

- Was selected by the Red Sox in the 18th round of the 2024 MLB draft out of Ole Miss, picked with the 537th overall selection
- Had been committed to transfer to Troy University for his senior season but instead signed with Boston for an under-slot \$50,000 in July
- He made his professional debut shortly thereafter and closed the 2024 campaign by posting a 5.56 ERA with 14 strikeouts to six walks in five appearances (three starts) spanning 11.1 IP with Salem
- Missed the entire 2025 season with a UCL (ulnar collateral ligament) tear, underwent Tommy John surgery last March
- Transferred to Ole Miss from Pearl River CC for his junior season
- At Pearl River CC, he served as the closer all season until the team decided the night before the National Championship game to give Tolbert the start, and he went on to allow 2 runs on 5 hits while striking out 11 over 7 innings
- Made just 16 appearances in his two seasons at Mississippi
- Spent the last year in Fort Myers rehabbing at the Red Sox Florida Complex. To pass the time while recovering from Tommy John surgery, he started umpiring Little League games in Florida to pass the time
- When he returned and pitched vs Delmarva on May 9 it was his first affiliated pitching appearance in 610 days (Sept 6, 2024 vs Kannapolis, went three innings with two strikeouts against the Cannon Ballers)
- Last week vs Hickory came out of the bullpen for the first time this season
- Tossed a career long 4.2 innings against the Crawdads, striking out three without allowing a hit or run in the winning decision (his first career pro win)

- Opened the 2026 season with High-A Greenville, going 0-4 with a 12.76 ERA across seven appearances and 18.1 innings pitched
- Reassigned to Single-A Salem on May 19 ahead of the six-game series in Hill City
- Made 16 appearances (11 starts) for Salem in 2025, posting a 3.88 ERA with 50 strikeouts across 67.1 innings while going 4-2
- Earned a promotion to High-A Greenville on July 25 and finished the season making his final seven appearances with the Drive
- Logged five or more innings in 10 of his 16 outings last season and worked at least six innings twice (June 18 vs. Fredericksburg and July 6 at Lynchburg)
- His 67.1 innings pitched ranked second on Salem last season behind Adam Bates (80.1 IP), while his four wins ranked third behind Griffin Kilander and Jay Allmer
- Averaged 4.1 innings per outing in 2025 while throwing the second-most innings of any Salem pitcher last season
- YAKTOID:** Since Salem's affiliation switched to Boston in 2009, Cohen ranks 12th all-time in innings pitched (172.1), 11th in starts (34), and is one of just 15 pitchers in the Boston era to record double-digit wins (10-7)

- Opened the 2026 season on the High-A Greenville roster and also made one appearance with Double-A Portland before returning to Greenville on April 21
