The Round Rock Express and Reno Aces (Arizona Diamondbacks) are set for game five of their six-game series tonight with Reno. First pitch is slated for 7:15 p.m. CT.

ACES TIE THE SERIES ON FRIDAY

Reno held on for a 6-5 win over Round Rock last night. The Aces kicked off the second with a C Aramis Garcia single and 3B Tristin English double. SS Nicky Lopez grounded out but drove in Garcia on the play. 2B Andy Weber hit a sacrifice fly to center field and English came home for a 2-0 Aces lead. The Aces drew three walks to open the third inning. 1B Trey Mancini reached on a throwing error and Barrosa scored to make it 3-0. In the fifth, Garcia hit a sacrifice fly to left then English drove DH Michael Pérez in with a single. Reno led 5-0 after five. Garcia doubled to open the eighth and scored on an English double, extending the Aces lead to 6-0. Round Rock put two on to start the eighth. CF Dustin Harris grounded out but Helman came home to put the Express on the board. Freeman singled and sent Trejo home. 1B Blaine Crim notched a double and Freeman scored to make it 6-3. In the ninth, SS Michael Helman belted his first home run at Dell Diamond. The two-run shot made it 6-5. Later, RHP John Curtiss came in to retire the final batter, earning the save.

DELL DIAMOND DANE

RHP Dane Dunning is slated to make his team-leading ninth start and sixth at Dell Diamond. Last time out, Dunning tossed his first scoreless appearance of the year with 4.2 innings of one-hit baseball at Charlotte on May 25. He struck out six and walked one without allowing a runner to reach second base. Dunning leads the club with 32.2 IP and 33 strikeouts.

PEYTON POUNDING THE ZONE

RHP Peyton Gray made his first appearance back with the Express after spending seven days on the injured list. He allowed a run on three hits in 2.0 innings without a walk. Gray owns a 2.92 ERA (4 ER/12.1 IP) while allowing a run or less in six of seven outings. He has walked just two batters across six appearances in May and allowed one hit in four of the appearances.

CLOSE CALLS WITH THE ACES

The Express are 6-4 against Reno this year with a 45-42 all-time record. Last night marked the seventh one-run game between the two teams and the fifth consecutive game decided by one run. Reno holds the head-to-head advantage in hits with 98 compared to Round Rock's 96 and the E-Train have scored 56 runs to the Aces 54. Round Rock's pitchers own a 5.01 ERA (51 ER/91.2 IP) against Reno while the Aces' pitchers sport a 4.91 ERA (50 ER/91.2 IP).

COOL-HAND CODY

3B Cody Freeman is batting .452 (14-31) with three doubles, a home run, 10 RBI and six runs while getting on base in all of his last seven games. He's recorded at least two hits in six of the seven while being responsible for 29.4% (15-51) of the E-Train's runs in that span. Freeman has nine hits in 18 at-bats while slugging .722 in the first four games of this series.

BIG LEAGUE EXPERIENCE

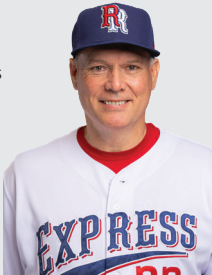

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2025 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's third season with the E-Train. In 2024, Davis secured his 800th win as a manager on July 12 at Reno. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided the E-Train to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 744-665 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
