LAST OUTING: Rodriguez had a tough luck loss in his last start on May 30 at Memphis. Locked in a 1-1 game late, he allowed a double in the seventh before exiting at 106 pitches. He was credited with the run scored after Rob Zastryzny gave up a two-run shot after his exit.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** This is Rodriguez's third career start against the Bats - all have come this season. He took the loss after giving up seven runs (all earned) in the series opener on April 23. He would later take his first win of the season in the finale on April 28 at Louisville Slugger Field.
