RIDERS FALL VIA WALK-OFF SINGLE TO NATUALS:

The Frisco RoughRiders held a 3-1 lead at one point but fell 5-4 to the Northwest Arkansas Naturals on a walk-off single in the ninth inning from Arvest Ballpark on Saturday night. For the second night in a row, the Naturals (24-38) scored a run in the first inning. This time, Morgan McCullough bashed a solo homer against Frisco (27-34) starter Jack Leiter. Leiter went 4.1 innings, allowing two runs on three hits while striking out from and walking four in his outing. The Riders took the lead in the third when **Thomas Saggese** crushed a two-run shot. It was Saggese's fifth home run of the road trip and his team-best ninth of the season. **Luisangel Acuña** then extended the Frisco lead to 3-1 and his hitting streak to 11 games in the fourth with an RBI single. The Naturals came from behind, scoring once in the fifth and twice in the sixth to take a 4-3 lead, but Frisco tied it in the eighth when **Nick Tanielu** scored on an error. After Jorge Bonifacio singled to lead off the ninth against **Michael Brewer** (1-2) and advanced to second on an error, he scored on the walk-off single by Tyler Cropley up the middle. In relief, Yefri Del Rosario (5-2) took home the win for the Naturals. **Dustin Harris** reached four times in the loss for Frisco, singling twice and walking twice.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has been hot lately, hitting safely in eight-straight games while batting .382 (13-for-34)/.432/.500/.932 with one double, one home run, four RBIs, five runs, three walks and a steal. Over the last seven games, he has raised his average from .200 to .231 and his OPS from .612 to .665.

OWEN THEM NOTHING, GIVING THEM EVERYTHING:

Pitcher **Owen White** was named Texas League Pitcher of the Week for the week of June 5-11. White took the hill for the RoughRiders on June 7 in Corpus Christi and tossed seven shutout innings to earn the win. White gave up just one hit to the 23 batters he faced, walking two and striking out six. Frisco won the game, 9-0. White now has three starts in which he has not allowed a run, earned or unearned. In seven of his 11 starts, he has allowed two runs or fewer. His ERA this season is 3.54 over 53.1 innings. Last year, White won the award in just his second start at the Double-A level. The former second-round selection in 2018 has a 3.24 ERA over 75 innings in Double-A. White made his MLB debut on Tuesday, allowing three runs over two innings with two strikeouts.

THOMAS IS BACK IN NWA

Thomas Saggese returns to Northwest Arkansas for the first time since his first week in Double-A in 2022, in which he won Texas League Player of the Week by battling .381 (8-for-21)/409/.857/1.266 with three doubles, two triples, a home run, nine RBIs, five runs scored with a steal and a walk. In the first five games of the series this year, he is hitting .409 (9-for-22)/.462/.727/1.189 with a double, a home run, three runs, six RBIs, two walks.

THE SPEAS THAT PLEASES:

Reliever **Alex Speas** now has an ERA under 1.00 at 0.79 over 20 appearances. In 23.2 innings, he has struck out 39 to 11 walks. Opponents are hitting just .134 against him and he has not allowed an earned run over his last 11 outings. During that span, he has struck out 24 to four walks over 13.1 innings. On the season, righties are just hitting .117 (7-for-60) against him on the season with a .377 OPS.

POWER SURGE

After only hitting two home runs over a two-week span, the RoughRiders have hit 13 long balls over their last 11 games. In the 11 games, Frisco is hitting .256/.359/.419/.778 with 21 doubles, 13 home runs and averaging 6.0 runs per game. **Luisangel Acuña** has led the way, hitting .340 (16-for-47)/.380/.532/.912 in the span while **Thomas Saggese** hit five home runs.

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, tied for first in the Texas League with a .600 average (12-for-20) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.619 OPS on the first pitch after homering on the first pitch on Saturday, which is second in the league. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .463 (19-for-41) on the initial offering while his 19 hits on the first pitch lead the league.

DUSTIN' THEM AND LEAVING THEM BEHIND:

Dustin Harris has been running wild for the RoughRiders this season. After stealing 19 bases in 85 games in 2022, Harris has already swiped 24 bags in 58 games this season. Harris is on pace for 54 steals, which would by far be a career high. **Luisangel Acuña** leads the league in steals with 28 and is on pace for a career-best 62 swipes. The RoughRiders are second in Texas League steals with 93 bases in 108 attempts (86 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on last Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)). Fixe oalso has a 1.101 OPS with the bags full, which is fourth in the minors (Low-A Myrtle Beach, 1.321 and Triple-A Saint Paul, 1.181, Double-A Somerset, 1.118).

ACUÑA MATATA

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .304 (70-for-230)/.369/.439/.808 through the first 53 games. Over his last 49 games, he is batting .316/.384/.462/.846. Acuña is riding an 11-game hitting streak, batting .346 (18-for-52). When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (116).

WALK THIS WAY

On the season, Frisco's 306 walks are tied for first among Texas League teams while their .354 team OBP is third in the Texas League. **Dustin Harris** is first in the league with 44 walks.

-White was drafted out of Jesse C. Carson High School in China Grove, North Carolina in 2018. He won the 2018 North Carolina Gatorade Player of the Year award, going 10-1 with a 0.22 ERA his senior year, striking out 101 over 63.2 innings. He also played shortstop and finished his career as the school's all-time record holder in hits, runs, RBIs, wins and strikeouts. Also played basketball and football (had some small-school

-Originally committed to the University of South Carolina before signing for \$1.5 million with the Rangers. Texas used the No. 15 pick on RHP Cole Winn (Rangers MiLB Pitcher of the Year in 2021 with the RoughRiders and signed him underslot to help sign White overslot. Was thought to be a two-way layer candidate if he

-2018 is the same draft as eight other former/current RoughRiders: RHP Cole Winn (1, 15), INF Jonathan Ornelas (3, 91), RHP Sean Chandler (6, 179), RHP Tim Brennan (7, 209), INF Jax Biggers (8, 239), LHP Grant Wolfram (18, 539), LHP Josh Smith (25, 749) and RHP Cole Uvila (40, 1199).

2023 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Opened the 2023 season with three shutout innings against Amarillo on April 7th. He was working his way back up from a neck injury that kept him out for a couple weeks during Spring Training.

-Threw first quality start for RoughRiders pitchers on April 25th at Amarillo, allowing three runs over six innings. He retired the first 10 he saw and allowed just one baserunner on a single through five innings.

-Threw his longest scoreless start in his professional career on June 7th at Corpus Christi when he fired 7.0 shutout innings, only allowing one hit. White finished with just 84 pitches, but was removed after the seventh. He won Texas League Pitcher of the Week for his efforts.

-Made MLB debut for Rangers in relief on 6/13/23 against the Angels. Went 2.0 IP, allowing three runs on four hits while striking out two and walking one. Was able to have 41 members of friends and family there for the debut.

2022 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 8 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Over his last three starts in Hickory, before being promoted to Frisco, White went 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA (4ER/19.0IP) while striking out 30 and just walking three over 19.0 innings.

-Recorded five quality starts over his 10 total starts, including a 7.0 innings, 1 ER, 11 K start on June 11th.

-With Hickory, owned a 45.8 percent groundball rate, 10th in the South Atlantic League. Also had a 16.4 percent swinging strike rate (3rd in SAL) and a 33.3 percent strikeout rate (4th).

-Was dominant in Double-A debut on June 25th, allowing one runs until an inherited run came across over

-Threw 5.1 hitless innings with seven strikeouts on July 1st against CC, winning Texas League Pitcher of the Week. Left game with left ankle injury, but was able to make next scheduled start. Riders lost no-hitter in 7th inning when Seth Nordlin allowed single, but Frisco won 5-0.

2021 SEASON

-Was Low-A Down East's Opening Day starer before punching the ground after an error and breaking his hand on May 4th. He returned to the Wood Ducks on August 10th.

-From The Athletic: "As soon as I did that, CY (general manager Chris Young) called me and basically said the Rangers have my back and they knew that it wasn't out of like hatred or trying to hurt myself," White explained on Monday. "It was more going out and competing and my emotions got the best of me at that moment in time. It's not like I came in the dugout and punched something at a locker, it was just — emotions got the best of me, I did what I did, and now I had to pay the consequence. But ..." White paused and nodded before giving a wry smile. "I promised them that I would never do it again."

-After making just nine outings on the season, he won Arizona Fall League "Pitcher of the Year", going 5-0 with a 1.91 ERA and 29 strikeouts over a league-best 28.1 innings.
