**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland A's, play the penultimate game in a six-game series against the division-leading Dayton Dragons, sending southpaw **Mac Lardner** – just signed by the Athletics on May 4th – to the mound in his Lugnuts debut against Dayton right-hander **Christian Roa**, the Dragons' 2021 Opening Day starter, making his first start of the year. The two teams have split the first four games of this series.

**Last Night: Dragons 6, Lugnuts 2.** **Lawrence Butler** homered and **Drew Swift** went 3-for-3, but Connor Phillips struck out nine batters in six three-hit innings and the Dragons snapped a two-game losing streak in front of 4,176 on Friday night. Lugnuts pitchers struck out a season high 15 batters, but Lugnuts batters struck out a season high 16 times. Jose Torres went 3-for-5 with a home run and three RBIs in the winning cause for the Dragons.

**On Deck:** The homestand wraps up tomorrow with a Capital City Market Kids Day featuring postgame Kids Run the Bases, and then the Lugnuts head on the road for two weeks, returning home May 31 to host Cedar Rapids.

**Among the MWL Leaders:** 3B **Brett Harris** ranks second in the Midwest League in OBP (.433), third in slugging (.598) and third in OPS (1.031). OF **Lawrence Butler** is fifth in the Midwest League with 19 walks, INF **Euribiel Angeles** is fourth with 35 hits, starter **Jeff Criswell** is tied for fifth with 30 innings pitched and fifth with a 0.83 WHIP, and reliever **Angello Infante** is tied for second with 11 appearances and tied for second with five saves.

**Transaction:** On Wednesday, Nuts placed infielder **Jack Winkler** on the Injured List (struck on the forearm by a pitch earlier in the series) and added pitcher **Mac Lardner**, who was signed as a free agent on May 4 after getting released by the Cardinals in May. Lardner, a former Gonzaga Bulldog signed as an undrafted free agent in 2020, spent last season with the Peoria Chiefs.

**In Need of Health:** With Winkler going on the Injured List, the Lugnuts now have eight players on the IL: pitchers **Charlie Cerny**, **Calvin Coker**, **Hogan Harris**, **Grant Holman** and **Jake Walkinshaw**, infielder Winkler and outfielders **Jonny Butler** and **Gabriel Maciel**.

**Go Green:** UT **Marty Bechina** joined the Lugnuts a week ago from Triple-A Las Vegas, becoming the second Spartan to play for the Lugnuts (joining 2011 outfielder Eli Boike). Bechina played four years at Michigan State University, where he competed against the Nuts in the 2016 and the 2017 Crosstown Showdowns. Bechina has excelled through six games with the Lugnuts, slashing .364/.500/.636 and reaching 14 times (8 hits, 4 walks, 2 HBP).

#### Athletics Farm Spotlight:

• **Double-A Midland:** DH **Jordan Diaz**, who excelled for the Lugnuts last year, went 3-for-4 with a double in the RockHounds' 9-5 win against Corpus Christi. Diaz is hitting .299/.356/.542 in 27 games, riding the crest of a red hot May (17-for-44, 6 2B, 4 HR, .386/.429/.795).

**165 Major League Nuts...** Infielder **Vinny Capra** (2018 in Lansing) debuted for the Blue Jays on May 1 and collected his first MLB hit last night. Capra is the 165th all-time Nut to reach the Majors and the fourth this year, joining A's relievers **Zach Logue** and **Zach Jackson** and Oakland infielder **Christian Lopes**.

**Talent Rich:** The Nuts boast the No. 1 prospect in the Athletics' organization in **Tyler Soderstrom**, a 20-year-old catcher drafted 26th overall in 2020 who is considered MLB Pipeline's No. 56 prospect in all of baseball. Soderstrom is one of seven Top 25 A's prospects on the roster, joining teenager **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 9) and **Euribiel Angeles** (No. 10), starting pitcher **Joey Estes** (No. 15), first baseman/outfielder **Lawrence Butler** (No. 17), pitcher **Jeff Criswell** (No. 18) and pitcher **Grant Holman** (No. 30).

## 26 PHIL POHL MANAGER

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2012:** With the Lugnuts leading 4-0 at Dayton in the sixth inning, the Dragons put runners at first and second with none out. Ryan Wright attempts to lay down a sacrifice bunt, but popped it up. Catcher Carlos Perez grabbed it out of the air (one out), fired to 2B Jon Berti to double off Juan Perez (two outs) and Berti relayed to 1B K.C. Hobson (three outs). The Nuts won, 4-2.  
**2018:** Kevin Smith delivered a superstar performance to beat the Dragons – a game-tying solo HR in the eighth and a walkoff RBI single in the ninth for a 4-3 win. He finished 3-for-4, raising his batting average to .387.
