LAST TIME OUT...

ROCHESTER, N.Y. (May 21, 2021) - In a game which featured four lead changes, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders out-lasted the Rochester Red Wings 9-8 on Saturday night at Frontier Field.

For the third straight day the RailRiders scored multiple runs in the first, this time taking a 2-0 lead on back-to-back RBI singles from Thomas Milone and Socrates Brito. They added another tally in the second on a solo home run from Estevan Florial and another in the third courtesy of an Andrew Velazquez RBI double.

Deivi Garcia allowed a solo home run to Daniel Palka in the bottom of the second, then surrendered three runs in the third. The right-hander gave up four runs on five hits in 2.1 innings, walking three and striking out two. Rochester briefly took a 5-4 lead in the bottom of the fifth when Palka scored on a sacrifice fly from Alec Keller against Albert Abreu. The RailRiders struck back in the sixth by sending 10 batters to the plate and scoring four runs to take an 8-5 advantage.

The Red Wings struck back in the bottom of the seventh with three runs against Trevor Lane to tie the game at 8-8. They were the first runs allowed by the left-hander this season. In the top of the ninth, Armando Alvarez led off with a single and advanced to second on a walk from Velazquez. On the seventh pitch of his at-bat, Kellin Deglan laced a single to left field to score Alvarez on a close play at the plate to give the RailRiders a 9-8 lead.

Rochester put the tying and winning runs on base in the bottom of the ninth, but Nick Goody (1-1) held on for the win. Dakota Bacus (0-2) received the loss. Deglan entered the game 0-for-10 at the plate on the season, and went 2-for-5 with a run scored and the game-winning RBI.

NEWS & NOTES

FAST OUT OF THE GATE: With their 13th win of the season in 17 games on Saturday, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders have kept themselves in elite company across minor league baseball. Entering play on Saturday there are five teams across minor league baseball with 13-4 records, with only Jacksonville at that mark among Triple-A teams. Within the Yankees organization, the Tampa Tarpons also are off to a 13-4 start to the season. Overall, the Yankees have the best organizational record in baseball (47-21, .691), a full 4.5 games better than Cleveland (32-24, .636). The RailRiders are off to their best start to a season since the 2009 SWB Yankees went 17-3 in the month of April.

MARATHON MEN: After Saturday night's 9-8 win over the Rochester Red Wings took 4 hours and 6 minutes to complete, the RailRiders have played three of the four longest 9-inning games in franchise history this season. In a cruel twist, Satuday's game also included a 10-minute delay for "wet grounds" at the start of the game. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre had not played a game lasting longer than four hours since Aug. 21, 2015 against Rochester, although that game lasted 14 innings. Before this season, there had never been a four hour 9-inning game in the RailRiders era (2013 - Pres.) of SWB baseball.

DINGER ALERT: After shattering the SWB franchise record with 212 home runs in 2019 (previously 164 in 1998), the RailRiders are at it again, hitting 27 home runs in their first 17 games this season. The

26 round-trippers hit by SWB puts the club in a tie for fourth place in Triple-A East with Gwinnett, trailing Durham (32), Charlotte (27) and Worcester (27). The RailRiders are tied for eighth in minor league baseball in home runs, and it is a true team effort, as only Chris Gittens (t-10th, 4) ranks in the top 15 in home runs in Triple-A East.

WALK-A-THON: Through 17 games this season, the RailRiders have drawn 101 walks, the most in all of Triple-A baseball. No other team in the minors' highest level has taken more than 94 bases on balls (Gwinnett). Overall, the RailRiders are 4th in all of minor league baseball in walks, with Tampa (Low-A, NYY) leading the way with 116 walks. SWB's team .375 OBP is best in the Triple-A East League, and ranks 5th across all levels of the minors. There are currently three teams in Triple-A East with team OBPs greater than .360. Rochester (.305) has the fourth-lowest OBP of the 20-team league. The team of the contraction of the 20-team league is the contraction of the contraction ofRed Wings also have the second-lowest team SLG (.345) in the circuit, and have a .650 team OPS, the second-lowest in all of Triple-A (Louisville, .622).

OH SAY CAN YOU GENESEE?: The current six-game road trip marks the one and only trip to Frontier Field for the RailRiders during the 2021 season, with the final 12 games against the Red Wings to be played in Moosic. Despite an all-time winning record against Rochester, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has historically struggled in Roc City, going only 1-7 last year and a combined 4-11 at Frontier Field in 2018 and 2019. In the RailRiders era (2013-Present), SWB has only one winning season in Rochester, when they went 4-3 in 2017. However, following today's contest, the 2021 season will officially be added to that list as the RailRiders have won 4 of 5 from the Red Wings to clinch a series victory. Including the four wins in 2021, SWB is 130-140 (.481) all-time in Rochester.

#SQUADUP: The RailRiders received three players this week from Double-A Somerset, and all three have made meaningful impacts in the series against Rochester. INFs Hoy Park, Brandon Wagner and OF Thomas Milone have combined to hit .339 (19-for-56) with 10 R, 4 2B, 1 HR, 11 RBIs, 12 BB, 17 K and 2 HBP. In Wednesday's 3-2 win over the Red Wings, Park and Milone drove in all three SWB runs, while all three have contributed strong play on the defensive end as well

LAST TIME OUT: Koerner allowed to solo home runs in 4.1 innings of work on Tuesday evening as the RailRiders scored an 11-6 win over the Rochester Red Wings in the series opener. Though he allowed a season-high five hits and two runs, he struck out four and left with an 8-2 lead. In throwing 72 pitches and lasting 4.1 innings, it was the right-hander's longest start of the season.

WELCOME BACK, KOERNER: After not playing in the 2020 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Brody Koerner returns to the RailRiders for his third season with the club. He has the distinction of being the longest-tenured pitcher on the team who has stayed within the Yankees organization, with 30 appearances (21 starts) spread out since the start of the 2018 season. Teammates Adam Warren (54 G), Nestor Cortes, Jr. (42 G) and Nick Goody (32 G) have all made more appearances with SWB than Koerner, but all have left the Yankees organization and have returned in 2021.

STAFF WORKHORSE: During the 2019 season, Koerner logged 138.2 innings between Double-A Trenton and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, tying him for most among Yankees minor leaguers (Miguel Yajure -- Charleston, Tampa). The right-hander also finished t-3rd in GS (22), 6th in AVG (.289) and Winning Percentage (4-8 combined), 7th in ERA (5.00) and WHIP (1.53), and 10th in K (109).

HEADING OVERSEAS: Following the 2019 season, Koerner left the country to play for the Gigantes del Cibao in the Dominican Winter League. It was the first time in his career that he played in a foreign winter league after the regular MiLB season. Koerner went 1-3 with a 2.17 ERA in seven starts with the Gigantes, striking out 21 and walking 17 in 29.0 innings. The right-hander was teammates with several former SWB RailRiders in the DWL, including Abíatal Avelino, Greg Bird, José DePaula, Anyelo Gómez and Adonis Rosa. Also appearing for the team were Wander Franco (No. 1 prospect in baseball) and Eloy Jimenez. Tonight's Syracuse Mets starter, Jesus Reyes, appeared in 17 games out of the bullpen for the Gigantes.
