## TODAY'S HEADLINES

**LAST GAME'S RESULT** - The St. Paul Saints and Toledo Mud Hens were suspended in the first inning in the final game before the All-Star break. The Mud Hens sent three batters to the plate and scored a run before the rain came down and the field became unplayable. The two teams will continue the game when the two teams meet next in Toledo from September 6-11.

**WE'RE ON A BREAK:** For the first time in the Saints franchise history as a Triple-A team, they enjoyed more than just one day off. The Saints, along with all the teams in the International League, had four days off for the Major League All-Star break from July 18-21. Triple-A doesn't have an All-Star break so it was some much needed downtime for the players.

**SHAWTY:** The shortest series the Saints have played as a Triple-A affiliate is a five-game series. Last season, the final two series of the season were five-games. All other series were six-games. This season, they played one five-game series against the Nashville Sounds because the final game was washed out. The three-game series against the Indianapolis Indians will be their shortest series in franchise history. They will also play a three-game series to end the season at home against Omaha.

**GO TO YOUR HOME:** Jermaine Palacios is quietly having a solid season for the Saints. His 41 runs are third most on the team. He currently has the longest active run scoring streak in the International League, scoring in six consecutive games. Earlier this season, he tied his career high by scoring a run in seven straight from May 20-27.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The St. Paul Saints collected another double on July 16 vs. Toledo. Overall, the Saints have collected 167 doubles, tied for sixth in Triple-A and tied for 10th in all of Minor League Baseball.

**RISPY (WITH 2 OUTS) BUSINESS:** The St. Paul Saints another run with two outs on Saturday night. With RISP/2 outs this season, opponents are hitting .283 against the Saints, third worst in all of Minor League Baseball. Tacoma has the highest average at .308, El Paso is second at .294.

**WELCOME TO THE SHOW:** Caleb Hamilton is having a career year, setting a career high in home runs with 10 and in the midst of an impressive streak of eight consecutive games with an extra base hit. He won't be adding to those totals because for the first time in his career, Hamilton had his contract selected and was promoted to the Minnesota Twins. Catcher Ryan Jeffers went on the injured list and Hamilton went up on July 15. In his first Major League at bat he grounded on Sunday vs. the White Sox Joe Kelly.

**FIRST INNING FLOP:** The St. Paul Saints have allowed at least one run in the first inning in 37 of 88 games (42.1%) the Saints have allowed at least a run in the first inning. They have allowed 76 runs in the first, most in the International League and fifth most in all of Minor League Baseball behind Albuquerque (91), Stockton (85), Visalia (78), and Binghamton (77). Their 19 home runs allowed are tied for sixth most in Minor League Baseball

**EXTRA EXTRA READ ALL ABOUT IT:** The St. Paul Saints have played 88 games this season and have an extra base hit in all, but one game. They have an extra base hit in 80 consecutive games, the second longest streak in all of Minor League Baseball. The only team with a longer streak is El Paso's 90 game streak, which is also active. The lone game they didn't collect an extra base hit was the game they were no-hit on April 13 vs. Indianapolis. They have just one extra base hit in only 10 games.

**FINAL FOUR:** The St. Paul Saints are a part of the final four, but not a final four they care to be included in. The Saints have yet to throw a shutout in 2022. They are one of only four Minor League teams that have yet to throw a shutout. They are joined by the Chattanooga Lookouts in the Southern League, Columbia Fireflies, and the Visalia Rawhide in the California League. The Saints 5.32 ERA in the third highest of the four teams. Chattanooga's ERA is the best at 5.10, Columbia has a 5.27 while Visalia is 5.95. The Charlotte Knights and Delmarva Shorebirds took their names off the list with a shutout on July 10.

**WE BELIEVE THE PROSPECTS ARE OUR FUTURE:** On July 7, Spencer Steer was chosen to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium. Steer is one of two Minnesota Twins Minor Leaguers to be chosen. He joins newly promoted outfielder Matt Wallner. Steer is the first Saints player chosen to the Futures Game. Josh Winder, who was chosen in 2021, was called up to the Saints two days before the announcement, but hadn't pitched for the Saints. Wallner delivered in the game going 1-2 with a home run while Steer was 0-2.

**TWINS UPDATE** - The Minnesota Twins lost the finale of their series against the Chicago White Sox on Sunday at Target Field, 11-0. They managed just one hit, an Alex Kirilloff fifth inning single. Chris Archer went 4.2 innings allowing four runs on five hits while striking out five.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** 7/13 vs. TOL...pitched 4.0+ innings allowing three runs on seven hits, giving up one home run, while walking two and striking out four...received the loss in an 8-2 Mud Hens victory.

**APPEARANCE PRIOR:** 7/7 @ LOU...pitched 4.0 shutout innings of relief allowing four hits and striking out four...received his first Triple-A win in a 5-4 Saints victory.

**KKKKK:** Ronny Henriquez set a season high by fanning 8 Indianapolis Indians on May 28 at CHS Field. What was more impressive is he struck out six consecutive hitters: the last batter of the second, the side in the third and the first two in the fourth. The six consecutive strikeouts tied a franchise high set by Joe Ryan on August 20, 2021 vs. Iowa Cubs.

**SIX DEGREES OF CARLOS CORREA:** On March 12, 2022, Ronny Henriquez was traded to the Minnesota Twins along with SS Isiah Kiner-Falefa in exchange for catcher Mitch Garver. Kiner-Falefa was then flipped, along with 3B Josh Donaldson and C Ben Rortvedt, to the New York Yankees for C Gary Sanchez and 3B Gio Urshela. That trade helped get rid of Donaldson's large contract. The Twins then went out and signed SS Carlos Correa.

**BUT WHAT DOES THE AP TOP 25 SAY:** Following the trade to the Twins, Henriquez immediately made his mark within the organizations Top 30 prospects. MLB Pipeline has him ranked #14 while Baseball America lists him at #28. In the Texas Rangers system, MLB Pipeline had him ranked #30 in 2019, #17 in 2020. Baseball America had him ranked #10 in 2020 and #15 in 2021.

**QUITE THE FIRST IMPRESSION:** In his first appearance for the St. Paul Saints on April 21 @ Toledo, Henriquez came on in relief of Devin Smeltzer to start the sixth inning. He promptly struck out the first two hitters he faced and then got a fly out to end the inning. To start the seventh, he walked the leadoff man, but retired the final six batters he faced getting two more strikeouts.

**BRINGING THE HEAT:** While his fastball has been clocked in the high 90s, the strikeout has been a big part of Henriquez' game. In his first three professional seasons, he has never had a strikeout per nine inning ratio of less than 10.1. In his first three seasons he's gone 12.3, 10.9 and 10.1 strikeouts per nine.

**IN THE YEAR 2000:** As the years go on more and more players that play for the Saints will be born in 2000 or later, but for now Henriquez is just the second player ever to don a Saints uniform and be born in 2000. Infielder Daniel Ozoria joined the Saints from Single-A Fort Myers on May 11, 2021. He was born on August 24, 2000 becoming the first player born in 2000 to play for the Saints. Henriquez is just about two months older than Ozoria born on June 20, 2000.
