ROUGHRIDERS OUTLASTED BY SOD POODLES 4-3:

The Frisco RoughRiders were dealt a 4-3 loss to the Amarillo Sod Poodles on Saturday night from Riders Field in a game that featured six combined runs in the final three innings. The Sod Poodles (4-10) struck first in the top of the fourth inning when Jose Fernandez ripped an RBI double to give Amarillo a 1-0 lead. The RoughRiders (9-5) threatened in the bottom of the seventh inning. With two outs and the bases loaded, **Ian Moller** stung a two-run single to give Frisco a 2-1 lead. Amarillo then took the lead on a two-run single by Fernandez and an RBI single by Jean Walters in the bottom of the eighth. Down to their final two outs, Frisco provided life when **Aaron Zavala** tagged a solo home run in the bottom of the ninth inning, his first of the season. But Sod Poodles reliever Zane Russell retired two of his final three batters to grab the save. Connor Grammes (1-0) earned the win in 0.2 innings of relief in the bottom of the seventh inning. Riders reliever **Skylar Hales** (0-1) took the loss, allowing Amarillo's three runs in the top of the eighth. Amarillo starter Roman Angelo earned the quality start, spinning 6.1 innings of one-run ball. RoughRiders starter **Mitch Bratt** dealt five strong innings, allowing just one run and fanning six.

A RETURN TO REMEMBER:

Janser Lara had a great night on paper against Amarillo on Friday, but it meant even more. Over his two shutout innings, he allowed just one base runner on a walk, pitching in affiliated baseball for the first time since 2018. The 28-year-old originally signed with the Royals, pitching with Low-A Lexington in 2018 as his highest stop. After pitching in the Nicaraguan Winter League in the offseason, he signed with the Rangers in January.

FLYING THE COOP:

Cooper Johnson has started out well in 2025 on both offense and defense. At the plate, he is hitting .276/.417/.655/1.072 with two doubles, three home runs, six RBIs, seven walks and five runs scored. He is tied for the league lead with three homers while being tied for fourth in both SLG and OPS. On defense, Johnson leads the Texas League with six caught stealings behind the plate, throwing out six of seven base runners against him. His 86 percent caught-stealing rate is the best in MiLB currently.

SEVENTH INNING STRETCH THE LEAD:

For whatever reason, the RoughRiders have been fantastic on offense in the seventh inning this season. They are leading the Texas League with 19 runs scored in the seventh, while slashing .344/.476/.508/.984. In the seventh, they have walked 15 times to 11 strikeouts as a team.

POWER BRINGS WINS:

The RoughRiders have shown off their punch to begin the season and have been amazing on offense during their first 14 games. Frisco's 16 home runs through 14 games are second in the Texas League. They are first in BA (.264), first in SLG (.427) and first in OPS (.790). **Josh Hatcher** and **Cooper Johnson** have both hit three home runs, tied for the league lead. Over this stretch where they have won seven of their last 10 games, Frisco is hitting .273/.371/.456/.827, all of which are first in the Texas League, while also ranking first in runs per game (6.6) and home runs (13).

HATCHIN' HITTIN':

Josh Hatcher was incredible for the RoughRiders in 2024 and he has picked up right where he left off in 2025. Hatcher hit .300/.350/.448/.798 over 107 games with Frisco last season. He was one of just three qualified hitters in all of Double-A baseball to hit .300 or better. To start 2025, he reached safely in all 10 of 11 games he's played in, batting .417 (20-for-48)/.412/.667/1.079 with three doubles, three home runs, nine RBIs, a stolen base and eight runs scored over his first 11 games. His .417 batting average is fourth in all of Minor League Baseball. Hatcher already has six multi-hit games and is 6-for-7 when putting the first pitch of an at-bat in play with two home runs. Hatcher's 18 hits were the most by a Texas Leaguer through the first eight team games since five-year Major Leaguer Jesus Guzman had 19 with Midland in 2008.

VERSUS THE SOD POODLES:

A season ago, the RoughRiders went 16-8 against Amarillo and showed off their offensive might against the Diamondbacks affiliate. The Riders as a team hit .292/.351/.494/.845 with 37 home runs in 24 games. Their 37 homers were the most against a single team since 2022, when they hit 47 in 18 games against Amarillo. **Keyber Rodriguez** crushed them in 16 games, batting .367/.433/.617/1.050 with 19 RBIs. **Josh Hatcher** (seven) and **Abimelec Ortiz** (six) both bashed six or more homers against the Sod Poodles as well.

ABIME-LECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz ended the year on fire for the RoughRiders. In his last 48 games, Ortiz hit .321/.413/.592/1.005 with nine doubles, 13 home runs, 38 RBIs, 37 runs scored and 28 walks. After July 10th, in those 48 games, he is fourth in average (.321), first in OPS (1.005), tied for first in RBIs (38) and first in home runs (13). During that span, he paced all of Double-A in OPS as well. In his last 29 games, he batted .364 (40-for-110)/.470/.710/1.170 with five doubles, 10 home runs, 30 RBIs, 21 walks, 24 strikeouts and 27 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. After, he hit .307 with a .954 OPS, raising his batting average to .243 and a .760 OPS. Ortiz clubbed his first home run of the season on Wednesday.

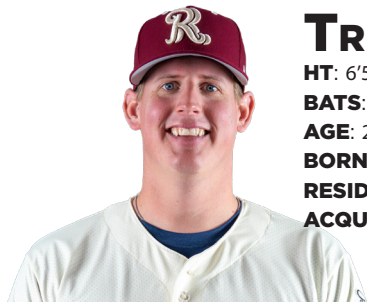

ABOUT TREY

-Pronounced SHOE-pock. Full name is Treyson Thomas Supak. Was named Treyson because he was the third child and "trey" stood for "three".

-Born in Bryan, Texas, but grew up in La Grange, Texas (La Grange didn't have a hospital). At La Grange High School, he starred in football, basketball and baseball and became the first player drafted from LGHS since Homer Bailey in 2004.

-Committed to University of Houston before signing with Pittsburgh. His uncle Jody was an All-American at Houston and was drafted by Detroit in 1987.

-Was drafted by the Pirates in the CB-B round of 2014.

2025 SEASON

-Allowed just one run through first two 5.0-inning starts.

2024 SEASON

-Spent time between Double-A Tennessee and Triple-A Iowa.

2023 SEASON

-Split time between Double-A Midland and Triple-A Las Vegas. Against Frisco in 2023, he made three appearances out of the bullpen (3.1 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 2 ER, 3 BB, 3 K), allowing a home run to Dustin Harris.

2021-2022 SEASON

-After electing free agency in Nov. of 2020, signed with the A's organization 18 days later.

-Missed the entire season and most of 2022 with "Tommy John" Surgery. Returned to make three starts with Midland that season.

2020 SEASON

-Was called up from the Taxi Squad to the MLB roster in 2020 for three days and was sent back down without making an appearance.

2019 SEASON

-Finished the season as the No. 11 prospect in the Brewers organization by MLB.com.

-When he made his Triple-A debut with San Antonio, it was 1.5 hours from hometown, so he had 40-50 friends and family there. "I have never had a feeling like that heading out to the mound."

-With Double-A Biloxi, won Southern League Most Outstanding Pitcher after leading the league in ERA (2.20), opponent batting average (.192) and tying for the lead in wins (11).

2014-2018 SEASON

-In December of 2015, he was traded to Milwaukee from Pittsburgh along with Keon Broxton in exchange for Jason Rogers.
