TODAY'S GAME: The Memphis Redbirds continue a 12-game road trip and six-game series at the Iowa Cubs (Triple-A, Chicago Cubs) on Saturday night at Principal Park in Des Moines, Iowa. Left-handed pitcher Bruce Zimmermann is slated to start game four of the series for Memphis opposite right-handed pitcher Paul Campbell for Iowa.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: The Memphis Redbirds continued a six-game series and 12-game road trip with an 8-4 win over the Iowa Cubs (Triple-A, Chicago Cubs) on Friday night at Principal Park. The Memphis bats jumped on Iowa pitching early. The Redbirds rallied for five runs in the first inning, hallmarked by third baseman Blaze Jordan RBI single and a shortstop Brody Moore two-run double. Jordan extended his team lead in base hits to 52 with a three-hit night. Center fielder Colton Ledbetter also added a 3-for-5 day with a double, an RBI and a run scored. Starting pitcher Quinn Mathews allowed four runs on four hits, walked four and struck out four across 4.2 innings pitched. Luis Gastelum, Chris Roycroft, Ryan Murphy (1-0) and Scott Blewett combined to finish the final 4.1 innings scoreless in relief. Murphy earned his first career Triple-A victory with his 2.0 perfect innings and four strikeouts. With the win, Memphis held a 1.0-game lead over the Nashville Sounds (Triple-A, Milwaukee Brewers) for first place in the International League standings. The Redbirds have spent every day of the 2026 season in at least a tie for first place.

FIRST TO 30 WINS IN TRIPLE-A: Last night's victory over Iowa moved Memphis to 30 wins on the 2026 season, the first Triple-A club to reach the mark this season. The Redbirds were bested by just the Eugene Emeralds (High-A, San Francisco Giants), who currently sit with 33 wins on the season, to the 30-win mark this season. The Redbirds were the first MiLB team to the 20 and 25 win marks and first professional baseball franchise to reach 10 wins.

NOT A DAY OUTTA FIRST: Thanks to a franchise-best 7-0 start to the 2026 season and steady play since, the Memphis Redbirds have yet to spend a day of the season outside of at least a share of first place in the International League. Memphis enters Saturday night's game at the Iowa Cubs (Triple-A Chicago Cubs) atop the International League Standings with a 1.0-game lead over the Nashville Sounds (Triple-A, Milwaukee Brewers) and Rochester Red Wings (Triple-A, Washington Nationals) and 2.5 games above the Louisville Bats (Triple-A, Cincinnati Reds), and 3.0 games in front of the Gwinnett Stripers (Triple-A, Atlanta Braves) and Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (Triple-A Miami Marlins). 3.0 games currently separates the top six teams in the International League standings. There are eight teams within 4.0 games of first and 11 within 5.0 games. Following the 12-game road trip at the Iowa Cubs (Triple-A, Chicago Cubs) and Omaha Storm Chasers (Triple-A, Kansas City Royals), Memphis returns home for an important six-game series against Louisville. Memphis has not won any International League (or Triple-A East) title since leaving the Pacific Coast League ahead of the 2021 season. The last Redbirds league title came in 2018.

MANAGER BEN JOHNSON

Ben Johnson enters his eighth season as manager of the Memphis Redbirds and his eighth year in the Cardinals organization.

COACHING CAREER

- Became the all-time winningest manager in franchise history on May 21, 2025 (368 wins)
- 428 - 435 managerial record entering 2025 season, including postseason.
- Oversaw a franchise record 15-game winning streak in 2021 (7/9-7/25); tied for longest in MiLB that season
- Oversaw a franchise record 200 home runs in 2019; team won 29 of final 40 games and were in contention for division until 2nd to last day of the season
- Spent 2018 as third base coach for the Durham Bulls (Rays' Triple-A)
- Spent 2014-2017 as a scout in the Arizona Diamondbacks organization
- Coached at Millenium HS in Goodyear, AZ from 2011-2013
- Previously managed Arizona Centennials in the Independent League in 2012

PLAYING CAREER

- Drafted by the Cardinals in the 4th Rd. of 1999 Draft; traded to Padres in 2000
- Made MLB debut on June 26, 2005 with the Padres; played 98 games over next three seasons with the Padres and Mets
- Named Padres Minor League Player of the Year in 2005 when he hit a career-high .312 with 25 home runs and 83 RBIs as a member of the Portland Beavers
- Played 901 MiLB games over 10 seasons with Cardinals, Padres, Mets and Tigers; hit .262 with 115 career home runs and 473 RBIs

PERSONAL

- Born in Memphis and played baseball at Germantown HS; named Memphis-area HS Player of the Year in 1999; lives with his dad during the season
- He and his wife, Elizabeth, have two children, Ethan and Ruby; reside in Phoenix, AZ

PITCHING COACH DARWIN MARRERO

- Marrero is beginning his 14th season in the Cardinals organization and fourth with Memphis.

COACHING CAREER

- Joined the Memphis Redbirds coaching staff following five seasons (2018-22) with Double-A Springfield Marrero's career with St. Louis began as pitching coach for the Gulf Coast League Cardinals (Rookie) from 2013-14, followed by the same role with the State College Spikes (Class-A) from 2015-17.

PLAYING CAREER

- Marrero's playing career spanned seven seasons from 1998-2004 with the Montreal Expos organization, attaining his highest level at Double-A with the Harrisburg Senators in 2002 and 2004.

HITTING COACH HOWIE CLARK

- Clark is beginning his fourth season in the Cardinals organization and fourth with Memphis

COACHING CAREER

- In 2015, Clark was named the hitting coach of the Delmarva Shorebirds, the Class-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. In February 2017, Clark was named the assistant hitting coach for the Orioles. He was named hitting coach of the Charlotte Knights, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, for the 2020 season. [9] On December 1, 2020, Clark was named assistant hitting coach for the Chicago White Sox.

PLAYING CAREER

- Clark played parts of six seasons in MLB with the Baltimore Orioles, Minnesota Twins and Toronto Blue Jays from 2002 to 2008.
