Leading Off

Today, Reading and Portland conclude this week's six-game series, as well as the first-half of the 2023 season. Tyler Phillips and CJ Liu will square off in a rematch of Tuesday night's game. Reading leads the series 3-2 and is looking for its second series win of the season.

Looking Back

Reading fell for the second-straight night last night in a 4-2 final. It was a bullpen game for the R-Phils and Adam Leverett was strong over three innings of work. Johan Rojas drove home an early run and Nick Podkul blasted a solo home run over the Maine Monster, but it was not enough. Podkul and Matthew Kroon both had two hits in the defeat.

History for De La Cruz

Carlos De La Cruz now holds the longest on-base streak by an R-Phil, dating back to 2009. A hit and two walks last night increased his streak to 37 games, which dates back to May 12. Tuesday, he passed Cameron Perkins mark of 33 set in 2014.

Can't Stop Johan

So far in This series, Rojas has had a four hit/three stolen base game Tuesday, was featured on SportsCenter with a home run robbing catch Wednesday, and had six-straight multi-hit games before an 0-3 game Friday night. Overall, Rojas is hitting a team-best .321 this season.

Amongst the League Leaders

Johan Rojas leads the Eastern League in runs scored with 49 and Carlos De La Cruz is second with 48. Rojas is third in the league in hitting at .322 and Matthew Kroon is fourth at .321; while De La Cruz is seventh at .300. Rojas is first in the league in hits with 88 and De La Cruz is tied for third with 80 hits. De La Cruz is also tied for third in the league with 14 home runs on the season.

Clean Slate

After today, the first half of the season comes to an end and Reading will be back to 0-0. After off days Monday and Tuesday this week, the R-Phils open a six-game series against the Richmond Flying Squirrels at home from Wednesday through next Monday, July 3.

Around the Organization

The Phillies fell to the Mets 4-2 yesterday and finish their three-game series this afternoon at home. Lehigh Valley succombed a lead late and fell to Worcester 8-7 at Polar Park. Jersey Shore won over Rome last night thanks to a strong start from Jordan Fowler. Finally, Clearwater beat Dunedin 5-2 to imrpove to 2-0 in the second half as Justin Crawford stole his 32nd base of the season.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 25, 2006: At Reading, the Phils pound New Britain, 14-2, as Matt Padgett and Brandon Gemoll each deliver three hits. Padgett doubles, homers and scores three runs while Gemoll scores three times. Gary Burnham goes 2-for-5 with four RBI.

This is the second series of the season between Reading and Portland, with both at Hadlock Field. The Sea Dogs are 2.5 games back of Somerset in the standings, giving the Patriots the first-half crown, which they clinched Friday night. Erie clinched the Southwest Division last night as well. Last week, Portland went 3-3 at Binghamton and next week, the Sea Dogs begin the second half at New Hampshire.

Dog on the Mound

Righty CJ Liu will get the ball tonight for Portland. It is Liu's 14th start of the season and he is 4-5 with a 4.35 ERA. Over 60 innings, Liu has allowed 59 hits and 32 walks, with 69 strikeouts. Liu was signed as an internation free agent out of Taiwan in 2019. He split 2022 between Greenville and Portland, combining to go 4-11 with a 6.06 ERA over 26 games and 22 starts. In 2021 he split time between Salem and the Red Sox rookie level team. Liu suffered the loss to Reading Tuesday, allowing three-earned runs on five hits over four innings pitched.
