### <u>TEEING OFF</u>

**COLUMBIA TAKES THE DOUBLEHEADER:** The Augusta GreenJackets return to SRP Park got off to a tough start on Wednesday night as they were swept in a doubleheader by their I-20 rivals. Despite two home runs from Cal Conley, Columbia used three home runs of their own to take game one 4-3. The Fireflies rallied from 4-2 down in the sixth by scoring six runs as they went on to complete the sweep with a 9-4 victory.

**CONLEY BRINGS THE POWER:** Cal Conley went yard twice in the opening match up of the doubleheader on Wednesday and he continues to torment Fireflies pitching in 2022. In 17 games against Columbia, Conley is batting .314 with 6 home runs and 19 RBIs. The Augusta shortstop has also scored 19 times in the season-series.
