Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the finale in a six-game home-and-home series opposite the Fort Wayne TinCaps, the High-A affiliate of the San Diego Padres, the last of three games in the Summit City. The Nuts took two of three from the TinCaps at home, including a victory on the 3rd of July in front of 9,917.

Last Night: Lugnuts 9, TinCaps 3. The series shifted from Michigan to Indiana, and the fortunes of the two teams shifted with it. After scoring only seven runs in three games in Lansing, the TinCaps tallied three runs in the 1st and five runs in the 4th against Jacob Watters en route to victory. Will Simpson homered in defeat.

On the Air: Today's game is on MiLB TV and Bally Live, with a Lugnuts audio stream via StreamGuys, Adam Jaksa and Jesse Goldberg-Strassler on the call.

On Deck: The Midwest League rests up the next two days, and then Lansing travels to Lake County to open a six-game series with the Captains leading into the four-day Major League Baseball All-Star Break.

**Finishing Things Up:** This is the final game that Lansing will play at Fort Wayne this season (though the TinCaps do come to Michigan's state capital at the end of August).

Calling Roll: The Lugs have used 40 players this season, 20 position players and 20 pitchers (including 13 different starters).

Off the Skids: Last night marked the first time in the last nine appearances that the Nuts won a game in which the tandem of Blaze Pontes and Will Johnston pitched; the last time Lansing triumphed with Pontes/Johnston on the mound, it was May 14.

Fort Wayne Familiarity: The Lugnuts' offense includes four players in Euribiel Ángeles, Jonny Butler, Brayan Buelvas and Sahid Valenzuela who have played for the ballclub each of the last three seasons (with Butler seeing action in each of the last four seasons, while Ángeles was a member of the TinCaps to end 2021).

Congratulations! Earlier this week it was announced that Lugnuts right-hander Luis Morales, the youngest player on the team, will serve as the sole representative for the Oakland A's in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game a week from today on July 13 at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas. Morales, the Athletics' No. 1 pitching prospect and No. 2 overall prospect, becomes the 5th active Nut in team history to participate in the Futures Game, joining Denzel Clarke (2022), Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (2017) and Ángel Perdomo (2016).

**Prospecting:** Lansing has four MLB Pipeline Top 30 Athletics prospects on its roster: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2, and the A's No. 1 pitching prospect), infielder **Will Simpson** (No. 24), southpaw **Will Johnston** (No. 27), who is expected to pitch tonight in relief, and outfielder **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 29).

What a Crowd! The Nuts' 9,917 attendance on July 3 was the largest crowd in not just the Midwest League, but in all of Class A+ this season. It topped all but one Class A team (Fresno), all but one Class AA team (Frisco), and was larger than 14 Class AAA teams.

**2011:** Casey Lawrence came one out from a CG ShO, pitching 8 2/3 innings before yielding to Bryan Longpre for the final out in an 11-0 rout of West Michigan at Cooley Law School Stadium. Bryson Namba had two singles, two walks and four runs scored; Marcus Knecht went 3-for-4 with a two-run HR; and leadoff hitter Michael Crouse was 2-for-4 with a walk, a three-run HR and five RBIs.

**2017:** Bo Bichette (1-for-2, 2 BB, .384) and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. (1-for-4, HR No. 7, .316), played their final game with the Lugnuts before departing, first to the MLB Futures Game in Miami during MLB All-Star Break, and then to A-Advanced Dunedin with a promotion. The Lugnuts lost at home to West Michigan, 3-2.

No-Hit History: On June 13, tossed five hitless innings, walking two and striking out six, before handing the baton to Grant Judkins (2 2/3) and then Colton Johnson (1 1/3) as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 no-hitter of the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first home no-hitter since April 2003.


Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands thus all root for Boston-area teams.

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Path to Lansing: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings... opened 2023 pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of California League Pitcher of the Week with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... dominated in Lugnuts debut May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win.

**In a Nutshell:** After not pitching in 2023, dominated in Stockton to open the season, earning promotion to Lansing May 29 and making his Lugnuts debut in Game 2 of a doubleheader on June 2, becoming the 942nd all-time Lugnut and the 13th different starting pitcher this season... name is pronounced "Chen Jong-Ow Jwahng"... works with interpreter Yen Po "Rambo" Wang... nicknamed "Z."

**First Start:** Struggled in the first inning vs. Peoria, allowing three runs on two walks and three hits, including a two-out, two-run triple by Michael Curialle... set down the final ten batters faced, with five strikeouts, in a 5-3 Lugnuts seven-inning victory.

**Temporarily Inactive List:** Inactive from June 28-July 4, returning to Taiwan in connection to compulsory military enlistment.

**Hometown Heroes:** Giants pitcher Kai-Wei Teng is the only 2024 Major Leaguer from Taiwan, though Teng is currently with the Sacramento River Cats... there have been 17 Major Leaguers all-time from Taiwan, the first being Chin-Feng Chen of the Dodgers, who played from 2002-2005... the Yankees' Chien-Ming Wang (2005-09, 2011-13, 2016) has the most career wins (68), the Orioles/Marlins' Wei-Yin Chen (2012-19) has the most career innings pitched (1,064 2/3), and Cleveland's Yu Chang (2019-23) has the most offensive records, from games played (235) to runs (72) to hits (121) to homers (20).

Record-Setters: In Lugnuts franchise history, the first Taiwanese players were Po-Hsuan Keng, who pitched primarily out of the bullpen for the Nuts from 2005-2007, and Chi-Hung Chen, who a starting pitcher in 2005-06 and 2008... last year, Brock Whittlesey broke Keng's franchise record of most career appearances... Whittlesey pitched in 103 games from 2021-23, while Keng appeared in 94...
