Today's Game: The Sounds take on the Bats in game three of the six-game series tonight. Nashville has dropped the first two games of the series and will send left-hander Aaron Ashby to the bump for game three. He will go up against right-hander Carson Spiers for Louisville.

Aaron Ashby: The 25-year-old lefty is making his fourth start for the Sounds and fifth start overall this season. In three starts thus far for Nashville, Ashby is 0-1 with a 9.28 ERA (10.2 IP/11 ER), 10 walks and 10 strikeouts. In his lone start for the Brewers, he allowed eight runs (four earned) across 3.2 innings at Cincinnati. In his last start against Omaha, he went 3.1 innings, allowing two hits, one earned run, five walks and struck out five. In 26 appearances (17 starts) in Triple-A, Ashby is 5-6 with a 5.59 ERA (75.2 IP/47 ER) with 111 strikeouts. His 8.44 K/9 this season is well below his career Triple-A average of 13.2 K/9. His 14.0 innings pitched this season for Nashville and Milwaukee is already double his combined innings from last season (7.0 IP). At 21.94 P/IP, Ashby averages the most amount of pitches per inning thus far for the Sounds.

Carson Spiers: The 26-year-old righty is making his fifth appearance (fourth start) this season. In four appearances at Triple-A, Spiers has a 3.50 ERA (18.0 IP/7 ER) with eight walks and 15 strikeouts. His lone start for Cincinnati came on April 9 against Milwaukee the day after Ashby's only appearance with Milwaukee. He pitched 4.0 innings in long relief allowing seven hits, four runs (three earned), three walks and had one strikeout. Spiers last start was at Iowa on April 19 where he pitched 4.2 scoreless innings, allowing four hits, four walks and had three strikeouts. In 2023, he had four appearances (two starts) at the big league level in 2023 (0-1, 3.60 ERA), one appearance at Triple-A (1-0, 0.00 ERA) and 28 appearances (nine starts) for Double-A Chattanooga (8-3, 3.69 ERA). At Double-A, he had 106 strikeouts in 83.0 innings of work. He was signed by the Reds on June 23, 2020 from the University of Clemson.

Bobby Petrol: Robert Gasser made his first start of the season for the Sounds yesterday. He went 4.0 innings, four hits, one earned run, one walk and five strikeouts on only 49 pitches. Gasser now has nine consecutive starts without allowing more than three earned runs and has struck out at least five batters in nine of his last 10 starts. He is the No. 5 prospect in the Brewers system per MLB Pipeline. He earned the International League Pitcher of the Year award after going 9-1 with a 3.79 ERA in 26 games (25 starts). His 166 strikeouts last season were the most in the International League since Michael Kopec struck out 170 with the Charlotte Knights in 2018. Gasser has a seven-decision winning streak, having not taken a loss since May 25, 2023 vs. Iowa last season. He held left-handed batters to a .215 average (26-for-121) with just seven extra-base hits.

Ouch! The Sounds were hit by a season-high three pitches in yesterday's contest. Brewer Hicklen left the series opener after being hit by a pitch on his knee. The Sounds rank fifth in Triple-A with 17 hit-by-pitches on the season. Tyler Black and Chavez Young have been plunked three times to lead the team. The last time the Sounds were hit by three pitches in a game was on June 25, 2023 at home against Norfolk.

Bulpen Beat: Despite being charged with the loss, the Sounds bullpen was stellar again yesterday. In 4.0 innings, the pen allowed three hits, one earned run, two walks and struck out three. They continue to lead all of Triple-A in ERA (2.40), WHIP (1.02) and batting average against (.163). The next closest bullpen ERA is Sacramento at 3.67. The pen also ranks fifth in Triple-A in K/BB ratio at 2.50.

Clutch Factor: Isaac Collins had the only extra-base hit for the Sounds yesterday. He ranks third on the team in total bases (33), RBI (12) and runs scored (11). With runners on base, Collins is batting .387 (12-for-31) with a .774 slugging percentage. Additionally, he holds the longest streak without an error by a Sounds outfielder this season at 16 games.

I Noah Guy: Utility player Noah Campbell was transferred to Nashville on Tuesday and is 2-for-5 with an RBI in the series. He also added two outfield assists yesterday while playing right field. Campbell was batting .324 (12-for-37) with the Shuckers at the time of his promotion. He hit .217 (18-for-83) with 12 RBI in 32 games with the Sounds last season.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 694-595 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,286-2,115 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.

LAST OUTING: Ashby last pitched on April 18 versus Omaha. He went 3.1 innings, two hits, one earned run, five walks and struck out four.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Ashby has two career appearances (one start) against Louisville and has taken the loss in both games. In the first appearance on July 3, 2021, he came in relief in the seventh inning and allowed six hits, seven runs (five earned) in 0.2 innings of work. In his lone start versus Louisville on July 17, 2021 he faced off against current Reds starter Hunter Greene. Ashby went 3.0 innings, four hits, three earned runs, one walk and struckout five.
