San Jose Giants (8-5) RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (7-6)





LHP Jacob Bresnahan (0-0, 7.88 ERA) vs. RHP Christian Zazueta (0-1, 6.14 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field! Your first-place Quakes continue a six-game set against the San Jose Giants (SF) today with game five of the series. Fans will enjoy post-game Fireworks tonight, thanks to Children's Dental FunZone. Game time is 6:30pm. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE GIANTS: Today's game is the fifth of 18 games against the Giants and the fifth of 12 here at home. The Quakes are currently 2-2 against the Giants. Rancho was 7-5 against the Giants in 2024, 4-2 here at LoanMart Field. **LAST GAME:** The Giants got a two-run triple from Robert Hipwell in the sixth inning for the only runs of the game, as San Jose shut out Rancho Cucamonga on Friday night, 2-0 at LoanMart Field. Hipwell's game-winning hit came off Marco Corcho (1-1), who had come on three batters earlier in the sixth, after Quakes' starter Sean Paul Linan was lifted after a season-high 5.2 innings of shutout baseball. Giants' starter Greg Farone (1-0) fired five scoreless frames, allowing just one hit and two walks, striking out nine. Giants' reliever Ben Peterson tossed two scoreless innings for his first save of the year. Rancho's offense finished the game with just four hits and was shut out for the second time this year.

EVERYTHING THAT HAS A BEGINNING, HAS AN END: The Quakes saw a pair of streaks end on Thursday night, as their perfect run at home ended at five straight wins to open the year. Thursday's loss also ended their second three-game win streak of the year. The Quakes have now dropped two straight games in this series.

QUIET OFFENSE RECENTLY: Despite scoring 11 runs over the first two games of the series, the Rancho offense had just 11 hits over those 17 innings. Last night, they were held to just four hits in the shutout loss. The Quakes are hitting just .231, fifth in the Cal League, entering tonight's action.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made a pair of roster moves on Wednesday, as INF Joendry Vargas and LHP Jakob Wright were both placed on the Injured List. No moves have been made to fill those respective spots.

STILL WEARING THE SAME SHOE: The Quakes have welcomed back Manager John Shoemaker, who returns to Rancho to guide the Quakes for a fifth straight year, a franchise record. The club is 271-243 in four seasons under "Shoe", having made the playoffs twice, including one appearance in the Championship Series (2023). The Quakes have only one returning coach to this year's club, as pitching coach Ramon Troncoso returns to Rancho, joining Shoemaker for his fifth year as well. New members of the coaching staff include hitting coach Johermyn Chavez, pitching coach Brandon Bailey, Bench Coach Dunior Zerpa, Bullpen Coach and former Quake Marco Hernandez, Athletic Trainer Alfredo Casillas, Performance Coach Jake Taylor and Video Associate Max Delorme.

CHRISTIAN ZAZUETA: Right-hander Christian Zazueta makes his third start of the year and his first against the Giants. Zazueta pitched twice last week in the Stockton series and had very different results. In game one on Tuesday, he allowed four runs over three innings in a loss, before rebounding for a no-decision in game six on Sunday afternoon, allowing just one run over 4.1 innings, while fanning seven. Zazueta made 14 appearances (11 starts) for the Quakes in 2024, going 1-5 with a 6.36 ERA, allowing 37 earned runs over 52.1 innings pitched. Zazueta signed with the Yankees in 2022 out of Mexico and then was traded to the Dodgers in February of 2024 as part of the trade that saw former Quake Caleb Ferguson go to the Yankees.

JACOB BRESNAHAN: Lefty Jacob Bresnahan makes his third start of the year and his first against the Quakes. In his last start overall, he allowed four runs on four hits with four walks over four innings in a no-decision against Visalia on April 12th. Bresnahan was originally drafted by Cleveland in the 13th round of the 2023 draft out of Sumner High School, in Sumner, WA. He was traded to San Francisco in July of 2024 for pitcher Alex Cobb.
