### MEET THE TEAM

The Chesapeake Baysox break camp in 2026 with six of the Orioles' Top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline. IF Aron Estrada (No. 7) headlines the position player group at just 21-years-old, and is accompanied by Fall League standout and C Ethan Anderson (No. 24), OF Thomas Sosa (No. 18), and IF Griff O'Ferrall (No. 27). On the mound, the staff is led by LHP Luis De Leon (No. 2), with RHP Tyson Neighbors (No. 15) anchoring the bullpen. Chesapeake's roster features 14 pitchers and 12 position players, along with six newcomers and boasts 20 returners. Of the 26 active players, 23 have previous Double-A experience.

### BAYSOX ON THE GLOBAL STAGE

18 former Baysox participated in the World Baseball Classic this spring. Among this current crop of Baysox, two shined for their nations. LHP Micah Ashman pitched for Team Canada and contributed 2.1 scoreless innings against Team USA, recording outs against Aron Judge, Cal Raleigh, Bryce Harper, and Kyle Schwarber, while RHP Ryan Long had a pair of scoreless outings for Team Great Britain that included a strikeout of Randy Arozarena.

### WELCOME HOME, SKIP!

Third-year manager Roberto Mercado begins his third season at the helm of the Baysox by heading to Hartford. Mercado was the Dean of Students and baseball coach at New Britain High School prior to joining the Orioles organization. He led New Britain to their first two conference championships since 1984 while at the helm. In his first two seasons with the Baysox, Mercado has led the Baysox to 121 wins - eighth-most among managers in franchise history. Mercado has overseen 32 promotions to Triple-A and 11 players under Mercado with the Baysox have gone on to make their major league debuts, including three already this season - RHP Carter Baumler (TEX), RHP Ryan Watson (BOS) and RHP Anthony Nunez (BAL).

### ESTRADA IS ELECTRIC

IF Aron Estrada was the youngest Non-Roster invitee at Orioles Spring Training in Sarasota. Estrada, who turned 21 in January, hit .300 with five home runs in 27 games for the Baysox last season after homering five times in 81 games for High-A Aberdeen. Estrada logged his first three-hit game at Double-A in the 2025 season finale against New Hampshire on 9/14.

### IT'S IN THE GAME

C Ethan Anderson enters 2026 after a hot finish to last season. Anderson ended his season with the Baysox strong, finishing 10 for his last 35 (.286) after a 4-for-30 (.133) start at the level. He followed suit by hitting at a .300 clip in the Arizona Fall League with eight doubles - the second-most of any hitter in the AFL last season.

### OPENING DAY HISTORY

The Baysox enter their 33rd Opening Day in franchise history with a record of 16-16. The Baysox have won three of their last four season openers, including a 3-2 victory over Altoona last season where big leaguer Jeremiah Jackson hit his first home run as a member of the Orioles organization. The Baysox bested the Yard Goats in Hartford on Opening Day as recent as 2023, where former No. 2 overall pick Heston Kjerstad hit his first Double-A homer in a 8-0 Baysox victory.

### PREVIEWING THE YARD GOATS

Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies, the Yard Goats boast five of the Rockies' top 30 prospects, via MLB Pipeline. This includes IF Roc Riggio (No. 10) who was acquired from the Yankees' organization last season. Hartford has a first-year skipper at the helm in Robinson Cancel. The Yard Goats finished 69-68 last season.

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Jake Brooks makes his Rockies' organizational debut tonight. Brooks went back to the Rockies in a trade on 1/20 that saw Bradley Blalock head to Brooks' former employer, the Miami Marlins. Brooks worked as high as Double-A in three seasons in the Marlins organization, posting a 2-2 record and a 4.58 ERA in seven starts with Pensacola. Brooks was drafted in the 11th round in 2023 by Maimi out of UCLA.
