**The Saga Continues:** It's Star Wars Night, with specialty R2-D2 uniforms and postgame LAFCU Fireworks, as the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fifth in a six-game series with the Cedar Rapids Kernels, High-A affiliate of the Minnesota Twins. These are the only meetings between the two teams this season; Cedar Rapids won the first two games by a combined 22-10 score, but the Lugnuts have taken each of the last two by a combined 12-1.

**Episode IV: Lugnuts 4, Kernels 1.** Cedar Rapids only had one at-bat with a runner in scoring position, stymied by **Chen Zhong-Ao Zhuang** (5 innings), **Mitch Myers** (3 innings) and **Hunter Breault** (1 inning) in an easy Nuts victory on Peanuts Night, achieved in front of a roaring crowd of 7,588, the Lugnuts' second-largest home crowd of the season and the largest crowd that the Kernels have played in front of this year.

### LUG•NOTES

**No June Swoon:** The Lugnuts have the best offense in the Midwest League this month by a considerable margin, slashing .284/.350/.463 as a team, averaging 5.7 runs per game, and topping the MWL in hits, total bases, doubles, triples, batting average, slugging, and OPS. Meanwhile, the Nuts' pitching staff has walked the fewest batters in the league this month (33 in 101 innings) while posting a 3.74 ERA, 5th-best in the MWL. Cedar Rapids, conversely, has the worst ERA in the league by over a run, 6.26, allowing 84 runs (71 earned) in 102 innings.

**Overall for the Year:** The Nuts rank 1st in the Midwest League in runs scored, total bases, doubles, triples, RBIs, slugging percentage and OPS, ranking 2nd in base hits and OBP. And speaking of doubles...

**Double Time:** Last night only saw one double, **Jonny Butler's** Midwest League-leading 16th double of the year, thus giving the Lugnuts a two-double lead over Cedar Rapids for the most doubles in the Midwest League, 109-107.

**Prospecting:** Lansing has five MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 25), southpaw **Will Johnston** (No. 28) and outfielder **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 30).

**Big League Nuts:** Southpaw **Brady Basso**, who pitched for the Nuts in 2021 and 2023, became the third former Lansing player this season to reach the Majors on May 31 (joining **Max Schuemann** and **Brett Harris**), the 187th all-time.

**History:** **Jake Garland** (5 innings), **Grant Judkins** (2 2/3 innings) and **Colton Johnson** (1 1/3 innings) tossed the 4th no-hitter in franchise history on Thursday, June 13, blanking Cedar Rapids, 8-0, the first no-hitter in Lansing since April 21, 2003, a 15-0 rout of Dayton in which **Donnie Hood** hit for the cycle, the first time ever a team had thrown a no-hitter and hit for the cycle.

**Future Lugnuts Spotlight:** Outfielder **Ryan Lasko**, the Athletics' 2nd-round selection in 2023 from Rutgers, went 2-for-4 yesterday in a 5-2 Stockton loss to Lake Elsinore, continuing a hot June: 12 G, 17-for-48, 4 2B, 2 HR, 9 BB, .354/.475/.563.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2008:** The Lugnuts scored 11 runs in the eighth inning, demolishing the Great Lakes Loons, 18-6, to clinch the first-half Eastern Division title on the last day of the half. The Nuts tied a franchise record with five home runs (Matt Liuzza 2, John Tolisano, Mike McDade, Moises Sierra); Eric Eiland set the franchise record with five runs scored (going 3-for-3 with three singles, three walks and two steals); John Tolisano and Matt Liuzza each drove in five runs; and Liuzza and Raul Barron each collected four of the Nuts' 22 hits.

**2016:** The Great Lakes Loons came one out from throwing their first no-hitter in franchise history, but Wes Helsabeck plunked John La Prise, Josh Almonte singled to center, and J.C. Cardenas, batting from the right side, hit a three-run homer. The Loons completed a 6-3 victory in Game 2 of a doubleheader at Cooley Law School Stadium. Cardenas had hit a three-run homer from the left side in Game 1, a 10-1 rout of Great Lakes.

**2019:** In front of 7,711 on Star Wars night, it was a Solo story: One run for the Nuts in a 7-1 loss to Matthew Liberatore (7 IP, 9 K) and Bowling Green.

**In a Nutshell:** Signing bonus of \$3 million broke the record given to Sandy Gaston by Tampa Bay in 2018 (\$2.61m)... declared a free agent on August 25, 2022... signed on the first day of the international signing period, January 15, 2023, and motored through four levels in his professional debut... glove this year is green and black to represent A's green and Lugnuts' black... opened 2024 on the Injured List, activated April 29... notable splits:

**Prospecting:** Morales is ranked the Oakland Athletics' no. 2 prospect and top pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline, which grades his fastball at 60, his curve at 50, his slider at 55, his change at 50 and his control at 50.

They write, "Morales was billed as the consensus top pitching prospect of the 2023 international signing period when he signed for \$3 million with the A's in January that year. After setting a U-18 record for strikeouts with 161 across 82 2/3 innings between 2019-20 in Cuba's Serie Nacional, he defected in 2021 to Mexico, where he trained with Maels Rodriguez, a former Cuban National team pitcher and Olympian who regularly threw 100 mph fastballs. Initially expected to pitch solely in the Dominican Summer League for his introduction to pro ball, his excellent performance earned him stops at four different levels. He finished the year at High-A Lansing, combining for a 2.86 ERA with 53 strikeouts in 44 innings.

Morales' whip-like delivery produces an electric fastball that sits around 94-97 mph and can reach up to 99. His four-pitch mix also includes a slider, a changeup and a curveball, all of which appeared to be quality secondary pitches as he rapidly ascended through the Minors in his debut season.

Adding about 10 pounds of muscle to his 6-foot-3 frame in preparation for his first full season as a pro, Morales will see his durability tested as he looks to navigate the rigors of pitching. While his command was solid upon joining the A's, he has struggled with controlling his pitches in the past. If he can keep that control steady, he has a chance to make another significant jump through the system in 2024, with enough potential to evolve into a frontline starter in the future."

**Path to Lansing:** Luis opened the 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League, making his professional debut on June 6 with 1 2/3 hitless innings vs. DSL Astros Blue, striking out three... struck out six batters in three one-hit innings on June 20... struck out five batters in four one-hit innings on June 27... made four appearances in DSL before he was promoted to the Arizona Complex League Athletics on July 2, debuting on July 4 with three innings, allowing one run with three strikeouts vs. D-Backs Black... made three starts in AzCL before he was promoted to the Stockton Ports on July 24, debuting on July 28 with three one-hit innings and five strikeouts vs. Lake Elsinore... in last of five California League starts, tossed four two-hit scoreless innings at Fresno on August 25... promoted to Lansing on August 30, his fourth different stop along the ladder... strikeouts high: 6, 6/20/23.

**In a Nutshell:** Watters first appeared for the Lugnuts on August 31, 2022, pitching against Cubs rehabber Wade Miley at South Bend in his second professional appearance... he then spent the full 2023 season for the Nuts... he has spent all but one MiLB inning (of 93 total professional innings) with the Lugnuts... opened the 2024 season in a piggyback tandem with Wander Guante, who was promoted to Double-A Midland on May 14... started May 18 and May 24 without a tandem-mate before piggybacking Luis Morales during last start... on May 24 at Fort Wayne, tossed one scoreless inning before game was suspended due to rain... on May 29, needed only 39 pitches to fire five scoreless innings against Peoria... notable splits:
