LAST TIME OUT: The St. Paul Saints offense pounded out 10 hits while the pitching staff navigated around traffic in all but one inning in a 4-3 win on Friday night at Fifth Third Field over the Mud Hens. After getting out of a pair of mini jams in the first two innings, Saints starter Connor Prielipp saw his 8.1 inning scoreless streak going back to Opening Day come to an end in the third; with one out, Ben Malgeri singled to left and Max Clark walked before Hao-Yu Lee made it 1-0 with an RBI single to left-center. Jace Jung roped a double to increase the lead to 2-0. The Saints responded by tying the game in the next half-inning; Emmanuel Rodriguez extended his hit streak to seven in-a-row with a leadoff single before coming home on Orlando Arcia's double. Aaron Sabato tied it with a sac fly. In the fifth, the Saints broke the deadlock with Rodriguez (SF) and Eric Wagaman (single) collecting the RBI. Four Saints relievers combined for 5.1 scoreless innings to close the game. Toledo went just 2-for-15 with RISP.

YOU'RE GOING TO THE SHOW, KID: Two St. Paul Saints are headed up to the Big Leagues on Saturday. Following the moves of Royce Lewis (left knee sprain) and Cody Lawryson (right forearm strain) to the Twins' injured list, Saints right-hander Andrew Morris and utility player Ryan Kreidler will each suit up in a Twins uniform for the first time in their careers. For Morris, 24, it's the first big league call-up of his career. Last year, Morris spent the entire season with the Saints and ranked third on the St. Paul staff in innings pitched (94.2); had it not been for a right forearm strain that sidelined him from June 21-August 9, he would have likely made his MLB debut last season. Kreidler, 28, is in his first season with the Twins org, has previously seen big-league action for each of the previous four years (2022-25) with the Tigers, where he hit .138 (26-188) across 89 games with Detroit. Morris and Kreidler are the second and third big league call-ups off the Saints roster this year, although the first, Garrett Acton, came off the Saints roster before actually appearing in a game in a Saints uniform.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: The week's series in Toledo features two of the top young prospects in baseball, Max Clark and Kaelen Culpepper, who are each shining early for their respective clubs. Here are where Clark, the overall No. 8 prospect in the game by MLB.com, and Culpepper, No. 49 on that same list, rank among the 45 International League hitters aged 23 or younger this year:

PITCHER'S PARK: Saints pitching has turned a corner after a rough home series against Worcester. Over the past four days at Fifth Third Field, the St. Paul staff have allowed just 12 runs in 38.0 innings, good for a 2.13 ERA. Saints starters have allowed just 3 runs over 14.0 innings to start the series against the Mud Hens after producing a 9.00 ERA (25 ER, 25.0 IP) over the course of the first eight games of the season.

YOU WORKING AGAIN, JOHN?: Saints reliever John Brebbia has fired a scoreless appearance in each of his first four games in a Saints uniform, and currently holds a 7.0-inning scoreless streak. There were only 10 instances of four or more consecutive scoreless appearances by a Saints reliever all of last season, with Kody Funderburk coming out of the gates with seven in-a-row from March 28-April 27 with the Saints, interrupted by a 2-game stint with the Twins in between. Brebbia is just the fourth Saints pitcher in franchise history that has fired at least four consecutive scoreless appearances to open the year after beginning the season on St. Paul's Opening Day roster, joining Funderburk (2025, 7g), Matt Bowman (2024, 5g), & Ian Hamilton (2022, 4g).

VARIETY IS THE SPICE OF LIFE: In his first 12 games as Saints manager, Brian Dinkelman has turned in 12 unique lineup cards. No Saints hitter has batted from the same spot in the order more than eight times (Kaelen Culpepper in the leadoff spot) and only Eric Wagaman and Culpepper have started at least seven times at a given position (1B & SS, respectively).

E-ROD WITH AN A-BOMB: Twins' No. 2 prospect Emmanuel Rodriguez clubbed a 451-foot grand slam off the bat at 113.6 mph last Wednesday against Worcester, marking the 10th-hardest hit ball by exit velo in Triple-A this season, and the 2nd hardest-hit ball that's gone for a home run at the level, trailing only Patrick Wisdom's 113.8 mph blast on April 8 for Tacoma. Including Major League Statcast data, Rodriguez has the 7th hardest-hit home run in baseball this season entering play on Thursday. He owns three of the top-50 hardest struck balls in Triple-A by exit velocity so far this year entering play on Saturday.

TWINS OF TOMORROW: The Saints open the season with nine of the Twins' Top-30 ranked prospects according to MLB.com, marking the most players listed on MLB's Minnesota Top-30 list to open a campaign in the Saints' history as a Triple-A franchise. Between Walker Jenkins, Kaelen Culpepper, Emmanuel Rodriguez, & Connor Prielipp, they also tout four prospects on either the MLB.com or Baseball America Top-100 list, surpassing last year's total of three when Rodriguez, Luke Keaschall, and Zebby Matthews all began the year with the Saints. Jenkins, the Twins' consensus top prospect, became the youngest player in Saints franchise history when he debuted at 20 years, 6 months, and 7 days of age last year. Culpepper, Minnesota's No. 2 prospect (MLB.com) and last year's Twins Minor League Player of the Year, made his Triple-A debut on Opening Day and reached base in his first eight games at the level, just the fourth Saints player in their team history to do so. Prielipp, the Twins No. 4 (BA) prospect, returns in a Saints uniform after finishing last season in St. Paul. The remaining ranked prospects include Gabriel Gonzalez (7/10), Andrew Morris (13/13), Marco Raya (18/21), and John Klein (20/23). Left-hander Kendry Rojas (10/8) will also open the year on the Saints' injured list, but is expected to join the rotation within the first few weeks.

CAREER NOTES

2025

- Opened the season with the Saints & went 2-1, 1.92 ERA (7 ER, 32.2 IP) before earning a promotion to the Twins...struck out 38 (28 K%) against 9 walks (7 BB%)
- Answered David Festa's 5.0 shutout frames on Opening Day with 5.0 scoreless innings of his own on April 1 @Columbus
- Went at least 5.0 innings and gave up 2 runs or fewer in each of his first three starts...did not allow more than 2 ER in any of his six starts before going up
- With the Twins, went 1-1 with a 5.21 ERA (11 ER, 19.0 IP) over four starts before landing on the 15-Day IL with a right shoulder strain
- Came back for one start on rehab assignment on July 13 vs Iowa...fired 4.0 shutout innings and struck out nine...did not walk a batter and gave up just one hit
- Following his rehab stint, closed the year going 4-5, 5.67 ERA (38 ER, 60.1 IP) across 12 starts with Minnesota...struck out 63 and walked 16 while yielding 10 HR
- In total with the Twins, made a career-high 16 starts in his second year in the big leagues, and produced a 5.56 ERA with 12 HRA across 79.1 innings
- Had the 7th-largest difference between his ERA and his FIP (3.79) in MLB (min 50 IP)

2024

- Jim Rantz Award Winner (Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Year)
- Ascended from High-A Cedar Rapids to to the Bigs in one season, becoming the first Twins pitcher since Randy Dobnak in 2019 to pitch at four separate levels in the Twins organization, including Minnesota, in one season
- Across 3 levels in the minors, accrued a 6-3 record with a 2.60 ERA, striking out 114 batters against just 7 walks in 97.0 IP...Led MiLB in K:BB ratio (16.29, min 40 IP)
- Promoted to Triple-A St. Paul on July 14 and made four starts for the Saints from July 21-August 8, going 1-2, 5.68 ERA, striking out 23 with just one walk in 19.0 IP
- Made his MLB Debut on Aug. 13 vs Kansas City at Target Field, earning the win with 5.0 innings of 2-run ball (struck out eventual AL MVP Bobby Witt Jr. for first MLB K)...went 1-4, 6.69 ERA across 9 starts w/ Twins to end year, struck out 43 vs 11 BB in 37.2 IP

- Split his first full pro season between High-A Cedar Rapids and Low-A Fort Myers, going 7-3 with a 3.84 ERA in 22 appearances (20 starts), w/ 112 SO and 15 BB in 105.1 IP

LAST APPEARANCE: Started Saturday vs Worcester and yielded five runs on a career-most four homers allowed...four of his seven hits allowed left the ballpark...gave up a two-run shot to Mickey Gasper in the first, back-to-back solos to lead off the third, and a leadoff blast in the fourth...Threw 24 sliders (28%), 18 curveballs (21%), 16 four-seamers (19%), 12 cutters (14%), 8 splitters (9%), and 7 sinkers (8%)...gave up a HR on four different pitch types while also inducing 13 swings-and-misses

HITTING THE GLOVE: In 2024, Matthews opened up the year on an incredible stretch without walking a batter. He issued his first walk of the season on May 22, seven starts into the campaign (also his 24th birthday). He struck out 49 batters before issuing a walk, facing 141 hitters before issuing a free pass. Since 1893, when the mound was moved to its current position, only two major league pitchers began a season with more strikeouts before issuing a walk: Kenley Jansen with the Dodgers in 2017 (51 K) and Corbin Burnes for the Brewers in 2021 (58 K). Matthews led the Minors with a 16.29 K:BB ratio that year among all arms with at least 40 IP, and was 6th among all MLB rookies with at least 35.0 IP with a 3.91 ratio during his time in the Bigs to end the year. Since going pro, his career 10.55 K:BB ratio in the minors leads MiLB entering the season (min 200 IP).

TINKERING WITH THE ARSENAL: A big reason for Matthews' success over the past two seasons has been a jump in velocity, which he attributes to attending the Twins' velocity camp before the start of Spring Training. He went from a college pitcher who sat in the low-90's, sometimes touching 96 mph, to a guy who regularly sits at 96 with his fastball while occasionally reaching back for 98. Working with Tommy Bergjans in the Spring of 2024, he scrapped a sweepy slider he threw in 2023 for a harder slider in 2024, which pairs well with his cutter, curveball, and changeup.

WHAT THE HECK IS A CATAMOUNT?: After starting his college career at Walters State Community College (TN) in 2019, Matthews transferred to the Division 1 ranks at Western Carolina, where he would put together one of the best careers for a Catamount pitcher in school history. After being limited to just 61.1 innings due to an elbow injury as a RS sophomore, he put together a 1st Team All-Southern Conference campaign in 2022, striking out 122, the only pitcher in the SoCon's history to eclipse the century mark; it was the third-most strikeouts in a single-season in program history for Western Carolina. When he went in the 8th round (234th overall) in 2022, he became the highest draft pick in Western Carolina history.

HIGHS & LOWS: While a high school pitcher, Zebby once gave up a walk-off homer in the 2nd round of the 2A NCHSAA playoffs while with Smoky Mountain High. After the game, he retrieved the ball from beyond the fence and kept it as motivation. The ball stays on his shelf next to the ball from the game he threw a perfect game in during his senior season.
