LAST TIME OUT

Moosic, PA (September 17) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders walked off the Buffalo Bisons 7-6 in their final game at PNC Field this season. Will Warren recorded a career-high 10 strikeouts, Aaron Palensky smoked a homer to tie it, and Andres Chaparro recorded the go-ahead sacrifice fly to win it.

Buffalo got on the board in the first inning. Rafael Lantigua drew a walk as the first batter of the game. An RBI double from Damiano Palmegiani gave them a 1-0 advantage. The RailRiders tied things up in the bottom of the seventh inning. Jesus Bastidas rocketed a single up the middle for his second hit of the game. He moved over to second on a balk and to third on a wild pitch. Bastidas raced home on another wild pitch to make the game one apiece.

In the top of the ninth inning, Jamie Ritchie smoked a home run to left for a late 2-1 lead. Leo Jimenez and Cam Eden hit back-to-back doubles to drive in another run. After Eden stole third, a sacrifice fly brought him home to make it 4-1. SWB threatened quickly in the bottom half. Josh Breaux led off with a base hit and Jake Lamb walked to reach. Aaron Palensky launched his first Triple-A homer to tie things up at four.

The contest moved into extras for the second night in a row. Palmegiani began at second as the pace-of-play runner and scored on an RBI single from Steward Berroa for a 5-4 lead. In the bottom half, the RailRiders were there once more. Nelson Medina was the inherited runner on second. He raced home on a groundout to tie things again at five. Cam Eden began the 11th out on second and scored on Rafael Lantigua's single giving Buffalo another lead. SWB was there to make it 6-6 in the home half. Bastidas doubled in Chaparro to tie it again. The RailRiders had the bases loaded but couldn't drive in another.

After holding Buffalo quiet in the twelfth, the RailRiders were hungry to get the win in front of their home crowd one final time. Medina started on second and Carlos Narvaez was given an intentional walk to reach. Franchy Cordero loaded the bases with his free pass. Chaparro drove a sacrifice fly into left to walk things off for the RailRiders. They finished with a 7-6 victory to end their home season.

Frankie Montas pitched a one-run inning in his first Major League rehab appearance, striking out two. Will Warren took over tossing the next five scoreless. Warren struck out ten, a career-high for the Yankees #10 prospect. Michael Gomez and Matt Bowman each had a clean frame. Zach Greene gave up three in the ninth. Aaron McGarity allowed two unearned runs in extras. Clay Aguilar (W, 1-1) was lights out

NEWS & NOTES

BEETER'S BEST - Righty Clayton Beeter had his best start in Triple-A last week. He shutout the Bisons limiting them to just four hits and a pair of walks. In 100 offerings, he nailed a career-high 13 strikeouts in a single contest. With the RailRiders, the righty has made 13 appearances for a 5.40 earned run average. He began in Double-A Somerset with a 2.08 ERA in 12 starts for six total wins. On the season, Beeter has set career highs in innings pitched with 120.2 and strikeouts with 151, the third most in the farm system.

PALENSKY PUNCH - Aaron Palensky recently received the call up to SWB to help them fill out some open roster spots. Since then, he has transitioned to the starting left fielder in his first three contests. On Sunday, he hit his 21st home run, his first in Triple-A. It was a bottom of the ninth three-run shot to tie the game. The righty has a 21/21 season with base running also being a big tool of his.

STEALING SWIPES - The RailRiders have gotten on a roll taking extra bases on the diamond with Aaron Palensky taking his first in Triple-A last night. The team has combined for 169 steals with Estevan Florial leading the way for 25 total and Brandon Lockridge has taken 23, both of which are no longer with the team. Last summer, SWB set a new franchise record with 172 taken.

EXTRA INNINGS - SWB went into extra innings for the thirteenth time of the season Sunday night. With a 7-6 loss in ten innings, the RailRiders hold a 7-6 record when there is free baseball. It was the fourth time this summer they have seen Buffalo in extras, with their first win against them coming in the 12th.

HOMER HAVEN - The RailRiders have combined for 211 home runs on the season. Estevan Florial had 28 while Andres Chaparro has 24 to his name. Nine different players have reached double digits on the summer. SWB sits tied for fifth place in all of Minor League baseball in the home run category while Syracuse is in third with 217. Durham leads with 221.

ANOTHER YEAR DOWN - The RailRiders a handful of September birthdays on the calendar. Franchy Cordero turns 29 on September 2nd, while his teammate's Nelson Medina and Jesus Bastidas have theirs on September 14th. Aaron Palensky turns 25 on the 22nd. Defensive coach Jose Javier celebrates his birthday on the 16th and the RailRiders manager Shelley Duncan's occurs on September 29th.

LEADING THE CHARGE - The RailRiders have had ten different first basemen this season, with Josh Breaux being the latest. Andres Chaparro and Jake Lamb lead the way with Billy McKinney taking most of the first half duties. Catchers Rodolfo Duran and Carlos Narvaez have turned into regulars in the corner. Mickey Gasper, Jake Bauers, Franchy Cordero and Max Burt have defended there as well.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top prospects making their first appearances in Triple-A season. Will Warren (#10), Clayton Beeter (#16), and Edgar Barclay (#28) are all essential parts of the starting rotation for the majority of the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's season.

ORIGINALLY DRAFTED: Selected in the Competitive Balance B-Round by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Texas Tech... received a \$1.2 million signing bonus, over the \$1 million slot value for the No. 66 overall selection... Competitive Balance Round B pick was acquired as part of the Dodgers' February 2020 trade with the Minnesota Twins

YANKEES GOT HIM: Was ranked by MLB.com as the Dodgers' No. 15 prospect at the 2022 Trade Deadline in August... traded by the Dodgers to the New York Yankees for LF Joey Gallo at the Trade Deadline on Aug. 2, 2022... was assigned to Double-A Somerset upon the trade... was a Rangers and Gallo fan growing up

TJ TIME: Had Tommy John surgery in December 2017 before his first season at Texas Tech and a follow-up arthroscopic elbow procedure seven months later

FUTURE FARMHAND: Was one of two Yankees prospects selected to the All-Star Futures Game in Seattle. The righty tossed just nine pitches, five for strikes, to record two outs in the seventh. He got San Diego's Jackson Merrill to ground out and recorded a strikeout against Jackson Chourio. Chourio is the #3 ranked prospect in all of MiLB according to MLB Pipeline, while Merrill stands at #10.

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS: Led the Red Raiders' 2019 College World Series semifinalists with eight saves and dominating in four starts as a redshirt sophomore, was a Freshman All-American in 2019 after recording a team-high eight saves in 20 appearances, where he owned a 3.20 ERA and 39 strikeout

PERSONAL/CAREER:

- 2023: In Beeter's second start of the season (55th career game) on 4/14 @BNG, he earned his first professional win with a career-high 6.2 IP, breaking his previous career mark of 5 IP, set in his final two starts of 2022. In the performance, Beeter started the Patriots' second shutout win of the season.
- 2022: Spent the beginning of his second season with the Dodgers in Double-A Tulsa making 18 appearances (16 GS), continuing to serve primarily as an opener, working no more than 4 IP in any of his starts, posting an 0-3 record with a 5.75 ERA and 15.33 K/9 IP. Beeter was acquired by the Yankees from the Dodgers hours before the 2022 MLB trade deadline on August 2 as the lone piece received in exchange for outfielder Joey Gallo. At the time of the trade, Beeter was ranked the Dodgers' No. 21 prospect by Baseball America, which credited him with having the Best Curveball in the Dodgers MiLB system. Beeter made his Yankees organizational debut with Double-A Somerset on 8/10/22, pitching three scoreless innings in which he posted six strikeouts and allowed only one baserunner (BB). In seven starts to end the season with Somerset, he posted a 2.13 ERA over 25.1 IP with 41 K and 11 BB (14.57 K/9 IP). Across his 7 GS with Somerset to end 2022, Beeter set and matched a new career-high 9 K on 8/27/22 vs. NH and 9/3/22 @BNG. Over this stretch, he also set a new career high in IP three different times, including in his lone postseason start on 9/22/22 vs. POR. He allowed 2 R (1 ER)
- 2021: Made his pro debut in 2021 and posted a 3.44 ERA between High-A Great Lakes and Double-A Tulsa, working mostly as an opener, going no more than 3.1 IP in any outing
