ABOUT LAST NIGHT: A four-run first and a pair of three-run frames — the second of which was highlighted by a Jack Suwinski three-run blast — propelled the Indianapolis Indians to a 12-1 win over the Omaha Storm Chasers on Saturday night at Victory Field. The Indians came out swinging in the bottom half of the first frame, with the first six batters reaching base. Ronny Simon drew a lead-off walk, and four consecutive singles off the bats of Ji Hwan Bae, Billy Cook, Jack Suwinski and Nick Yorke sent three runs across the plate. Malcom Nuñez broke up the singles by reaching on a fielder's choice to set up a Liover Peguero sacrifice fly to cap the inning's scoring. The home half of the second started similarly to the first, with Simon reaching on a lead-off walk and a Bae single. A wild pitch by John Gant brought Simon home, Yorke connected for his second RBI single and Nuñez sent an RBI double to left to give the Indians a 7-1 early advantage. Peguero added a pair of insurance runs in the fifth with his fourth long ball of the season and an RBI single in the seventh. Suwinski put an exclamation point on the night with a three-run shot over the left field wall in the eighth. The Storm Chasers' lone run of the contest was a bases-loaded walk issued to Joey Wiemer in the opening frame. Bubba Chandler tossed 3.1 innings, striking out six batters while walking four and yielding a run on three hits. Indians relievers Randy Labaut, Dauri Moreta and Burch Smith combined for 5.2 shutout innings, with Moreta striking out four of the six batters he faced.

WINDIANAPOLIS: Indy's back-to-back home wins have improved their Triple-A best home winning percentage to .732 (30-11), which ranks them third among all full-season minor league teams. Indy's home winning percentage is its highest through June 28 (min. 20 G) since at least 2005, surpassing 2012, when they had a .725 winning percentage (29-11). The Indians have won 20 of their last 25 home games since May 11, which is tied for the most in Minor League Baseball in that span, and 28 of their last 35 dating back to April 16, which is the most in MiLB.

OFFENSIVE ONSLAUGHT: The Indians set season-highs in hits (15) and runs scored (12) in last night's win. Indy last achieved both marks on Sept. 10, 2024, against Rochester, when they scored 13 runs on 15 hits. In June, the Indians are pacing International League teams with 237 hits and a .281 batting average while ranking second in on-base percentage (.364). Additionally, the Indians have hit a home run in each of their last seven games, which is their longest streak this season and matches their longest streak from 2024.

ANOTHER RBI FROM JACK: Jack Suwinski knocked in two RBI with a single in the first inning and capped his night with a three-run, opposite-field homer in the eighth to match his single-game career high with five RBI. It was the third time he's accomplished the feat in his career, with the last occurrence coming on April 29, 2023, at Washington. Despite not making his season debut with Indy until April 25, Suwinski leads Indians hitters on the season with 44 RBI. Those 44 RBI also rank second among International League hitters since April 25. With runners in scoring position this season, Suwinski ranks second among full-season minor league hitters with at least 50 plate appearances in batting average (.438, 21-for-48) and OPS (1.337).

SO' HOT: Nick Solak recorded his team-high fifth straight multi-hit game dating back to June 22 in Friday's contest, which is also tied for the third-longest streak of multi-hit games in the International League this season. It is the first time an Indians hitter has had five straight games with multiple hits since Miguel Andujar did so in five games from July 29-Aug. 3, 2023. He has the highest batting average (.579, 11-for-19) and OPS (1.583) and the most hits of qualified International League hitters across his streak. Solak is also rocking a 14-game hitting streak since the first game of a doubleheader vs. St. Paul on June 12, which is tied with Alika Williams for the longest on the Indians this season and stands as the second-longest active streak in the International League. He has reached base safely in 18 of 19 games played and has hit safely in 17 games since returning to Indy on June 5. On the season, Solak leads full-season minor league hitters (min. 200 PA) in batting average (.376, 70-for-186) and ranks fifth in OPS (1.027).

MALCOM MASHES: Malcom Nuñez recorded his third multi-hit game last night since returning from the 10-day injured list on June 11. He has a hit in five of the six games he's played since his return and has racked up four doubles. Before being placed on the seven-day injured list on May 11, Nuñez was hitting .320 with a .830 OPS while leading Indians hitters in extra-base hits (12) and ranking second in hits (30), RBI (15) and total bases (46). Since April 8 at Louisville, Nuñez has reached base safely in 25 of 30 games played and has turned in a multi-hit performance in 11 of those games. He has a .337 batting average (34-for-101) with 13 doubles, two home runs, 16 RBI and a .890 OPS in that stretch.

CHEFFING IN JUNE: Billy Cook, who was named the Indians June Player of the Month on Friday, picked up his tenth multi-hit game of the month last night, which is tied for the second-most among International League hitters. Six of those multi-hit efforts came in his first seven games played through June 7. Across that span, he tied for the second-most hits (12) among full-season minor leaguers, only trailing Pirates No. 2 prospect Konnor Griffin, who had 13 hits in Bradenton. Cook also ranked seventh in batting average (.522, 12-for-28) and eighth in on-base percentage (.607). In June, he leads qualified Triple-A hitters with a .391 batting average (.25-for-64) and ranks third with a .468 on-base percentage.

TODAY'S FINALE: The Indianapolis Indians and Omaha Storm Chasers conclude their six-game set at 1:35 PM from Victory Field. With a win, Indianapolis would clinch its fifth home series win out of six this season, with their sole loss coming in their first home series of the season against lowa from April 1-6. Additionally, the Indians are looking to win their sixth series out of the last eight they have played since May 6-11 vs. Columbus. Today's pitching matchup will be a rematch of Sunday's series opener, with southpaw Hunter Barco starting for Indy against righty Thomas Hatch. Tuesday marked Barco's first start against Omaha, and he held them to five hits and no runs while striking out six across a career-high 6.0 innings. Hatch, who pitched one game for the Indians in 2023, has faced his former team twice, both times coming this season. He was tagged for seven runs on Tuesday and allowed four runs while striking out six in his first appearance against Indy earlier this season on May 2.

ON THIS DATE IN 2003: Pete Zoccolillio launched a two-out, solo home run in the bottom of the 12th inning to defeat Richmond in walk-off fashion, 3-2. After Indy took a 2-0 lead in the fourth, Richmond ran down to the wire and plated a pair to tie the game in the top of the ninth. Zoccolillo was one of four Indians batters (also: Jim Rushford, Keith Luuloa and Alex Delgado) to notch multi-hit games in the win

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Hunter Barco: The southpaw ranks as Pittsburgh's No. 5 prospect and Minor League Baseball's No. 88 overall prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Historic Zeroes: Barco did not allow a run in his six starts with Double-A Altoona, totaling 25.2 consecutive scoreless innings to begin the season, marking the longest scoreless streak in Curve history.

Last Outing: Barco tossed a career-high 6.0 innings while allowing five hits, no runs and striking out six on Tuesday in his first career start against Omaha.

EAS Pitcher of the Month: Barco was awarded the 2025 Eastern League April Pitcher of the Month Award after leading the league (min. 20ip) in ERA (0.00, 20.2ip) and batting average against (.132, 9-for-68), while ranking second in WHIP (0.63) and tied for fourth in strikeouts (30).

Mowing Them Down: Barco finshed his award-winning April with back-to-back eight-strikeout starts, the last of which came in just 3.0 innings of work on April 27 at Double-A Chesapeake. He became the first Pirates full-season farmhand to strike out eight or more batters in 3.0 innings or less since Osvaldo Bido also struck out eight in 3.0 innings vs. Triple-A Louisville on Aug. 4th, 2022.

Miscellaneous: Barco was selected by the Pirates in the second round (44th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Florida (Gainesville).
