

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Wilmington scored early and put the game away late, holding off Brooklyn 9-3 on Tuesday night. The Cyclones left 10 men on base and, after pulling to within one run in the top of the eighth, allowed the Blue Rocks to explode to a 9-3 win with a five-run bottom of the eighth. C **Jose Mena** led the offense with three hits and two RBIs. Brooklyn starter RHP **Oscar Rojas** lasted just 1 2/3 innings, allowing three runs. Wilmington LHP **Mitchell Parker** earned the win, holding Brooklyn to one run despite eight hits.

DIVISION ON THE LINE: Including today, the Cyclones have 2i9 games remaining and five series: six at Wilmington, six vs. Hudson Valley, six at Jersey Shore, six vs. Wilmington, and six at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting a 1/2-game behind Hudson Valley for first place.

FEELING BLUE: Brooklyn has dropped 10 of 16 games against Wilmington this season with a run differential of -23. The Cyclones have only fared worse against Aberdeen (5-13) this season but in those games, Brooklyn has been outscored by 15.

MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN: The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league in the second half and overall. Brooklyn ranks second in the North Division with a +18 run differential behind Hudson Valley's +19. The Cyclones have allowed just 135 runs over 37 games (3.6 runs/game) in the second half. The next-closest team is Hudson Valley, allowing 4.3 runs per game in the second half.

ROAD WARRIORS: OF **Alex Ramirez** and OF **Stanley Consuegra** have done big damage away from Maimonides Park this summer. At home, the pair have combined to hit just 28-139 (.201) with 12 doubles, a triple, and two home runs. On the road, the two have combined to hit 27-81 (.333) with four dou-

HELP IS ON THE WAY, DEARY: Three players were promoted from Low-A St. Lucie to High-A Brooklyn ahead of this week in Delaware. No. 25 Mets prospect RHP **Christian Scott**, INF **William Lugo**, and RHP **Jeffrey Colon** have all been added to the roster.

PEROZA PRODUCING: Since July 9, INF **Jose Peroza** has a OPS of .827 over his past 23 games with an 11-game on-base streak. The Mets No. 29 prospect has been on base in 21 of the past 23 games, hitting .289 with a .381 OBP.

RA-RA RAMIREZ: No. 4 Mets prospect OF **Alex Ramirez** is tied with Triple-A INF **Brett Baty** with 106 hits. The 19-year-old Dominican leads the organization with seven triples.

HAMMER TIME: No. 9 Mets prospect RHP **Dominic Hamel** ranks second in the system with 106 strikeouts, sitting two behind Triple-A RHP **Jose Butto** (108). Hamel has thrown 88 1/3 innings, ranking fourth in the system but most among 2021 Mets draftees.

SHINE BRIGHT LIKE A DOMMOND: Dominic Hamel makes his sixth Brooklyn start, facing Wilmington for the first time in his career.

TREND BEHIND RIGHTED: Hamel's walks seem to come in bunches. In his July 9th start against Aberdeen, he walked back-to-back hitters in the fourth inning (one scored). In the July 16 start against Greensboro, Hamel walked the second and third batters back-to-back (one scored). In his July 23 4 start at Jersey Shore, Hamel walked both batters to start $\frac{4}{50}$ the second inning (both scored). Of the six runs allowed, 5 four have been runners who reached on a walk. However in 5/ back-to-back starts, Hamel has scattered his four total walks and has not allowed any runs. 6/

PROMOTED: Dominic Hamel, who is the Mets No. 9 pros- 7 pect according to MLB Pipeline, earned the promotion from *Indicates relief appearance Low-A St. Lucie, joining the Cyclones on the Fourth of July.

ST. LUCIE: With the Low-A St. Lucie Mets, Hamel made 14 appearances and 13 starts, posting a 3.84 ERA in 63 1/3 innings. Hamel posted a 27% strikeout rate, 11% walk rate, and a 3.91 FIP.

DOM-INANT JUNE: Hamel posted a 2.84 ERA in June, making five starts. He struck out 30 and walked 10 in 25 1/3 innings.

BEGINNINGS: The Arizona native was drafted by the Mets in the third round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist, signing for \$755,300 and made two appearances for the Florida Complex League Mets last year.

COLLEGE DAYS: Hamel pitched at Dallas Baptist in 2020 and 2021 after two seasons at Yavapai College. At Dallas Baptist in his senior season, Hamel set a school record with 136 strikeouts in 91 2/3 innings.
