OFFENSE FLOUNDERS, RIDERS FALL TO HOOKS 5-3:

The Frisco RoughRiders were defeated by the Corpus Christi Hooks 5-3 on Wednesday evening from Riders Field. Corpus Christi (1-1, 27-44) opened the scoring in the top of the second inning when Pascanel Ferraras came around to score on a single from Collin Price against Frisco (1-1, 45-26) starter **Ryan Garcia** (5-4). An error by Daniel Mateo in center field allowed Price to score and make it 2-0 Hooks. Miguel Ullola (4-3) kept the Riders offense in check, spinning 5.2 innings of two-run ball with seven strikeouts. Offensively, Frisco did not see their first base runner until **Geisel Cepeda** worked a walk in the bottom of the sixth inning. Jordan Brewer launched a solo homer to extend the Corpus Christi lead in the top of the fourth. The Hooks offense tallied three extra-base hits in the frame as Ferraras, who doubled, scored on an RBI double by Kenedy Corona to give Corpus a 4-0 advantage. The Frisco offense came alive after Cepeda's walk in the bottom of the sixth. Cepeda ended the shutout effort against Ullola, scoring on a groundout by Mateo. **Alex De Goti**, who reached with a double, crossed the plate on a sacrifice fly from **Liam Hicks** that cut the deficit to 4-2. **Triston Polley** worked a pair of scoreless frames and **Andy Rodriguez** surrendered a run in the top of the ninth. Corona singled, stole both second and third before scoring on a wild pitch to bring the score to 5-2. In the bottom of the ninth, the Riders threatened with two-outs but were unable to prevail. **Maximo Acosta** drove in **Keyber Rodriguez** with an RBI single, but Frisco stranded the tying run at first. The Riders offense went down in order in seven of their nine trips to the plate. In the sixth inning, De Goti and **Kellen Strahm** each notched hits while Rodriguez and Acosta logged the final two hits with singles in the ninth inning.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

Tuesday marked the first day of the second half. After a Midland loss on last Sunday, the RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

BROKEN BATS:

Over their last couple of weeks, the RoughRiders struggled offensively. Their 17 total runs across their last eight games are last in Double-A while they have slashed .194/.265/.286/.551 with three home runs. Frisco hit seven home runs in their last home series against Amarillo. Frisco lost three of the six games last week by one run while losing five of six. It was their first time losing five of six in a series this season and their first time losing five games in a series since 5/9-13/2023 vs. Wichita (lost all five in a rain-shortened series). In that series, the Riders were outscored 54-29 in five games, while the Riders were outscored 19-12.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The Riders have the fewest errors in all of Minor League Baseball (40) while also ranking second in fielding percentage (.984) in the minors. Frisco's 67 double plays are second among non-Triple-A teams. Corpus have allowed the third-fewest stolen bases in MiLB (48), throwing out 28 percent of total base runners against them.

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 2.92 ERA, which is also the third-best in all of Minor League Baseball. The Riders' pen allowed three runs on Friday, which was more than their previous 12 games, owning a 0.41 ERA (2 ER/43.2IP) over that span. In their last five series, spanning 27 games, Frisco's bullpen has a 1.68 ERA (18ER/96.2IP). In June, **Steven Jennings** has been fantastic, not allowing a run over his eight outings, throwing 16.1 innings.

FIRING BLANKS:

In their last 18 games, the Riders have allowed just 37 earned runs over 157.0 IP (2.12 ERA). Frisco has the best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball during the month of June, at 2.59 through the first 22 games. Having won 20 of their last 29 games since May 25th, the Riders have the best ERA in Minor League Baseball (2.41) during that stretch while also being tied for second in saves (9) and tied for first in wins (20) since May 25th. The team with the second-best ERA in that stretch (Palm Beach) has a 2.95 ERA. In those last 29 games, the Riders have allowed more than three runs in a game just eight times and five times in the last 17 games. Their Tuesday and Thursday 2-1 losses last week marked their first two losses when allowing three runs or fewer, dropping them to 36-2 in those games.

HICKS IS THE PICK:

Liam Hicks has been on fire at the plate for the Riders over his last 34 games, batting .325 (37-for-114)/.437/.456/.893 with six doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs, 19 walks, 12 strikeouts and 21 runs. In his last 18 games, he is hitting .333 (21-for-63)/.449/.540/.989. Two Fridays ago in Corpus Christi, Hicks collected two home runs for his first multi-home run game of his Minor League career.

RISP-ECT THIS:

The RoughRiders have been great with runners in scoring position this season, but have struggled recently. Over their last 36 games, they are 22-14, but are hitting .243 (68-for-280) with runners in scoring position. On the season, they are still second in the Texas League, batting .270 with RISP.

ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

2024 SEASON

-Krauth enters 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation.

-Became the first RoughRiders pitcher to complete a quality start on 4/14/24 against Corpus Christi.

2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
