INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Liover Peguero and Matt Fraizer each launched a grand slam as the Indianapolis Indians tallied 14 hits in a 14-3 matinee victory over the lowa Cubs on Wednesday afternoon at Principal Park. With lowa leading 2-0 after one, Indianapolis responded in the second inning for seven runs on six hits off Dan Straily. Three of the first four batters in the frame reached base via single, with Fraizer and Ji Hwan Bae tying the game up with RBI knocks. Back-toback walks scored another before Peguero's first career grand slam put the game out of reach. Indy exploded for seven additional runs before lowa could plate another, courtesy of two Andrés Alvarez RBI singles and Fraizer's blast in the seventh inning. The I-Cubs final run came in the ninth inning when Fabian Pertuz singled home Travce Thompson.

GOOD, GREAT, GRAND: Liover Peguero and Matt Fraizer each launched grand slams in last night's commanding win over the I-Cubs, becoming just the second pair of Indians batters to hit grand slams in the same game in the Victory Field era, following Jared Oliva and Rodolfo Castro on May 10, 2022, at Charlotte. The second-inning blast by Peguero capped a seven-run frame and was his first career grand slam. Fraizer followed with the second grand salami of his career (also: July 22, 2021, with High-A Greensboro at Greenville). The Indians have now hit four grand slams this season, one shy of tying their five from the 2023

FLAVA FRAIZ: After singling home a run in the top of the second inning, Matt Fraizer's seventh-inning grand slam gave him his fourth career-high tying five-RBI game and second with Indianapolis this season (also: July 2, 2024 at Louisville). His 2-for-4 performance was also his fifth multi-hit game in nine July contests, during which he's hitting .400 (10-for-25) with 10 runs, three doubles, two home runs and 12 RBI. The Indians as a team have logged six individual five-RBI performances after having nine in 2023.

KEEP THE TAB OPEN: Seth Beer continued his torrid stretch against International League hitting last night, going 2-for-5 with a run and ground-rule double. The performance comes off a three-homer game on Tuesday night, when he became just the ninth Indians batter in franchise history and the second in the Victory Field era to hit three home runs in a single game. It was the first three-homer game by an Indian since Micah Franklin on Sept. 1, 2001, vs. Toledo, and the first to do so on the road since Willie Greene on Aug. 22, 1995, at Omaha. Beer has now hit safely in each of his last eight games and 14 of 15 since June 27 (2) with a .390 batting average (23-for-59), 15 runs, four doubles, seven home runs and 20 RBI.

BILLY'S BACK: Billy McKinney returned to the Indians lineup last night for the first time since May 11 after a stint on the injured list and logged a season-high three hits en route to Indy's win over the I-Cubs. The performance was also his second this season with three runs, following May 9 at Louisville when he went 2-for-2 with a walk. In 28 games with the Indians this season, he is hitting .278 (25-for-90) with 16 runs, five doubles, two home runs and 13 RBI.

MASHING VS. THE I-CUBS: The Indians have launched 23 of their 88 home runs in 14 total games against the lowa Cubs, their most home runs against a single opponent this season. Fourteen of those home runs came during a six-game series at Principal Park from May 21-26, with the Indians launching a season-high six long balls on May 23. Including Tuesday night's four-homer outburst and two grand slams last night, the Indians now have launched 20 home runs in eight games in Des Moines this season. Individually, Matt Gorski leads the pack with five homers in 12 games against lowa. Below is a list of the hottest Indians hitters against the I-Cubs and their stats.

TONIGHT: The Indians continue a nine-game road trip with the third of six games at lowa tonight at 7:38 PM ET. The Indians mashed at Principal Park over six games in May, launching a staggering 14 home runs (see above). In 14 total games vs. lowa, the Indians are 9-5 after winning a six-game set at Victory Field from June 18-23. Continuing the six-game set for Indianapolis today is RHP Mike Burrows (0-0, -.--), making his first start with the Indians since undergoing Tommy John surgery in 2023. Countering for the I-Cubs is RHP Riley Thompson (4-3, 5.68), who is 3-0 with a 4.19 ERA (9er/19.1ip) and 12 strikeouts in eight appearances (four starts) in his career vs. Indy.

BE LIKE MIKE: RHP Mike Burrows returns to the Indians starting rotation today after spending the season rehabbing from undergoing Tommy John surgery last year. He has made six total starts between FCL Pirates and Single-A Bradenton this season, going 0-2 with a 8.56 ERA (13er/13.2ip) and 14 strikeouts while topping out at 69 pitches in his latest start on July 18. Burrows began the 2023 campaign on Indianapolis' Opening Day roster and tossed 6.1 innings with two runs allowed across two starts, exiting the latter on April 8 with two outs in the second inning. Burrows is currently rated as Pittsburgh's No. 9 prospect by MLB

THIS DATE IN 1997: Giovanni Carrara won his 10th game of the season as he tossed 8.0 one-hit innings with seven strikeouts in a 6-0 win at Louisville. He combined with reliever Richie Lewis for the second one-hitter in the Victory Field era. Brian Hunter tallied a two-run single, Aaron Boone hit a two-run home and Ozzie Timmons collected two RBI. Brook Fordyce contributed a game-high three hits and two runs scored.
