Round Rock and Oklahoma City face off at 7:05 p.m. CT on Tuesday night for the series opener from Dell Diamond. E-Train RHP Tyson Miller is scheduled for the start against Dodgers RHP Beau Burrows.

Express Director of Broadcasting Mike Capps handles play-by-play duties while former MLB player and Express INF Matt Kata provides color commentary.

LET'S RECAP

The Round Rock Express fell in the series finale to the Albuquerque Isotopes by a final score of 8-7 on Sunday night at Isotopes Park. The E-Train earned a series split in the six-game series. The Round Rock offense hit three home runs and it was RF Leody Taveras with the first of the night to tie the score at one in the fourth inning. Albuquerque C Jonathan Morales smacked a two-run home run in the fourth to take a 3-1 lead. In the fifth, the lead was extended to 5-1 on a solo home run from 3B Elehuris Montero. In the sixth inning, 1B Zach Reks hit the first of two home runs on the night. A two-run shot trimmed the Albuquerque lead to 4-3. The Isotopes tacked on two more runs in the home-half of the sixth inning on two hits, two walks and a hit batter. In the eighth, after a walk for SS Josh Smith and a single for Taveras, Reks hit a three-run home run to tie the game at seven. Albuquerque collected the walk-off win in the ninth. With one out, 2B Brett Boswell singled. Morales doubled to score Boswell and give the Isotopes an 8-7 win.

MILLER ON THE BUMP

Round Rock RHP Tyson Miller will make his 11th appearance and fourth start of the year. The righty holds a 2-1 record and 4.55 ERA (15 ER/29.2 IP) through his first 10 appearances. During those games, Miller has struck out 41 and walked 13.

SMITH TO THE SHOW

Round Rock INF Josh Smith was called-up to Texas on Monday and made his Major League debut at third base against the Tampa Bay Rays. He went 3-for-4 and tied the Rangers club record for hits in a debut. Smith had been red hot for the E-Train before his promotion. On Saturday in Albuquerque, he went 4-for-6 with four RBI in a 14-3 Round Rock win. In 40 games this year for Round Rock, Smith slashed .273/.382/.422 with four home runs and 29 RBI. He collected 24 walks and 39 strikeouts.

REKS PCL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

OF Zach Reks was named the Pacific Coast League Player of the Week for May 23-29. Reks posted an average of .550 (11-20) in five games against the Albuquerque Isotopes. He hit four home runs, two doubles and five singles with nine RBI. He also walked twice. On Sunday, he went 4-for-4 with two home runs, a double and five RBI. Reks was called-up to Texas on Monday afternoon and appeared in the lineup last night against the Tampa Bay Rays. He batted seventh and went 0-for-4.

ROSTER MOVES

Following the promotion of INF Josh Smith and OF Zach Reks on Monday, the Texas Rangers announced RHP Kohei Arihara and INF Davis Wendel were reinstated from the 7-day Injured List. INF Diosbel Arias was added to the Round Rock from the ACL Rangers along with RHP Jose Leclerc from the Texas Rangers. C Konner Pottot was transferred from Round Rock to the Arizona Complex League.

ENDING MAY STRONG

Round Rock is 15-10 in the month of May following their series split with Albuquerque last week. The Express have led all of Triple-A in average (.285), runs (195), hits (285) and home runs (40). Round Rock has had at least a share of first place for 27 out of 31 days this month.

SERIES OPENERS

Round Rock is 8-1 in series openers this season while they are 7-1 in games played on Tuesday's in 2022.

RHP Daniel Robert, INF Josh Smith and OF Bubba Thompson all made their Triple-A debuts on Opening Day - April 5, 2022 while RHP Hever Bueno made his on April 6.

STATING THE FACTS

The team's lone Texan, RHP Justin Anderson hailed from Houston before a collegiate career at the University of Texas at San Antonio.

EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.

Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
