PAPILLION, NEB. - The Omaha Storm Chasers' six-game winning streak came to an end Wednesday afternoon with a 6-5 loss in 10 innings to the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp 6-5 Wednesday at Werner Park.

- The Chasers started the scoring in the bottom of the 2nd inning as **Nate Eaton** homered for the second straight game, a solo shot to left field for a 1-0 Omaha lead.
- Jacksonville had a quick counter and did not trail for long, as **Griffin Conine** led off the top of the 3rd inning with a game-tying home run, then two more homers in the 4th inning gave the Jumbo Shrimp a 4-1 lead.
- Nick Pratto** brought the Chasers a run closer in the bottom of the 4th inning with his sixth home run of the year, a solo shot that stretched his hitting streak to seven games and cut Jacksonville's lead down 4-2.
- While he surrendered his first 3 homers of the year, Omaha starting pitcher **William Fleming** retired his final five hitters, including a 1-2-3 5th inning to complete 5.0 innings for the second straight start, allowing four runs on six hits with two strikeouts.
- After Omaha got within two runs, the next few innings were quiet as both teams mustered just three walks combined through innings 5-7 without scoring a run.
- Behind Fleming, Storm Chaser relievers **Austin Cox**, **Jake Brentz**, **John McMillon**, and **Sam Long** each offered a scoreless inning and combined for five strikeouts, holding the Jumbo Shrimp to two hits from the sixth inning through the 9th ... Brentz and McMillon pitched 1-2-3 7th and 8th innings respectively, their first perfect innings of the season.
- Down two going to the bottom of the 8th inning, Omaha closed the gap as **Nick Loftin** doubled in **Cam Devanney**, then Pratto singled in Loftin to tie the game 4-4.
- Omaha was put away quietly in the bottom of the 9th inning and **Walter Pennington** took over for the 10th inning, but Jacksonville's **Victor Mesa Jr.** hit a home run to right center field on the first pitch he saw, a two-run shot that scored the placed runner for a 6-4 Jumbo Shrimp lead ... Pennington limited the damage to just the two runs (one earned) over his inning of work.
- Omaha had one last breath in the bottom of the 10th inning as a walk and a hit by pitch loaded the bases ... with one out, Pratto hit a sacrifice fly and drove in his third run of the game to plate **Brian O'Keefe** and cut the deficit down to 6-5 which held as the final score and the Chasers stranded the tying and winning runs on base.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

(DON'T) WALK THIS WAY

- Tonight's Omaha starting pitcher, **Luis Cessa**, has not walked a batter across his last three starts, a rather rare feat in the Storm Chasers era.
- Since the move to Werner Park in 2011, Cessa is just the 6th Storm Chaser pitcher to go 3 starts without walking a batter ... no Omaha starter has gone more than 3 straight starts without walk.
- Of the 6 pitchers to go 3 straight starts without walking a batter, Cessa's 12.0 innings over his 3 starts are the fewest ... **Will Smith** had a 19.0-inning/3-start stretch without a walk from April 15 to 26, 2012, followed by **Marcelo Martinez**, who had a 18.2-inning/3-start stretch from September 9 to 22, 2021.
- The last 3 starts for Cessa have been a stark contrast from his first 3 appearances, as he walked 8 over his first 3 games this year (5.2 IP).

CLOSE BUT NO CIGAR

- Omaha lost its 12th game of the season yesterday afternoon, falling to a 20-12 record ... a 6-5 loss marked another close defeat for the Storm Chasers.
- Yesterday was Omaha's 5th one-run loss of the year ... 10 of the Chasers' 12 losses this season have been decided by 3 runs or fewer (a save situation) ... the Storm Chasers have only lost one game by more than 4 runs: a 9-1 loss on April 18 at Nashville.
- In 5 of the 10 games that Omaha has lost by 3 or fewer runs, the Chasers have at the tying run either at the plate or on base ... in 3 games this year (yesterday included), Omaha has had the winning run on base and stranded it to end the game.
- The Storm Chasers have not allowed more than 9 runs in a game this season ... of the 20-team International League, only Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and Omaha have yet to allow a double-digit run total, but SWB has 5 games of 9+ runs ... 16 of 20 IL teams have allowed 10 or more runs in at least 3 times.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

- Omaha has outscored its opponents 192 to 148 this season, a +44 run differential.
- A +44 run differential ranks as the 2nd-best in the International League and is 4th in Triple-A ... Scranton/WB (NYY) and Sugar Land (HOU) are tied for the Triple-A lead at a +52 run differential.

THE MANN OF THE HOUR

- After a strong week in Des Moines, **Devin Mann** was named the International League's Player of the Week on Monday, for the week of April 29 to May 5.
- Mann led the league with a .467 average (7-for-15), .579 on-base percentage and 1.446 OPS, while ranking second in slugging percentage (.867) ... 4 of his 7 hits went for extra bases (3 doubles, 1 homer), to go along with 4 walks and 5 runs scored.
- 0-for-4 at the plate yesterday, Mann's 19-game on-base streak came to an end, just the 3rd time this season he did not reach base in a game for Omaha ... between April 4 and May 7, Mann hit .354 (23-for-65) with a 1.053 OPS ... he had hits in 14 of the 19 games, with 8 multi-hit games during the streak as well.
- Even though he did not get on yesterday, Mann has reached base in 20 of 23 games this season with the Storm Chasers.

TODAY'S START

- ✓ Cessa is making his **7th appearance** and **6th start** of the season after opening the year on Omaha's Opening Day roster ... he spent a week on the Development List (April 5 to 11), but has made 4 starts since.
- ✓ The Royals in 2024 mark Cessa's 7th MLB organization ... with the Mets for the first 8 seasons (2008-15) of his professional career before being traded to the Detroit Tigers midseason in 2015 and dealt to the New York Yankees later that offseason ... joined the Cincinnati Reds in a trade in 2021 and pitched for them through 2023 ... pitched for Washington and Colorado's Triple-A affiliates in 2023 ... Cessa has made five MLB Opening Day rosters: 2016, 2019 & 2021 with the Yankees and 2022-23 with the Reds.

LAST OUTING: FRIDAY, MAY 3 @ IOWA

Earned his first win of the season, holding Iowa to a run in the 1st inning ... pitched through the 5th inning for the first time this year ... a single, double and walk scored a run in the 1st, but Cessa faced 1 over the minimum after the sac fly, only allowing a double in the 3rd and single in the 5th ... fired 1-2-3 innings in the 2nd and 4th ... set his personal season-high with 5 strikeouts.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- ✓ Appeared in 6 Cactus League games out of the bullpen for the Royals and went 0-0 with a 4.60 ERA (4 ER in 7.2 IP), with 5 strikeouts ... held opponents to a .179 average (5-for-28).
- ✓ Made his first appearance of the season on March 30 vs. Iowa with 2.2 innings of relief, but has made starts his last 4 appearances.
