#### EL PASO CHIHUAHUAS (27-36) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (18-45)

### LHP Miguel Cienfuegos (0-1, 9.64) vs. RHP Tanner Gordon (0-1, 6.59)

**TODAY'S GAME**: The Isotopes and Chihuahuas meet for the fourth series of five on the year and the final at Isotopes Park ... El Paso won the first set, a three-gamer, while the clubs have split the previous two ... Tanner Gordon is scheduled to start for Albuquerque while Miguel Cienfuegos is slated to go for El Paso.

JONESY: In his tenth rehab game with the Isotopes Sunday, Nolan Jones went 0-for-3 with a walk. Over 10 games, Jones is 7-for-35 with six RBI, four walks, 10 punchouts and one home run. Has reached base in nine of the 10 contests.

**SHUTOUT**: Albuquerque was shutout Sunday for the first time since July 9, 2023, at Oklahoma City, snapping a 125-game streak. It was the 12th occurrence in which Sacramento blanked the Isotopes (last: July 3, 2019, 1-0), all but one has occurred in California.

**TWO OR FEWER**: Dating back to May 24 at Salt Lake, Albuquerque has scored two or fewer runs in 10 of their last 15 ballgames. Overall, it has occurred 19 times this season.

**LAST 15**: Over the Isotopes last 14 contests, they have scored 48 runs—the fewest in Triple-A and third-fewest in all of Minor League Baseball (fewest: Tri-City, 45).

SERIES: Albuquerque dropped five of six games in a series Sunday for the fifth time in 2024 (also: at Oklahoma City, vs. Sugar Land, vs. Round Rock, vs. Oklahoma City). They have yet to be swept. The Isotopes also split six games at El Paso from April 16-21 and May 7-12.

RUNS IN A SET: Albuquerque's 17 total runs last week marked their second-lowest total in a six-game series, behind nine plated at Sugar Land from May 27-June 1, 2021, including two shutouts by the Space Cowboys.

HITS: The Isotopes were held to three hits Sunday for the first time since June 24, 2023 at Reno, which was a 6-1 Aces victory behind Brandon Pfaadt.

**RISP**: the Isotopes are 19-for-108 with runners in scoring position over their last 15 games.

**TAKE YOUR BASE**: Sunday was the seventh instance in which the Isotopes pitching staff walked at least nine batters and first since May 31 vs. Sugar Land (also nine).

**XBH**: Sacramento compiled one extra-base hit Sunday, the seventh time Albuquerque limited their opponent to one ... The Isotopes have allowed at least one in every contest this season.

**REAL SLIM SCHUNKY**: Aaron Schunk recorded his 20th double of the year Sunday, four away from the Triple-A mark he set last year (career high: 34, 2022 with Hartford).

**BOONIE**: Trevor Boone saw his 14-game on-base streak with Albuquerque come to an end, with an 0-for-3 performance. He compiled a .216/.298/.353 slash line with two doubles, a triple and homer during the span.

JC: Julio Carreras tallied his seventh multi-hit performance of the season Sunday, and second in his last three starts after going 2-for-3 with a double ... Swiped his team-leading 18th stolen base of the year Thursday. He is one shy of tying his career high for a season (high: 19, 2022 with Spokane, 17, and Hartford, two).

**SAM I AM:** Sam Hilliard went hitless Sunday for the eighth time in his last 12 contests ... Since May 26, he is hitting .100 (5x50), with his average dropping from .324 to .275 during stretch.

FAN FAVORITE: Coco Montes has three hitless games over his last five contests. During the stretch, he is hitting .118 (2x17) with three walks.

HIS NAME IS DREW: Drew Romo went 0-for-4 Saturday, his fifth hitless contest in his last eight games.

**COOLIN' OFF?:** From April 21-May 18, Romo slashed .450/.459/.725 with eight doubles, four homers, 20 RBI ... Last 12 games, hitting .178 (8x45) with a double, triple, two homers.

**COPIE**: Daniel Cope recorded three singles Saturday for his first multi-hit contest of the season. It's his first three-hit game since Sept. 21, 2023, vs. Oklahoma City.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Drew Romo is 3rd in average (.323) and 10th in slugging (.522) ... Aaron Schunk is T-2nd in doubles (20) and T-9th in XBH (26) ... Coco Montes is 2nd in average (.332), 3rd in hits (72), T-3rd walks (35), 5th in OBP (.420) and OPS (.941), T-6th in triples (4), and 9th in total bases (113) ... Sam Hilliard is T-6th in XBH (28), T-7th in runs (44), 8th in total bases (116), T-9th in walks (33), homers (11) and hits (63) and T-10th in triples (3) ... Julio Carreras is T-4th in stolen bases (18).

**TEAM STATS**: Offensively in MiLB, the club is 2nd in triples (28), hits (605), 3rd total bases (1,030), and slugging (.465), 4th in average (.273) and doubles (132), 5th in OPS (.820) and 10th in runs (355).

200 RBI: Coco Montes became the fifth Isotope to tally 200 RBI with the club May 25, six days after Sam Hilliard.

#### **NUCLEI NOTES**

**SKIPPER**: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

**HOMETOWN KID:** Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

**BALLS AND STRIKES**: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
