> WELCOME BACK: After being activated from the 7-day injured list on Tuesay, Esmerlyn Valdez smacked his 10th home run of the season and reached pase three times against Jupiter. The 10 home runs are tied with Axiel Plaz for the most, which are also the fourth-most in the FSL this year. Over his last five games, Valdez is hitting .389/.476/.722 with three doubles, one home run, six RBIs, two walks, and three runs scored.

> BACK-TO-BACK: The Bradenton Marauders experienced back-to-back off-days on Sunday and Monday for the first time since the start of the Minor League Baseball season on April 5. Both the Minor Leagues and Major League Baseball share a four-day All-Star break next Monday through Thursday.

> WELCOME JUPITER: Bradenton and Jupiter met 12 times last season with each team hosting a series at their home ballparks with neither side winning either series. The Marauders won four out of six games against the Hammerheads at LECOM Park in 2022. Palm Beach is now the lone team in the Florida State League that Bradenton has yet to play.

JAVVY'S MASHIN: In June, Javier Rivas slashed .341/.400/.646 with five doubles, a triple, six home runs, 13 RBIs, three walks, and 13 runs scored in 25 games. His seven home runs on the season are also a new career-high with his six in June tied for the most in Single-A. Rivas finished first in the Florida State League during the month of June in total bases (53), tied for first in home runs (six), second in batting (.341), slugging (.646) and OPS (1.046), tied for second in hits (28) and extra base hits (12) and sixth in OBP (.400).

PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS: With the graduation of 2023 Marauder Paul Skenes from the prospect ranks, RHP Khristian Curtis entered the Top 30 rankings at No. 30. The Bradenton Marauders now hold eight of the Pittsburgh Pirates' Top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline, which is the most of any Minor League team in the Pirates system. **RHP Mike Burrows**, the No. 10 prospect is also rehabbing with Bradenton to bring the total to nine.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Thursday's loss against Fort Myers marked the Marauders' 28th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 16-12 record in those games with 55 of their first 82 (67.0%) games having been decided by three runs or less.
