ROUGHRIDERS TAKE FINALE, SERIES OVER SOD POODLES:

The Frisco RoughRiders out-slugged the Amarillo Sod Poodles 8-6 on Sunday evening from Riders Field, securing their third-straight series victory. Amarillo (4-11) drew first blood in the top of the first inning when Tommy Troy clipped an RBI single in the top of the first. Frisco (10-5) countered with a three-run bottom of the first. **Josh Hatcher** hit an RBI double, **Sebastian Walcott** scored on a wild pitch and **Cam Cauley** rolled an RBI groundout to take a 3-1 lead. In the bottom of the third, **Abimelec Ortiz** walloped a solo home run for his second long ball of the series. Then, **Luis Mieses** ripped an RBI single in the bottom of the fourth to give the Riders a 5-1 lead. In the top of the sixth, Amarillo's Kristian Robinson hit a sacrifice fly to cut the Frisco lead to 5-2. **Cooper Johnson** then lofted an RBI single in the bottom of the sixth, extending the Riders lead to 6-2. After an RBI single by Amarillo's Caleb Roberts in the top of the sixth, the Riders tallied two runs in the bottom half of the inning. Walcott pummeled an RBI double and Hatcher delivered an RBI single to up Frisco's lead 8-3. Then, the Sod Poodles answered in the top of the seventh when Gavin Conticello yanked a three-run home run, cutting the Frisco lead to 8-6. RoughRiders relievers **Gavin Collyer** and **Robby Ahlstrom** blanked Amarillo over the final two innings. Collyer spun 1.2 scoreless innings while Ahlstrom recorded the final out of the game to record his team-high fourth save. Riders starter **Trey Supak** (2-0) earned the win, allowing two runs across five innings while whiffing four and walking none. Sod Poodles starter Jose Cabrera (0-0) suffered the loss, allowing six runs on eight hits across 4.2 innings.

LITTLE SEBASTIAN? BIG SEBASTIAN:

Top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been off to an incredible start with the RoughRiders. The 19-year-old is the second-youngest player in the Texas League and has shown incredible patience. He is ninth in pitches seen and fifth in balls seen. His 17 percent walk rate is his highest in state-side baseball while his 24 percent strikeout rate is the lowest in his state-side career. During an eight-game hitting streak, he is hitting .333 (9-for-27)/.486/.593/1.079 with four doubles, one home run, eight RBIs, eight runs scored. In that streak, he has walked nine times while striking out just six times.

FLYING THE COOP:

Cooper Johnson has started out well in 2025 on both offense and defense. At the plate, he is hitting .333/.450/.697/1.147 with three doubles, three home runs, seven RBIs, seven walks and six runs scored. He is third in the Texas League in both SLG and OPS. On defense, Johnson leads the Texas League with seven caught stealings behind the plate, throwing out seven of eight base runners against him. His 88 percent caught-stealing rate is the best in MiLB currently.

SEVENTH INNING STRETCH THE LEAD:

For whatever reason, the RoughRiders have been fantastic on offense in the seventh inning this season. They are leading the Texas League with 19 runs scored in the seventh, while slashing .333/.471/.492/.963. In the seventh, they have walked 16 times to 11 strikeouts as a team.

POWER BRINGS WINS:

The RoughRiders have shown off their punch to begin the season and have been amazing on offense during their first 15 games. Frisco's 17 home runs through 15 games are second in the Texas League. They are first in BA (.271), first in SLG (.437) and first in OPS (.806). **Josh Hatcher** and **Cooper Johnson** have both hit three home runs, tied for the team lead. Over this stretch where they have won eight of their last 11 games, Frisco is hitting .281/.379/.467/.846, all of which are first in the Texas League, while also ranking first in runs per game (6.8) and home runs (14).

HATCHIN' HITTIN':

Josh Hatcher was incredible for the RoughRiders in 2024 and he has picked up right where he left off in 2025. Hatcher hit .300/.350/.448/.798 over 107 games with Frisco last season. He was one of just three qualified hitters in all of Double-A baseball to hit .300 or better. To start 2025, he reached safely in all 11 of 12 games he's played in, batting .423 (22-for-52)/.418/.673/1.091 with four doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs, a stolen base and nine runs scored over his first 12 games. His .423 batting average is fourth in all of Minor League Baseball. Hatcher already has seven multi-hit games and is 6-for-7 when putting the first pitch of an at-bat in play with two home runs. Hatcher's 18 hits were the most by a Texas Leaguer through the first eight team games since five-year Major Leaguer Jesus Guzman had 19 with Midland in 2008.

VERSUS THE HOOKS:

The Riders dominated Corpus Christi last season, going 17-7 against the Hooks. This was in large part due to their dominance on the mound, owning a 3.01 ERA (71ER/212.0IP) in their 24 head-to-head meetings a year ago. Since 2021, the Riders are 47-34 against Corpus Christi despite their losing record against the Hooks in their franchise history (270-279).

ABIMELEC-LECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz ended the year on fire for the RoughRiders. In his last 48 games, Ortiz hit .321/.413/.592/1.005 with nine doubles, 13 home runs, 38 RBIs, 37 runs scored and 28 walks. After July 10th, in those 48 games, he is fourth in average (.321), first in OPS (1.005), tied for first in RBIs (38) and first in home runs (13). During that span, he paced all of Double-A in OPS as well. In his last 29 games, he batted .364 (40-for-110)/.470/.710/1.170 with five doubles, 10 home runs, 30 RBIs, 21 walks, 24 strikeouts and 27 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. After, he hit .307 with a .954 OPS, raising his batting average to .243 and a .760 OPS. Ortiz clubbed his first two home runs of the season last week.

ABOUT RYAN

-Grew up in Marietta, Georgia area. Went to Etowah High School in Woodstock, Georgia.

-After High School, he started his college career at Chattanooga State Community College in Chattanooga, Tennessee. He then transferred to Mercer University, where his brother, Taylor, had previously pitched from 2016-2021.

-Played college summer ball in 2022 for Brewster of the Cape Cod League, going 1-0 with a 2.84 ERA (2 ER/6.1 IP) in four app

-In 2022, went 5-5 with 4.54 ERA and 5-4 with 6.96 ERA in 2023. In two-years at Mercer, he totalled 141 strikeouts over 132.2 innings. After he was signed, the Rangers reworked his pitch locations using data analytics.

2025 SEASON

-As of 4/18/25, Lobus has only had one career appearance without a strikeout in his professional career (8/14/23 vs. A-WSX) while pitching in the Arizona Complex League.

-Started with Low-A Down East and moved up to Double-A Frisco by the end of the season.

-Led all Rangers farmhands (min. 90.0 IP) in K/9 (12.78), BB/9 (2.10), K/BB ratio (6.09), K rate (35.8%), BB rate (5.9%), WHIP (0.98) and xFIP (2.64)

-His 35.8% strikeout rate ranked 2nd in all of MiLB under the same parameter to only Matt Wilkinson of the CLE system

-Recorded at least one strikeout in each of his 27 outings, registering in double-digit K's three times
