**LONG HOMESTAND:** After dropping the series opener to the Mudcats last night, the FredNats look to bounce back tonight behind the Virginia Credit Union Stadium debut of RHP Bryan Romero. Romero pitched well in his FredNat debut last week, allowing just three base runners in four scoreless innings against the Lynchburg Hillcats. He faces Carolina righty Daniel Corniel, who makes his third start of the season against Fredericksburg. In the two previous starts, Corniel has covered 11 innings and allowed just three runs for an ERA of 2.45. He's also struck out 13 in those two starts as well.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Mudcats started the game with five hits in a row, scoring four runs before the first out was recorded. They never looked back en route to a 15-5 win in the series opener. The FredNats scored four runs in the 9th on five straight hits themselves, but it was too little, too late. Fredericksburg pitching had a season-high 13 walks in the loss. Brenner Cox reached base four times and had an RBI double, YoYo Morales hit a two-run double in the 9th, and Brandon Pimentel had an RBI double and also drove in another run to give him 67 RBIs on the year.

**HE'S SOMETHING ELSE:** Travis Sykora has proven to be one of the most dominant pitchers in the Washington organization since he joined the FredNats for his professional debut on May 1. He's tied for 8th in all of Minor League Baseball in strikeouts per nine innings (13.50), 11th in hits per nine (5.18), and tied for 11th in opponent average (.165). In his last five starts covering 22 innings, Sykora is 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA, the opponents are hitting just .110 against him, and he has 39 strikeouts against just nine walks.

**DON'T LET HIM GET HOT:** Elijah Green homered twice last week in Lynchburg, and had an extra-base hit in four out of five games last week as well. Since July 1, Green is slashing .253/.371/.467/.837 and has posted a wRC+ of 145 (100 is league average), and a wOBA of .397 (.313 is league average). He also cut his strikeout rate by 9% from June, and his walk rate in July was 14%.

**LEADOFF BRENNER:** Friday night, Brenner Cox crushed the first pitch of the baseball game over the right field wall to get the FredNats off and running. It was Cox's sixth home run of the year, and the third time this season the FredNats have led off a road game with a home run. In last night's game, Cox had an RBI double, a single and two walks and he leads the team with a .742 OPS, and he's third on the team with 34 RBIs despite missing a month with a thumb injury. Cox is also second on the team in outfield assists with 11.

**YO!:** 2023 FredNat and top Washington infield prospect Yohandy Morales is off to a red-hot start in his first five rehab games with FXBG, going 10-for-20 with two homers, two doubles and seven RBIs. Morales broke his thumb in Harrisburg in late May and had not played since then. Last year's second round pick out of Miami, Morales played in 18 games for the FredNats after last year's draft, slashing .390/.448/.571 for an OPS of 1.019. Morales is currently ranked as Washington's 4th-best prospect.

**CLUBHOUSE SWITCHEROO:** When the Nationals traded Lane Thomas to the Cleveland Guardians on Monday, the trade had repercussions in this series. Cleveland sent back Top-30 prospects Alex Clemmey and Rafael Ramirez Jr., both of whom were on Lynchburg's team prior to the trade. Both have switched clubhouses, and Ramirez Jr. will make his third straight start tonight, while Clemmey will make his Washington organizational debut tonight in a start. Ramirez has three hits in three games against his old team.

**THE SKIP IS BACK:** The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 199-165 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

**THE STAFF:** The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Frelich, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals. He was the Pitching Coach for A+ Wilmington in 2021 and AA Harrisburg in 2022 before coming to FXBG in 2023.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with ZSP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Frelich begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Brayan Romero is set to make his second start as a FredNat tonight, as the team looks to rebound against Carolina.

Romero was called up from the FCL on 7/26, in conjunction with Marc Davis being promoted to A+ Wilmington.

**ROAD TO FXBG:** Romero's pro career began in 2022, primarily as a reliever in the Dominican Summer League. He covered 11 innings in the DSL, working to a 3.27 ERA with opponents hitting just .154 against him. That earned him a mid-summer bump to Florida, where he posted a 5.79 ERA over five outings (two starts).

Romero lost 2023 due to injury, but has excelled this season in the FCL. He's transitioned to a starting role (12 appearances, 9 starts), sporting a 2.52 ERA across 39.1 innings, nearly double his 2022 workload. He's struck out 39 men, while walking just nine, with a .212 BAA.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Romero impressed in his full-season debut last week, allowing just two base hits and two unearned runs over four strong innings against the Lynchburg Hillcats.
