TONIGHT'S GAME: The Quakes continue their six-game road trip with game five of a six-game series at Banner Island Ballpark, taking on the Stockton Ports (ATH). The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, April 15th, taking on the San Jose Giants in a six-game set.

VS THE PORTS: Today's game is the fifth of 18 games (all in the first half) against the Ports and the fifth of 12 here in Stockton. After Friday's win, the Quakes are 1-3 in this series. Last season, the Quakes went 8-2 against the Ports, 5-1 here in Stockton.

LAST GAME: The Quakes rallied for three in the ninth on Friday night to top Stockton, 5-4, securing their first win at Banner Island Ballpark this series. Elijah Hainline's two-run homer knotted the score at 4-4, before Victor Rodrigues walked and eventually scored on a two-out wild pitch from Stockton closer Wilfred Alvarado (0-1). Rancho reliever Domingo Geronimo (1-0) earned the win, retiring four of the five batters he faced to lock it up. Rancho overcame ten walks and three errors, both season-worsts, to end their three-game losing streak and get their first road win of 2025. **ROSTER MOVES:** The Quakes made their first roster move of the year on Thursday, placing INF Nico Perez on the IL, retroactive to April 8. INF Raynerd Ortega filled that spot and debuted on Thursday night, going 0-for-4.

STILL WEARING THE SAME SHOE: The Quakes are excited to welcome back Manager John Shoemaker, who returns to Rancho to guide the Quakes for a fifth straight year, a franchise record. The club is 271-243 in four seasons under "Shoe", having made the playoffs twice, including one appearance in the Championship Series (2023). The Quakes have only one returning coach to this year's club, as pitching coach Ramon Troncoso returns to Rancho, joining Shoemaker for his fifth year as well. New members of the coaching staff include hitting coach Johermyn Chavez, pitching coach Brandon Bailey, Bench Coach Dunior Zerpa, Bullpen Coach and former Quake Marco Hernandez, Athletic Trainer Alfredo Casillas, Performance Coach Jake Taylor and Video Associate Max Delorme.

PROSPECT HEAVY: According to MLB Pipeline's rankings the Dodgers have stocked the Quakes with seven of their top-30 prospects. In order, they are: INF Kellon Lindsey (#8), OF Eduardo Quintero (#9), INF Joendry Vargas (#12), RHP Hyun-Seok Jang (#17), OF Mike Sirota (#21), OF Jaron Elkins and RHP Samuel Sanchez (#28). Of the 29 active players on the Rancho roster, 15 of them saw time in a Quakes' uniform in 2024.

SEAN PAUL LINAN: Right-hander Sean Paul Linan makes his second appearance and first start of the year, his first against the Ports. In his only outing this year, he dominated over 5.1 innings, allowing one run on two hits, striking out a career-high 11 batters, while walking just one in a win over the Storm on April 6th. Linan opened the 2024 season with the ACL Dodgers, going 3-0 with a 2.08 ERA over six games (one start) before joining the Quakes, where he'd go 6-2 with a 4.89 ERA over 13 games (four starts). Linan signed with the Dodgers in January of 2022 out of Cartagena, Columbia.

TZU-CHEN SHA: Right-hander Tzu-Chen Sha makes his first start and second appearance for the Ports, his first against Rancho. In his only outing this year, he retired all nine batters he faced over three innings last Sunday, as part of a no-hit win over Fresno. Sha has seen time in Stockton during all three years of his pro career, going 0-1 with a 5.00 ERA in seven starts in 2023, before going 2-6 with a 6.33 ERA over 24 games (12 starts) in 2024. Sha signed with the A's out of Taiwan in February of 2023.
