TULSA POWER SURGE DROPS CARDS 9-3: The Tulsa Drillers hit three home runs and scored 6 runs in the top of the 2nd inning as the Cardinals dropped their third straight with a 9-3 loss on Thursday evening. **RJ Yeager** had a season high 4 hits, **Bryan Torres** went 3-for-3 and **Ramon Mendoza** drove in two runs with a double in bottom of the 2nd for Springfield. For the second time in their series against Tulsa, the Cardinals hit into three double plays. The Cards outhit the Drillers 12-10 but went 2-for-11 with runners in scoring position.



DPPOSING STARTER: Lefty **Justin Wrobleski** makes his 9th start of the season for Tulsa...Last pitched on Saturday, May 18 against Wichita and had his best outing of the season firing 6.0 IP of one-run ball allowing just 3 H with a season-high 9 K's...The Drillers won the game, 4-3...1-0 with a 3.78 ERA in 3 May starts after going 1-1 with a 4.76 ERA in April...Got the nod on opening night at NW Arkansas and got the win, allowing a run on 3 H with 6 K in 5.0 IP...Spent the entire 2023 season with High-A Great Lakes of the Midwest League going 4-4 with a 2.90 ERA in 25 appearances (23 starts)...Opponents hit .244 against him...Made one start last season against the Peoria Chiefs (High-A, Cardinals) and allowed 2 ER on 7 H in 5.0 IP with 3 K...Made 13 appearances in 2022 between the ACL Dodgers and Low-A Rancho Cucamonga and went 1-3 with a 2.91 ERA after rehabbing from Tommy John surgery...Selected by the Dodgers in the 11th round of the 2021 draft out of Oklahoma State despite having his only season with the Cowboys cut short (9 appearances) due to his elbow injury...Spent his sophomore season in junior college at State College of Florida in 2020 after pitching for Clemson as a freshman in 2019...23 years old

LONGEST HOMESTAND OF 2024 CONTINUES WITH SEVEN AGAINST THE DRILLERS: For the first time this season, the Cardinals play host to the Tulsa Drillers (Double-A, Los Angeles Dodgers) as the two teams play a seven-game series at Hammons Field this week. The Cardinals won 4 out of 5 at ONEOK Field from April 30-May 4. The Cards and Drillers will play a doubleheader on Wednesday to make up for the postponement on May 5.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

HOME (NOT SO) SWEET HOME: The Cardinals have struggled thus far during their longest homestand of the season at Hammons Field, going 3-7 through the first 10 of the 13-game stand. Springfield has a 6.88 team ERA over those 10 games and has been outscored 70-50 despite sporiting a .286 batting average during that time. After an 8-0 start to their home schedule, the Cards have lost 11 of their last 14 games at Hammons Field.

Overall, Springfield has dropped 9 of its last 12 games, going from 20-10 to 23-19.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats and put the ball in play. The Cards have struck out just 303 times in 42 games, the 3rd-fewest in all of full-season Minor League Baseball. In the Texas League, Springfield trails the Frisco RoughRiders (290 K's in 41 games) for 2nd-fewest in the circuit. Springfield is averaging just 7.2 K's per game. The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers are tied with Frisco for fewest K's in the minor leagues at 290.

CARDS PLAGUED BY BIG INNINGS: So far in 2024, the Cardinals have had a hard time limiting the big inning. Springfield has surrendered 34 innings in which the opponent has scored 3 or more runs. In those 34 innings, the Cardinals have allowed 132 of the 240 total runs scored by the opposition, 55% of the runs the Birds have allowed this season. Springfield has allowed that production in just 9.5% of their innings pitched. In the other 324.2 IP Springfield has allowed 105 runs, which comes out to 2.91 runs per 9 innings.

SEARCHING FOR LONGBALL ELIXIR: So far this season the Cardinals have been victims of the longball, getting dinged for 53 home runs in just 42 games. That number is the highest in Double-A; the Amarillo Sod Poodles are next having allowed 47 homers. Overall opponents are batting .259 against Springfield pitching, 3rd highest in the Texas League.

HE GETS ON BASE...AND HITS TANKS: Despite having his on-base streak snapped in game one on Wednesday, Matt Lloyd has still reached base in 19 of his last 21 games. His 18-game on base streak was the third longest on the club this season; Bryan Torres had a 23-game streak from April 5-May 9 and Jeremy Rivas had a 20-gamer from April 14-May 12. Lloyd has walked a team-high 24 times, also leads the Cardinals with 7 home runs and has an OBP of .390. He finished a triple shy of the cycle in the series finale against Midland on Sunday.

HOT CORNER, HOT BAT: After a slow start to the season, Cardinals INF **Jacob Buchberger** has gotten hot over the last month. Since coming into play on April 14 batting .087, Springfield's 3B is batting .341 (28-for-82) over his last 24 games, and has hit safely in all but 3 of them. He has two separate 8-game hitting streaks during that stretch.

Buchberger is currently riding a 9-game hitting streak, the 3rd-longest active streak in the Texas League. During his hitting streak, **Buchberger** is batting .441 (15-for-34) with a double and home run. He has multiple hits in 6 of his last 8 games.

TABLE SETTERS: The hitters that occupy the top two spots in the Cardinal lineup on the most regular basis, **Bryan Torres** and **Nathan Church**, have been the fuel to Springfield's league-leading offense. Combined, **Torres** and **Church** are batting .316 (93-for-294) with 49 R, 16 2B, 24 SB, 4 CS and have struck out a combined 40 times compared to 32 walks.

Springfield leadoff hitters are batting .290 (2nd in the Texas League) and .295 out of the 2-hole, the top mark in the circuit. Combined, the Cardinals batting .297 between the two spots in the lineup, tops in the league.

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his

go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 206.

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 19 straight games without a home run.
