PITCHING DOMINATES AGAIN IN SHUTOUT WIN OVER CORPUS:

The Frisco RoughRiders won their third straight game against the Corpus Christi Hooks, allowing just two hits in a 5-0 win on Thursday at Whataburger Field. **Justin Slaten** (3-2) took the win by striking out all six batters he faced in relief. **Evan Carter** had the go-ahead triple in the sixth inning and **Trevor Hauser** homered in the next at-bat. Frisco (21-15, 52-52) is back to a .500 record for the first time since May 5th and is now a season-best six games over .500 in the second half. Corpus Christi (19-16, 52-53) has been shut out by Frisco three times in nine games this year. Before this week, the Riders had not shut out an opponent since June 7th, when Frisco won at Whataburger Field 9-0. Three of Frisco's four shutouts this year are in nine games at Whataburger Field. Ryan Gusto (2-2) totaled 11 strikeouts over 5.1 innings for the Hooks and was finally pulled out after **Keyber Rodriguez** walked on 10 pitches in the sixth. Against reliever Diosmerky Taveras, Carter tripled to score Rodriguez. That run was charged to Gusto, giving him the loss. Hauser homered to left center moments later, scoring Carter and giving Frisco a 3-0 lead. After two walks, **Liam Hicks** singled for an RBI to put four runs on the board in the sixth inning. **Noah Bremer** went four scoreless innings in his start for Frisco. In a no-decision, Bremer gave up just two hits and struck out two. Bremer allowed just one base runner through his first three innings, a pop fly double to left field in the first inning. He stranded that runner at second base by starting a string of eight straight batters retired. He put three runners aboard in the fourth inning but escaped without a run allowed, using a double play ball. It was Frisco's league-leading 94th double play this season. Slaten struck out all six batters he faced in the fifth and sixth innings. It was a season-high for Slaten in strikeouts, and he has struck out 11 over his last four innings. His season high last year was seven strikeouts, also against Corpus Christi. **John Matthews** tossed two hitless innings, striking out four, and **Antoine Kelly** went 1-2-3 in the ninth. Frisco's bullpen has not given up a run this series over 11 innings, with just two hits. **Jayce Easley** stole his first base at the Double-A level on Thursday. Hicks walked in the ninth inning and Easley pinch ran. He swiped second and advanced to third on the same sequence due to a throwing error. He scored on a wild pitch to make Frisco's lead 5-0.

NEW MONTH, NEW ME:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the mound this season, but in the month of August, they have been fantastic. In the nine games in August, the RoughRiders lead the Texas League with a 2.22 ERA while allowing a league-low four home runs and .158 BAA. The August ERA is the fourth-lowest in MiLB while the .158 BAA is the lowest in the minors. The bullpen has allowed just five earned runs over 46.2 innings, a 0.96 ERA with 62 strikeouts to 13 walks. **Ryan Garcia** was brilliant on Tuesday, allowing just two base runners on walks over six no-hit innings with six strikeouts. **Nick Krauth** then followed up with a second quality start on Wednesday, giving the RoughRiders their first back-to-back quality starts since May 31st and June 1st when **Owen White** and **Jack Leiter** completed the feat.

HAU YOURSELF A YEAR:

Trevor Hauser has been fantastic recently for the RoughRiders on the offensive side. On June 16th, he was hitting .218/.337/.368/.705, but in the 38 games since, he is batting .317/.434/.535/.969 with 11 doubles, six home runs, 26 RBIs and 30 walks. In those games, he has raised his average 45 points and his OPS 120 points.

CARTER WALKS SO THE ROUGHRIDERS CAN RUN:

Evan Carter has been fantastic at drawing walks and getting on base this season. Carter's 61 walks are second in the Texas League despite only playing in 77 percent of the RoughRiders games this year. His 15.6 percent walk rate this year is sixth-highest in the league as well. He has walked 11 times in his last 11 games. His .406 OBP on the season is 10th in all of Double-A and among all 13 players in Double-A with a .400 OBP or better, Carter is the youngest at 20 years old.

HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 20 games, Hicks is batting .362 (25-for-69)/.463/.507/.970 with five doubles, a home run, 13 RBIs, 13 walks and 12 runs scored. He is riding a seven-game hitting streak, batting .478 (11-for-23).

K'S BY KELLY:

RoughRiders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He has not allowed an earned run over his last 19 outings. During that stretch, he has 24 strikeouts to three walks over 21.1 innings while recording three saves. He has converted on all seven save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauser**, **Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

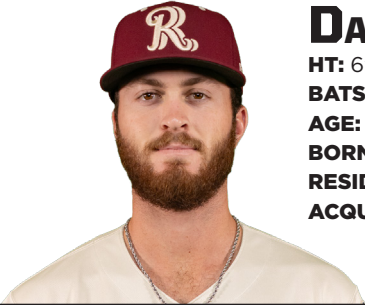

ABOUT DANE

-Went to Brenham High School in Brenham, Texas (between Austin and Houston). His senior year of high school, he went 5-2 with a 1.79 ERA.

-Acker attended Rice for freshman season, going 5-2 with a 4.20 ERA and earned Conference USA All-Freshman Team honors. From there, transferred to San Jacinto College for sophomore season in 2019, going 10-0 with a 2.36 ERA in 14 starts. He struck out 97 batters in 76.1 IP.

-Drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 2019 23rd round, but did not sign.

-For his junior season, he went to Oklahoma University, making four starts in the COVID-shortened season, going 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA. At the Schrienes College Classic on March 1st against No.11 LSU, Acker threw the first Oklahoma no-hitter since 1989, striking out 11 batters to just one walk and two hit batters. He threw 117 pitches in the game.

-Acker was taken by the Oakland Athletics in the 4th round of the 2020 draft, one pick after Braves pitcher Spencer Strider.

2023 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 22 prospect in the Texas system by MLB.com.

-In Double-A debut at San Antonio on July 3rd, allowed two-run inside the park homer in the third inning to Juan Fernandez, but struck out five.

-When he was promoted to Double-A Frisco on July 3rd, Acker had just thrown 53.1 career MiLB innings over 17 games with only 50.1 innings and 12 games in affiliated ball above the Rookie level.

-Finished out High-A time with a 1.65 ERA (3ER/16.1IP) in June.

-Induced ground balls at a 46.9% rate with High-A Hickory over his six starts.

-Earned first career MiLB win with five strong innings against San Antonio on July 18th.

2022 SEASON

-Acker returned from rehab in mid-July, throwing in the Arizona League before making four starts with Hickory, debuting with the Crawdads on August 21st.

-After the season, Acker participated in the Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.

2021 SEASON

-After trade to Rangers, Acker made two starts with the Down East Wood Ducks before his second ended with "Tommy John" surgery.

-Traded from the Oakland Athletics along with OF Khris Davis and C Jonah Heim in exchange for INF Elvis Andrus and C Aramis Garcia and cash on February 6th, 2021.
