JACKSONVILLE OVERCOMES DEFICIT IN 6-4 WIN

Matt Mervis drove in three runs and finished a double shy of the cycle as the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp came back to win 6-4 over the Rochester Red Wings Thursday afternoon. Trailing 4-1 in the sixth, Jacksonville (40-26) sent nine men to the plate to take the lead, which they would never relinquish. A hit batter coupled with a walk put two runners on. An RBI single from Graham Pauley cut the deficit to two. A double steal, coupled with a two-run triple from Mervis evened the game at four. **Andrew Pintar** followed with an RBI single off Rochester (22-42) starter **Adrian Sampson** (1-2).

SUMMER DAYS DRIFTING AWAY

Jacksonville began the 2025 campaign on a tear, posting a 21-8 record through the first 29 games of the season. After posting a Triple-A best, ERA (2.80), batting average against (.205) and tied for the best record (21-8), the Jumbo Shrimp have cooled off heading in to summer. In their last 37 games (May 1-present), Jacksonville is 19-18 and have a -15 run differential. Their .676 OPS is the second-lowest in Triple-A while their 335 strikeouts are tied for the eighth-most.

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the season opener, Jacksonville has recorded a stolen base in 53 of their last 65 games, with multiple steals in 40 contests. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have eight games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte; Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. With two stolen bases Thursday, the Jumbo Shrimp lead Triple-A and are fourth in the minors with 147 steals.

EXIT (VELOCITY) STRATEGY

Jacksonville's biggest strength in 2025, along with stealing bases, has been its pitching and defense. The club ranks second in Triple-A with a 3.64 ERA, and their 266 runs allowed are the third-fewest at the level. Interestingly, Jacksonville's staff ranks only 16th in Triple-A in strikeouts (573), but their 459 hits allowed are the level's fewest, meaning the club has suppressed quite a few balls put in play. Opponents have mustered an average exit velocity of 87.1 against the Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff, the fourth-lowest such mark in Triple-A.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD

Jacksonville's bullpen went nearly a week between earned runs, yielding three runs in the ninth inning of their May 24 contest against Memphis before a ninth-inning tally on Friday for Gwinnett. Over their last 16 games dating back to May 25, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to surrender 28 runs, 24 earned, on 51 hits in 72.0 innings for a 3.00 ERA. Jacksonville relievers have combined for 70 strikeouts against 34 walks during this stretch.

WALK IT OUT

Through 66 games thus far in 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp have totaled 240 free passes (3.6 BB/G). **Jakob Marsee** ranks second in walks in the International League (45). Among the 105 qualified players in the circuit, Marsee ranks 10th in walk rate (16.7%). Including Marsee, Jacksonville has four other players scattered among the 105 other qualified players in walk rate in the IL (**Maximo Acosta**, 11.1%; **Jacob Berry**, 8.7%; **Troy Johnston**, 7.5%; **Andrew Pintar**, 6.8%).

PITCH PERFECT

Jacksonville's 40 wins in 2025 can be attributed to the strength of their pitching staff. Not does the staff own the second-best ERA in Triple-A (3.64), they've coupled that with the 16th-most strikeouts (573) and the fourth-fewest walks (242). The low strikeout number isn't necessarily troubling because the staff is tied for the second-fewest pitches per inning (16.22). Meaning, that opposing hitters don't draw a ton of three-ball counts, but they also don't drive up the pitch counts of Jacksonville hurlers. Jumbo Shrimp starters average 4.0 IP per contest and own a Triple-A best 15.76 pitches per inning. In addition, the bullpen averages 4.2 IP per game and is second in Triple-A in pitches/inning (16.62) behind Durham (16.46).

WE'RE NOT SUPERSTITIOUS, JUST A LITTLE-STITIOUS

Since 2022, the Jumbo Shrimp have played two games on Friday the 13th. Although most find Friday the 13th as bad luck, Jacksonville is 2-0 on the date. Jumbo Shrimp are 24-for-75 (.320) with four doubles, four homers and 15 RBIs. The pitching staff has been excellent as well. Starters have posted a 1.63 ERA, allowing 2 runs, 2 earned runs for a 1.63 ERA along with seven hits (5.7 H/9), six walks (4.9 BB/9) and 11 strikeouts (9 K/9).

ABOUT ROBINSON

-A native of San Cristobal in the Dominican Republic, Piña was originally signed by the Los Angeles Angels as an international free agent on February 15, 2017.

-Following the 2023 season, Piña elected free agency. He signed with the Philadelphia Phillies as a minor league free agent and spent the 2024 campaign between Double-A Reading and Triple-A Lehigh Valley.

2024 SEASON

-Piña posted major platoon splits; While he held right-handed hitters to a .195/.245/.312/.557 batting line in 249 plate appearances, left-handed batters hit .324/.366/.591/.957 against him over 303 plate appearances.

-Piña posted an 8-2 record and 3.50 ERA over 12 starts during the season's first half (61.2 IP, 65 H, 8 BB, 70 K, .262 BAA). However, over 13 starts in the second half of the year, he went 5-6 with a 4.79 ERA (67.2 IP, 71 H, 19 BB, 62 K, .269 BAA)
