Captain's Log

NEW NAME, SAME GAME: The Lake County Captains are the High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. Cleveland officially changed their name to the Guardians on November 19, 2021.

2021 DRAFT: Five starting pitchers for the Captains' were selected in the 2021 draft. Gavin Williams, has made four starts, striking out 39 over 24.2 innings. The right-hander was selected in the first round, with the 23rd overall pick. Doug Nixhazy, the 58th overall selection, has totaled 15 innings over four starts allowing seven earned runs. Tommy Mace was also taken in the second round, 69th overall via a competitive balance pick. Tanner Bibee, was drafted in the fifth round as the 156th overall pick, he's totaled 16.2 innings allowing two earned runs. Aaron Davenport, was the sixth round and 186th overall pick in the 2021 draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Yesterday's 5-2 loss to the Great Lakes Loons marks the 11th loss in which the Captains put up two runs or less. Lake County left in total 10 runners on base

IS STAT SO?: Lake County Captains pitchers have allowed the least amount of earned runs in the Midwest League with 78 over 218 innings pitched.

Among qualified pitchers Gavin Williams has the fourth best ERA in the Midwest League, with a 1.46 ERA over 24.2 innings.

CAPTAINS TO THE SHOW: Four former Lake County Captains have made their MLB debut with the Cleveland Guardians in the 2022 season.

Richie Palacios: The Brooklyn born Palacios earned two singles in his first two major league at-bats on April 25th against the Angels. Palacios earned the start in left field and had both his mother and father in attendance. Palacios played 20 games with Lake County in 2018 and had 24 hits.

Kirk McCarty: McCarty took the hill for the first time as a Guardian on Sunday, April 24th at Yankee Stadium. He appeared in the sixth inning, going three innings, surrendering four runs but adding three strikeouts. He made 22 starts in the 2018 season as a Captain, accumulating a 4.29 ERA through 115.1 innings.

Tanner Tully: The left-hander from Elkhart, Indiana, made his MLB debut on April 22nd entering in the fifth inning against the Yankees. He went two innings allowing two hits, and one run over 38 pitches. Tully was a Captain in 2017, where he 16 appearances, eight starts and posted a 3.16 ERA over 77 innings.

Bryan Lavastida: Lavastida became the 104th player to come through Lake County and make their Major League Baseball debut catching all nine innings for the Guardians in their 17-3 win over the Kansas City Royals on April 10th. He earned his first big league hit April 22nd at Yankee Stadium. Lavastida was a Captain in 2021 playing in 48 games where he batted .303/.399/.467.

LAST TIME OUT: Hickman pitched two strong innings in relief against the Dragons last Saturday. The right-hander faced seven batters striking out five, allowing one hit and forcing one groundout over 39 pitches. The game marked the first save of Hickman's professional career.

BACK IN LAKE COUNTY: This is year number two for Hickman with the Captains. He started 20 games in 2021 including game number 120. The 2020 draft pick struck out 110 over 97.2 innings.

A FLY GUY: In 2021, Hickman generated 48.4 percent of his outs on flyballs. The fourth highest mark among Cleveland minor league pitchers who hurled 50+ innings.

CWS CHAMPION: Mason Hickman got the ball in the deciding game three of the 2019 College World Series against the University of Michigan. He threw six innings, allowing only one run and striking out 10 Wolverines in an 8-2 win. In four NCAA tournament starts, the Tennessee native had a 1.57 ERA in 23 innings and earned the win in two games.

NORMAL MASON: With Kumar Rocker and Drew Fellows as teammates in 2019, the attention and eyeballs off the college baseball world determined on who got next. Hickman was known for his consistency and was called "Normal Mason" by Rocker after the 2019 College World Series in the Omaha World Herald.

VANDY BOY: Over three seasons at Vanderbilt, Hickman had 221 strikeouts over 189.2 innings and a 19-2 record. Before the 2020 season, Hickman was named to the first team Preseason All-American by Collegiate Baseball and a second team Preseason All-American by Perfect Game. Manager Tim Corbin stated on Hickman during his time at Vandy, "Mason has turned into one of the most dependable and reliable starting pitchers that we have had in our program. He continues to develop and get better at his craft while taking on a leadership role on our pitching staff. He is a quality young man that excels in the classroom as well. Very competitive in everything that he does."
