Tonight's Game: The Sounds and Indians conclude their series tonight at First Horizon Park. The teams have swapped shut-out wins the last two games with Nashville winning 3-0 last night. Right-hander Mitch White makes his first start of the season and will face off against right-hander Aaron Shortridge for Indianapolis.

Mitch White: The 29-year-old makes his 12th appearance (first start) for the Sounds this season. He had three appearances with the Giants, four with the Blue Jays, and six with the Brewers before coming to Nashville. In his last outing at Gwinnett on August 3, he went 3.1 scoreless innings with five strikeouts. It was his third outing of at least 3.0 innings with Nashville and fifth overall. His last start was with Buffalo on September 21, 2023 vs. Norfolk. In his minor league career, 92 of his 119 appearances are starts but only 22 of 71 in the MLB have come as a starter. White made his MLB debut in 2020 and has logged innings with four teams in the majors. He has been designated for assignment three times this season and traded twice. The San Jose native was drafted by the Dodgers in the second round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft from Santa Clara. He missed his senior year in high school, recovering from Tommy John's surgery, but he returned to Santa Clara after earning All-West Coast Conference Freshman team honors.

Aaron Shortridge: The 27-year-old makes his fifth appearance (fourth start) for the Indians this season. His last start was in the series opener and he was charged with the loss after allowing seven earned runs across 4.0 innings. The last time he allowed at least seven earned runs in a start was on September 3, 2023, at Erie (12 ER). Before pitching for Indianapolis this season, he made two rehab appearances with the FCL Pirates and three starts for Bradenton. He was activated off the injured list on July 16. Before this season, Shortridge had only made one appearance in Triple-A against Rochester on September 20, 2023. The Santa Rosa, Ca. native was drafted by the Pirates in the 4th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft from the University of California, Berkeley. He made eight starts in A(short) in 2018 and 24 starts in 2019 for A(Adv) but did not pitch in 2020-2021 due to the canceled minor league season and a recovery from Tommy John surgery.

Solo Shots: Isaac Collins opened the bottom of the first inning with a solo blast. It was the first leadoff home run by a Sound since Tyler Black on June 5 vs. Louisville and Collins' first home run since June 30 at Jacksonville. Francisco Mejia hit a solo homer in the fifth inning apart of a 3-for-4 performance. It was the fourth time this season that he has had three hits in a game and extended his on-base streak to 15 games. Only Isaac Collins (17 games & 18 games) has had longer on-base streaks this season for Nashville. His home run was also the 100th in his professional career with 71 in the minor leagues and 29 in the MLB for the Padres and Rays.

Return to Form: Carlos Rodriguez had his sixth quality start of the season which was the first by a Sound since Chad Patrick on July 11 vs. Iowa. Patrick and Rodriguez have combined for 13 of the 16 quality starts for Nashville. Rodriguez has been excellent over his last four outings, allowing just two earned runs in 17.1 innings. It was the third time this season that he has recorded outs in the 7th inning (6.2 IP at Memphis on May 30 & 6.1 IP vs. Omaha on April 17).

No Runs Allowed: Last night was the fourth shutout by the Sounds this season. The previous three occurred on March 31 at Toledo, April 12 at Memphis (seven innings), and June 4 vs. Louisville. Tobias Myers was the starter for the first two with Chad Patrick starting the game on June 4. Buffalo and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre are tied for the most shutouts in the International League with eight.

Future Brew Crew: The Sounds currently have three of the top 10 and six of the top 30 Brewers prospects, per MLB Pipeline. They are RHP Jacob Misiorowski (No. 2), INF Tyler Black (No. 3), RHP Carlos Rodriguez (No. 7), RHP Logan Henderson (No. 16), RHP Craig Yoho (No. 23) and INF Wes Clarke (No. 24).

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 742-636 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,334-2,156 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.
